PRICE INDICES IN AGRICULTURE

THIRD QUARTER OF 2010

1. Indices of producer prices in agriculture

The index of producer prices in agriculture increases by 8.5% in the third quarter of 2010 as compared to the same quarter of 2009. In the crop prices have increased by 10.1%, and in livestock – by 4.9% compared to the corresponding quarter of previous year. Increase was recorded in: cereals – by 12.6%, industrial crops – by 12.2%, vegetables – by 7.8%, fruit – by 12.5%, live animals – by 1.5% and animal products – by 7.9%. The prices increase for wheat – by 19.5%, maize – by 11.8%, sunflower – by 17.3%, tomatoes – by 35.8%, cucumbers – by 6.5%, apples – by 19.8%, pigs – by 5.4% and cow milk - by 12.5%.




Figure 1. Producer prices indices in agriculture by quarter (2005 = 100)

2. Indices of prices of means of production used in agriculture

The index of prices of means of production used in agriculture in the third quarter of 2010 is 1.8% above the same quarter of 2009. Increase was registered in the plant protection products - by 0.7%, electricity – by 1.5%, veterinary medical products – by 0.8% and animal feeding stuffs – by 7.1%. The prices decrease was recorded seen in fertilizers and plant protection products – by 12.9% and 0.7% respectively.




Figure 2. Goods and services currently consumed in agriculture by quarter (2005 = 100)
