

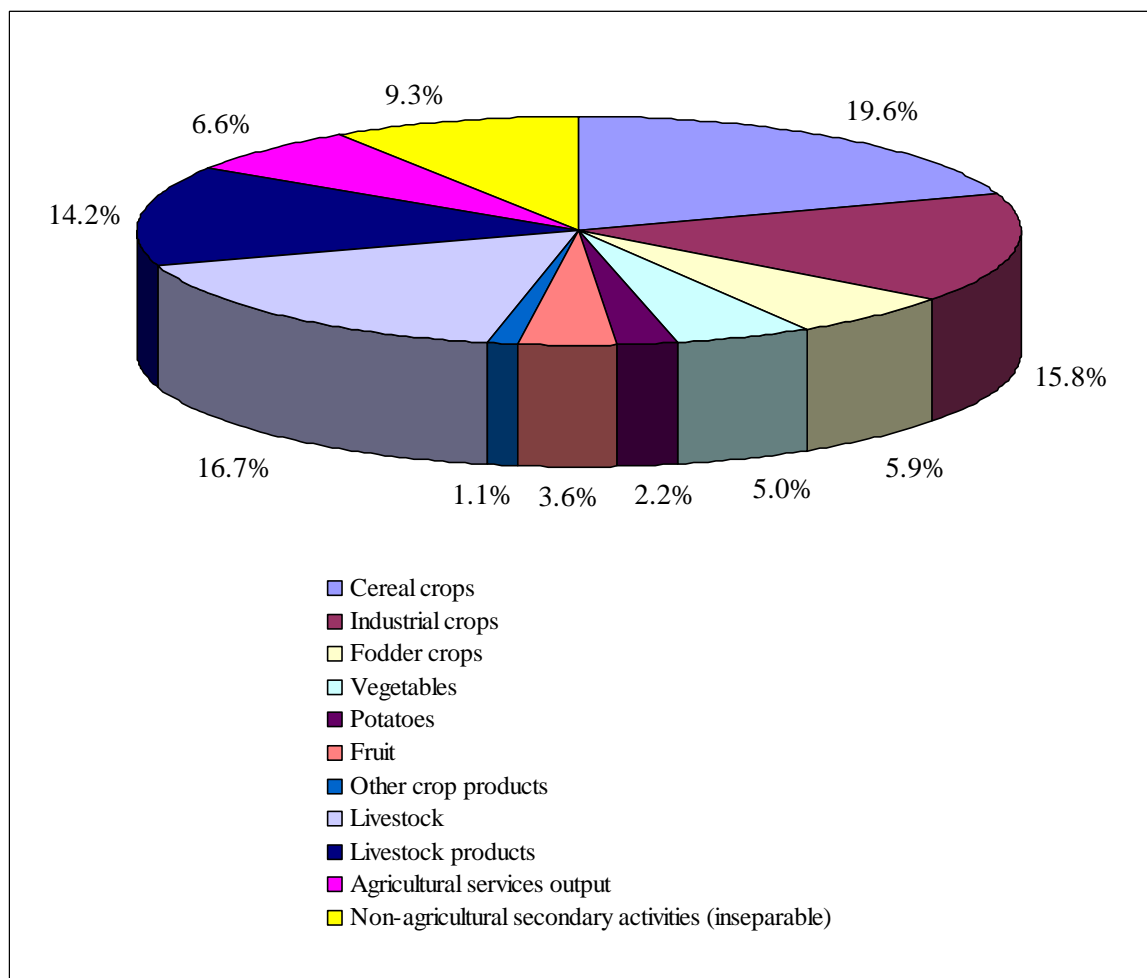


## ECONOMIC ACCOUNTS OF AGRICULTURE IN 2010 – FIRST ESTIMATES

According to the first estimates of the National Statistical Institute, prepared as of November, the final output<sup>1</sup> at basic prices<sup>2</sup> in agriculture amounted to 7494.5 million leva or went up by 1.4% as compared with a year ago. The increase was mainly due to the raise in prices by 4.9%.

The final output at basic prices in cereal crops amounted to 1475.8 million leva. It had the highest share in the final output of agriculture (19.7%), followed by share of the final output of livestock (16.7%), industrial crops (15.8%) and animal products (14.2%).

In 2010 intermediate consumption decreased by 3.6% as compared with a year ago mainly due to the drop in volume – by 3.5%. The most significant share of the intermediate consumption have feedstuffs - 29% and fuel and energy - 22%.

<sup>2</sup> Basic prices include subsidies on products but exclude taxes on products.



Value added in agriculture rose by 10.9% as compared with a year ago, mainly due to the price increase – by 14.3%.

Operating surplus / mixed income in agriculture went up by 15.5% as compared with the previous year, mainly due to the increase in subsidies (by 168 million).
