



BULGARIAN TRADE WITH EU IN THE PERIOD JANUARY - JULY 2015 (PRELIMINARY DATA)

In the period **January - July 2015** Bulgarian **exports to the EU** increased by 10.1% compared to the corresponding period of 2014 and amounted to 16.8 Billion BGN (Annex, Table 1 and 2). Main trade partners of Bulgaria were Germany, Italy, Romania, Greece, France and Belgium which accounted for 70.6% of the exports to the EU Member States (Annex, Table 3).

In **July** 2015 the exports to the EU decreased by 0.5% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 2.6 Billion BGN.




Figure 1. Nominal value¹ change of exports of Bulgaria to EU in the period 2014 - 2015 (Compared to the same month of the previous year)

Bulgarian **imports from the EU** in the period January - July 2015 increased by 8.5% compared to the same period of 2014 and added up to 19.2 Billion BGN at CIF prices (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). The largest amounts were reported for the goods imported from Germany, Italy, Romania, Spain and Greece (Annex, Table 3).

In **July** 2015 the Bulgarian imports from the EU Member States increased by 12.2% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 3.1 Billion BGN at CIF prices.



The **foreign trade balance** of Bulgaria (export FOB - import CIF) **with** the **EU** in the period January - July 2015 was negative and added up to 2 417.1 Million BGN (Annex, Table 1). At FOB/FOB prices (after elimination of transport and insurance costs on imports) the trade balance was also negative and amounted to 1 118.1 Million BGN.

In the first seven months of **2015** compared to the same period of 2014 the largest growth **in the exports** of Bulgaria to the **EU** distributed according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Annex, Table 4) was recorded in the sections 'Crude materials, inedible (except fuel)' (17.2%) and 'Chemical and related products n.e.c.' (16.5%). Fall was recorded in section 'Beverages and tobacco' (6.8%).

In **imports from** the **EU** the largest growths were reported in the sections 'Beverages and tobacco' (17.7%) and 'Crude materials, inedible (except fuel)' (16.5%) while the most notable fall was observed in section 'Mineral fuel, lubricants and related materials' (25.8%).
