




## BUILDING PERMITS ISSUED AND CONSTRUCTION OF NEW BUILDINGS STARTED IN THE FIRST QUARTER OF 2020

In the first quarter of 2020, the municipal authorities issued **building permits** for construction of 1 351 residential buildings with 6 317 dwellings and 815 293 sq. m gross building area, of 22 administrative buildings/offices with 64 183 sq. m gross building area and 883 other buildings with 472 160 sq. m gross building area.

As compared to the previous quarter the issued building permits for residential buildings decreased by 10.6%, their dwellings - by 15.5% and the gross building area - by 9.0%. The number of issued building permits of administrative buildings rose by 4.8% and their gross building area - by 204.9%. The issued building permits for other buildings fell by 19.9% and their gross building area - by 22.6%.

Figure 1. Building permits issued for construction of new buildings by type and quarter








As compared to the first quarter of 2019 the issued building permits for new residential buildings increased by 8.3%, while their dwellings decreased by 19.3% and the gross building area - by 21.1%. The number of issued building permits of administrative buildings and their gross building area registered a drop by 21.4% and 4.8% respectively. The issued building permits for other buildings fell by 23.2% and their gross building area - by 15.7%.

The highest number of building permits for new residential buildings was issued in the following districts: Sofia (stolitsa) - 227, Plovdiv - 201, Varna - 153, Sofia - 113 and Burgas - 87. Most dwellings are to be built in the districts: Sofia (stolitsa) - 2 512, Plovdiv - 701, Varna - 680, Burgas - 676 and Kardzhali - 236 (Annex, Table 1).





In the first quarter of 2020 **began the construction** of 847 residential buildings with 4 454 dwellings and 529 686 sq. m gross building area, of 12 administrative buildings/offices with 4 873 sq. m gross building area and of 545 other buildings with 510 416 sq. m gross building area.

As compared to the previous quarter the started residential buildings decreased by 14.7%, their dwellings - by 22.8%, and the gross building area - by 22.4%. The number of started administrative buildings grew by 9.1%, but their gross building area declined by 58.6%. The started other buildings fell by 11.2%, while their gross building area increased by 23.2%.





Figure 3. Started construction of new buildings by type and quarter

As compared to the first quarter of 2019 the started new residential buildings decreased by 2.8%, their dwellings - by 0.6% and their gross building area - by 15.4%. The number of started administrative buildings and their gross building area registered a drop by 29.4% and 84.1% respectively. The started other buildings fell by 15.4% and their gross building area - by 11.0%.

The construction of the highest number of new buildings were started in the following districts: Plovdiv - 146 residential buildings and 70 other buildings; Sofia (stolitsa) - 136 residential buildings, 4 administrative buildings and 22 other buildings; Stara Zagora - 52 residential buildings and 76 other buildings; Burgas - 94 residential buildings and 32 other buildings; Varna - 76 residential buildings and 18 other buildings (Annex, Table 2).





## Methodological notes

The quarterly statistical survey of permits issued for construction collects information about building permits, issued by municipal authorities as well as for the started construction of new buildings according to their type and gross building area. This information may be used as an indicator of future construction activity of enterprises in the country.

**Type of buildings** is classified according to the Classification of types of construction (CC) and is divided into:

- Residential buildings for which the useful floor area is mostly used for permanent residential habitation.
- Non-residential buildings for various purposes, including:
- administrative offices and buildings for administrative work of departments and other organizations and associations (representative buildings banks, post offices, government department offices, conference and congress centres, low courts, municipalities);
- other buildings buildings used for different activities: production, trade, transport, education, cultural, sports, agriculture, health, recreation and facilities for short stay (hotels, motels, rest houses, huts and others).

**Gross building area -** a sum of all floors areas in external dimensions.
