
BUILDING PERMITS ISSUED AND CONSTRUCTION OF NEW BUILDINGS STARTED IN THE SECOND QUARTER OF 2022

In the second quarter of 2022, the municipal authorities issued **building permits** for the construction of 2 249 residential buildings with 13 810 dwellings and 1 692 823 sq. m gross building area, 20 administrative buildings/offices with 23 464 sq. m gross building area and 1 164 other buildings with 697 715 sq. m gross building area.


As compared to the previous quarter, the issued building permits for residential buildings increased by 21.6%, the number of their dwellings - by 45.5% and the gross building area - by 44.5%. The issued building permits for administrative buildings have shown an increase of 11.1% and their gross building area increased by 39.9%. Issued building permits for other buildings rose by 8.7% and their gross building area - by 21.8%.

As compared to the second quarter of 2021, the issued building permits for new residential buildings increased by 28.9%, their dwellings - by 38.8% and the gross building area - by 43.3%. The issued building permits for administrative buildings and their gross building area decreased by 23.1 and 47.7%, respectively. The issued building permits for other buildings fell by 4.1%, while their gross building area went up by 55.4%.

The highest number of building permits for new residential buildings was issued in the following districts: Plovdiv - 399, Sofia (stolitsa) - 338, Sofia - 243, Varna - 203 and Burgas - 153. Most dwellings are to be built in the districts: Sofia (stolitsa) - 5 984, Varna - 2 380, Plovdiv - 1 820, Burgas - 614 and Blagoevgrad - 409 (Annex, Table 1).

In the second quarter of 2022, **began the construction** of 1 388 residential buildings with 7 202 dwellings and 924 818 sq. m gross building area, 11 administrative buildings/offices with 10 095 sq. m gross building area and 604 other buildings with 504 069 sq. m gross building area.

As compared to the previous quarter, the started residential buildings increased by 9.4%, the gross building area - by 17.4%, while their dwellings decreased by 5.9%. The number of started administrative buildings was unchanged, but their gross building area increased by 24.8%. The started other buildings rose by 5.6%, with 13.9% growth in their gross building area.





Figure 3. Started construction of new buildings by type and quarter

As compared to the second quarter of 2021, the number of started new residential buildings decreased by 1.6%, while their dwellings increased by 20.2% and the gross building area - by 17.9%. The number of started administrative buildings was down by 47.6% and their gross building area - by 49.3%. The construction of 5.9% fewer other buildings was started, but with a 20.2% larger gross building area.

The construction of the highest number of new buildings was started in the following districts: Plovdiv - 233 residential buildings and 65 other buildings; Sofia (stolitsa) - 220 residential buildings, 4 administrative buildings and 25 other buildings; Sofia - 145 residential buildings and 27 other buildings; Burgas - 117 residential buildings and 38 other buildings; Varna - 110 residential buildings and 30 other buildings (Annex, Table 2).



Methodological notes

The quarterly statistical survey of permits issued for construction collects information about building permits issued by municipal authorities as well as for the started construction of new buildings according to their type and gross building area. This information may be used as an indicator of the future construction activity of enterprises in the country.

Types of buildings are classified according to the Classification of types of construction (CC) and are divided into:

- Residential buildings for which the useful floor area is mostly used for permanent residential habitation.
- Non-residential buildings for various purposes, including:
- administrative offices and buildings for administrative work of departments and other organizations and associations (representative buildings banks, post offices, government department offices, conference and congress centres, low courts, municipalities);
- other buildings buildings used for different activities: production, trade, transport, education, culture, sports, agriculture, health, recreation and facilities for a short stay (hotels, motels, rest houses, huts and others).

Gross building area - a sum of all floors' areas in external dimensions.
