



CRÈCHES IN 2015


The number of detached crèches and groups in kindergartens functioning in the country as of 31.12.2015 was 812 with 32 040 places in them (Table 1). The number of places in the country has increased with 1 516, or with 5.0% compared to the previous year.

There were 682 crèches in urban areas with 29 657 places and 130 crèches with 2 383 places in rural areas respectively.

The total number of places in crèches per 100 children aged up to 3 years as of 31.12.2015 was 16.2 (Figure 1). The highest values were registered in districts Gabrovo (26.3 per 100 children), Blagoevgrad (23.7 per 100 children) and Vratsa (22.1 per 100 children). Lowest values were indicated for districts: Sliven (8.7 per 100 children), Pazardzhik (10.2 per 100 children) and Kardzhali (10.7 per 100 children).


The number of children new entrants in detached crèches and groups in kindergartens in 2015 was 29 576 or 521 children more than the children new entrants in the previous year. 32 124 children were accommodated there at the end of the year (Table 2). 16 497 of them were boys, and - 15 627 girls. In comparison with 2014 the number of children accommodated in crèches has increased by 2.0%.


Figure 2. Structure of children accommodated in crèches as of 31.12.2015 by age

The distribution of children raised in crèches by age remains without changes in 2015. The highest was the share of children aged 2 years - 79.6%, the smallest was the share of children aged up to 1 year - 0.1% (Figure 2).

The coverage¹ of children brought up in crèches at the end of 2015 was 16.2%, as it has increased by 0.4% compared to previous year. The coverage of children aged 2 years was 38.3 % and the coverage of children aged 1 year at the end of 2015 was 8.1% (Figure 3).

7 574 medical and non-medical specialists were working on a basic labour contract in crèches at the end of 2015 in order to raise, educate and train the children. The number of medical specialists on Health care was 3 850, as 93.9% of them were nurses (3 615) (Table 3).

¹ The indicator was expressed by ratio of the number of children aged up to 3 years brought up in detached crèches and groups in kindergartens per 100 of children of the same age group of the total population.



Methodological notes

The survey 'Crèches' is an exhaustive survey carried out by the National Statistical Institute annually. Detached crèches as well as groups in kindergartens are covered.

Sources of data are detached crèches and groups in kindergartens. Data on personnel, places in crèches and number of children as well as their distribution by age are collected.

Crèches are set up to support families in raising children up to the age of three years and to ensure their normal physical and mental development in accordance with the Law on Health and Ordinance № 26/18.11.2008 of the Minister of Health. Crèches are organizationally distinct structures, where medical and other specialists raise, educate and train children aged from three months to three years.

Groups for children aged between 3 months and 3 years could be opened at daily and weekly kindergartens as the organization of work there do not differ from the work of detached crèches.
