




## BULGARIAN TRADE WITH EU FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY - SEPTEMBER 2012 (PRELIMINARY DATA)

In the period **January - September 2012** the Bulgarian **exports to the EU** decreased by 2.6% compared to the corresponding period of the previous year and amounted to 17.8 Billion Levs (Annex, Table 1 and 2). The main trade partners of Bulgaria were Germany, Italy, Romania, Greece, France and Belgium that formed 70.8% of the exports to the EU Member States (Annex, Table 3).

In September 2012 the exports to the EU decreased by 4.8% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 2.1 Billion Levs.

(Compared to the same month of the previous year)**




Bulgarian **imports from the EU** in the period January - September 2012 increased by 10.4% compared to the corresponding period of the previous year and added up to 21.7 Billion Levs at CIF prices (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). The largest amounts were reported for the goods imported from Germany, Italy, Romania, Greece and Spain (Annex, Table 3).

In September 2012 the Bulgarian imports from the EU Member States decreased by 2.5% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and added up to 2.3 Billion Levs at CIF prices.

The **foreign trade balance** of Bulgaria (export FOB - import CIF) **with EU** in the period January – September 2012 was negative and added up to 3 882.0 Million Levs (Annex, Table 1). At FOB/FOB prices (after elimination of transport and insurance costs on imports) the trade balance was also negative and amounted to 3 031.0 Million Levs.

In the **first nine months of 2012** compared to the corresponding period of the previous year the largest growth (40.4%) **in the exports** of Bulgaria **to EU** distributed according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Annex, Table 4) was recorded in the section “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” and the most notable fall (29.8%) - in section “Crude materials, inedible (except fuels)”<sup>2</sup>.

In **imports from EU** the largest increase (49.8%) was reported in section “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” while a decrease (10.3%) was observed in section “Crude materials, inedible (except fuels)”.
