


BULGARIAN TRADE WITH EU FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY - MAY 2013 (PRELIMINARY DATA)

In the period **January - May 2013** the Bulgarian **exports to the EU** increased by 7.5% compared to the corresponding period of the previous year and amounted to 10.2 Billion Levs (Annex, Table 1 and 2). Main trade partners of Bulgaria were Germany, Italy, Romania, Greece and France which accounted for 69.7% of the exports to the EU Member States (Annex, Table 3).

In **May 2013** the exports to the EU decreased by 12.0% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 1.9 Billion Levs.

Figure 1. Nominal value¹ change of exports of Bulgaria to EU for the period 2012 – 2013 (Compared to the same month of the previous year)





Bulgarian **imports from the EU** in the period January - May 2013 increased by 0.5% compared to the corresponding period of the previous year and added up to 11.9 Billion Levs at CIF prices (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). The largest amounts were reported for the goods imported from Germany, Italy, Romania, Greece and Spain (Annex, Table 3).

In **May** 2013 the Bulgarian imports from the EU Member States decreased by 11.6% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 2.4 Billion Levs at CIF prices.

The **foreign trade balance** of Bulgaria (export FOB - import CIF) **with EU** in the period January – May 2013 was negative and added up to 1 685.5 Million Levs (Annex, Table 1). At FOB/FOB prices (after elimination of transport and insurance costs on imports) the trade balance was also negative and amounted to 1 215.1 Million Levs.

In the first five months of **2013** compared to the corresponding period of the previous year the largest growth (28.5%) **in the exports** of Bulgaria **to EU** distributed according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Annex, Table 4) was recorded in the section "Beverages and tobacco". The most notable fall (8.9%) was recorded in section "Food and live animals".

In imports from EU the largest increase (8.2%) was reported in section "Chemical and related products n.e.c." while the most notable fall (6.6%) was observed in the section "Machinery and transport equipment".
