



PRODUCTION AND DELIVERIES OF ENERGY PRODUCTS, November 2009

The production of unleaded motor gasoline in November 2009 compared to October 2009 increases by 17.7% to 146 thousand tones and electricity – by 10.2% to 3993 GWh. Decrease is observed for the production of solid fuels – by 6.7% to 3094 thousand tones, LPG – by 9.1% to 10 thousand tones and transport diesel – by 5.3% to 161 thousand tones. There is no change in the production of natural gas (Table 1).

The production of solid fuels in November 2009 compared to November 2008 increases by 2.6% and unleaded motor gasoline – by 2.1%. Decrease is reported for the production of LPG – by 23.1%, transport diesel – by 6.4%, electricity – by 3.1% and natural gas – by 100%.

The deliveries of unleaded motor gasoline in November 2009 compared to October 2009 increase by 7.8% to 83 thousand tones, transport diesel – by 8.0% to 135 thousand tones, natural gas – by 37.9% to 269 million standard cubic metres and electricity – by 22.5% to 3276 GWh. Decrease is observed for the deliveries of solid fuels – by 9.3% to 3316 thousand tones and LPG – by 3.8 to 25 thousand tones (Table 2).

The deliveries of LPG in November 2009 compared to November 2008 increase by 4.2%, unleaded motor gasoline – by 20.3%, natural gas – by 3.5% and electricity – by 7.4%. The deliveries of solid fuels decrease by 3.7% as well as transport diesel – by 18.7%.

Methodological notes

The survey on energy products is conducted every month in accordance with the adopted Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on energy statistics. The survey aims to submit information on the production and inland deliveries of the main energy products – electricity, solid fuels, natural gas and petroleum products. Respondents of the survey are producers, importers and exporters of energy products. Production and deliveries of the energy products are the main observed indicators.

Solid fuels

Include Hard coal, Lignite and Solid fuels from coal.

Production – producers report quantities, calculated after any operation for removal of inert matter.

Deliveries – quantities delivered to the internal market. Equal to the total of the deliveries to the different types of consumers: producers' own use, main activity power stations, coking plants and patent fuel plants, industry, iron and steel industry and others.

Petroleum products

Production – production of finished products at a refinery or blending plant.

Deliveries – the observed delivery of finished petroleum products from primary sources.

Natural gas

Production – all dry marketable production within national boundaries including offshore production. Production is measured after purification and extraction of NGLs and sulphur.

Deliveries – total natural gas, distributed for the internal market, including own use and losses.

Data are presented in million standard cubic metres – at international standard conditions 15° C and 760 mm Hg.

Electricity

Production – produced electricity from Thermal power plants, Nuclear power plant, Hydro power plants, Pumped storage plant and electricity, obtained from wind generators and solar collectors.

Deliveries – sum of net produced electricity and net import.

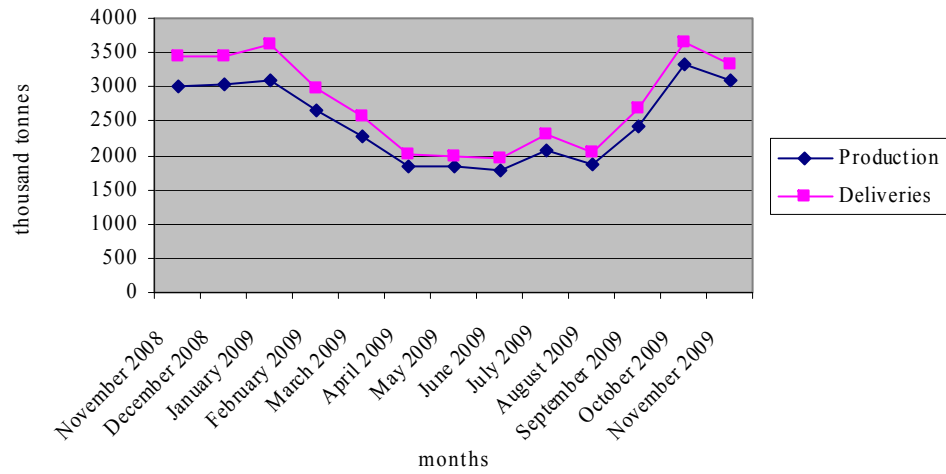

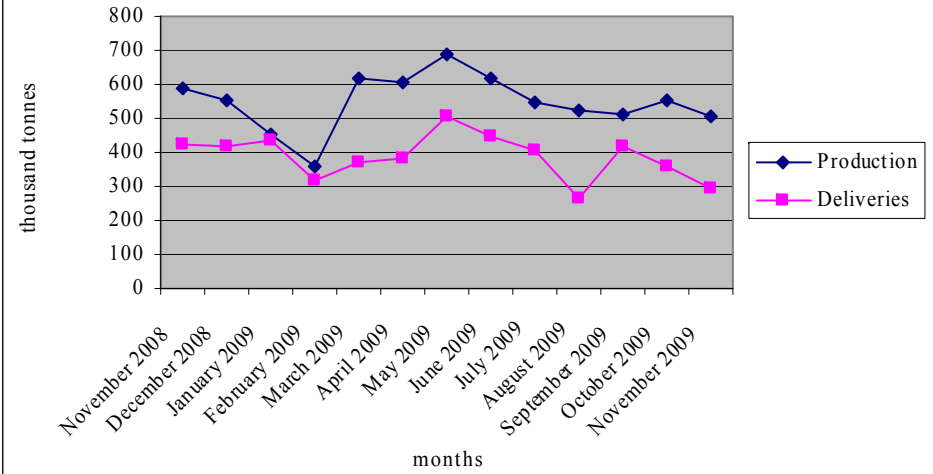

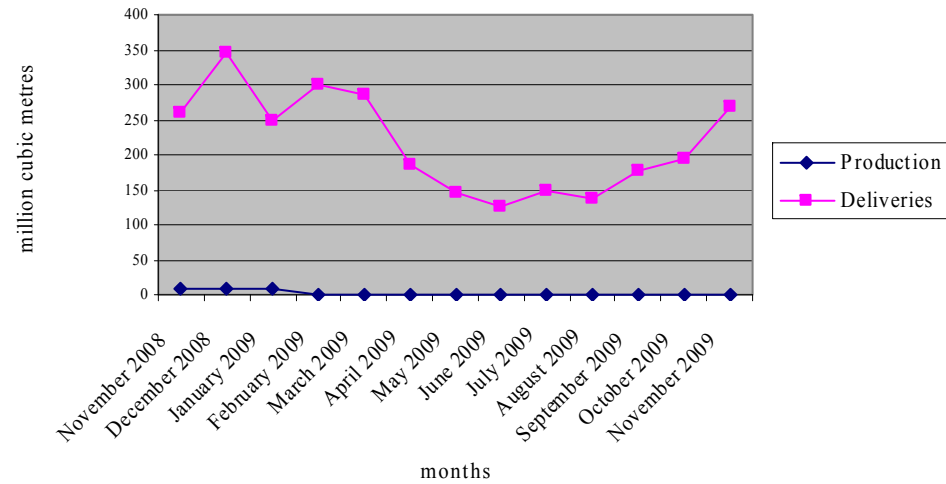
