




## BULGARIAN TRADE WITH EU FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY - SEPTEMBER 2011 (PRELIMINARY DATA)

In the period **January - September 2011** the Bulgarian **exports** to the **EU** increased by 34.6% compared to the corresponding period of the previous year and amounted to 18.1 billion leva (Table 1.1 and 1.2). The main trade partners of Bulgaria were Germany, Romania, Italy, Greece and Belgium, that formed 67.0 % of the total exports to the EU Member states (Table 2). The most significant growths were observed in the exports to Malta and Denmark. Falls were registered in the exports to Slovenia.

In **September 2011** the exports to the EU increased by 22.7% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and exceeded 2.0 billion leva.

(Compared to the same month of the previous year)**




Bulgarian **imports** from the **EU** in the period **January - September 2011** increased by 20.5% compared to the corresponding period of the previous year and amounted to 18.7 billion leva at CIF prices (Tables 1.1 and 1.2). The most significant growths were reported on the imports from Cyprus (Table 2). Decreases were observed in the imports from Finland, Portugal and Denmark.

In **September 2011** the Bulgarian imports from the EU Member States increased by 10.3% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and exceeded 2.1 billion leva at CIF prices.

The **foreign trade balance** of Bulgaria (export FOB - import CIF) with EU in the period January - September 2011 was negative and amounted to 631.8 million leva (Table 1.1). At FOB/FOB prices (after elimination of transport and insurance costs on imports) the trade balance was positive and amounted to 221.6 million leva.

The **exports** of Bulgaria to the EU distributed according to the **Standard International Trade Classification**, increased in all sections in the first nine months of 2011 compared to the corresponding period of the previous year (Table 3). The largest growths were recorded in the sections “Crude materials, inedible (except fuels)”<sup>1</sup>, “Chemical and related products”, and „Animal and vegetable oils, fats and waxes”<sup>2</sup>

The largest growths **on imports** from EU were reported in sections “Crude materials, inedible (except fuels)” and „Animal and vegetable oils, fats and waxes”. Falls were reported in section “Mineral fuels, lubricant and related materials”.
