PRODUCTION AND DELIVERIES OF ENERGY PRODUCTS, DECEMBER 2022

In December 2022, compared to the previous month, for the production of energy products, the largest increase was observed in solid fuels - by 5.8%, and electricity - by 4.5%, and the largest decrease was registered in liquefied petroleum gases - by 25.0%.

In December 2022, compared to the previous month, for the deliveries of energy products was observed an increase in all energy products. The largest increase was observed in liquefied petroleum gases - by 34.1%, natural gas - by 26.1%, as well as in electricity - by 17.1%.

Production of energy products

In December 2022, compared to November 2022, an increase is reported for the production of:

- solid fuels by 5.8% to 3 283 thousand tonnes;
- electricity by 4.5% to 4 383 GWh.

A decrease is reported for the production of:

- liquefied petroleum gases by 25.0% to 6 thousand tonnes;
- transport diesel by 20.4% to 246 thousand tonnes;
- unleaded motor gasoline by 3.1% to 156 thousand tonnes.

No change for the production of natural gas (Annex, Table 1).

In December 2022, compared to the same month of the previous year, during which planned repairs of production installations were carried out, the production of liquefied petroleum gases and unleaded motor gasoline increased significantly, as well as:

- transport diesel by 43.0%;
- solid fuels by 1.3%.

A decrease is reported for the production of:

- natural gas by 50.0%;
- electricity by 12.6%.

Deliveries of energy products

In December 2022, compared to November 2022, an increase is reported for the deliveries of:

- liquefied petroleum gases by 34.1% to 55 thousand tonnes;
- natural gas by 26.1% to 280 million m³;
- electricity by 17.1% to 3 267 GWh;
- transport diesel by 16.1% to 238 thousand tonnes;
- unleaded motor gasoline by 15.8% to 44 thousand tonnes;
- solid fuels by 4.7% to 3 239 thousand tonnes.

No decrease is reported for any of the energy products (Annex, Table 2).



In December 2022, compared to the same month of the previous year, an increase is reported for the deliveries of:

- unleaded motor gasoline by 69.2%;
- liquefied petroleum gases by 44.7%;
- transport diesel by 13.9%.

A decrease is reported for the deliveries of:

- natural gas by 23.9%;
- electricity by 3.5%;
- solid fuels by 2.6%.

Methodological notes

The survey on energy products is conducted every month in accordance with Regulation (EC) No. 1099/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 October 2008 on energy statistics and its amendments. The survey aims to submit information on the production and inland deliveries of the main energy products - electricity, solid fuels, natural gas and petroleum products. The reporting units are producers, importers and exporters of energy products. Production and deliveries of energy products are the main observed indicators.

Solid fuels

Production - includes Hard coal, Lignite and Solid fuels from coal. Producers report quantities calculated after any operation for the removal of inert matter.

Deliveries - quantities delivered to the internal market. They are equal to the total of the deliveries to the different types of consumers: producers' own use, main activity power stations, coking plants and patent fuel plants, industry, iron and steel industry and others.

Since 1.01.2017, Brown coal briquettes have been excluded from the monthly survey.

Petroleum products

Production - includes production of finished products at a refinery or blending plant.

Deliveries - wholesale deliveries to the domestic market of finished petroleum products from producers and importers/exporters.

Deliveries of petroleum products are defined as: primary product receipts + gross refinery output + recycled products - refinery fuel + imports - exports - international marine bunkers + interproduct transfers - products transferred - stock changes.

Natural gas

Production - includes all dry marketable production within national boundaries, including offshore production. Production is measured after purification and extraction of NGLs and sulfur. Excludes extraction losses and quantities reinjected, vented or flared. Includes quantities used within the natural gas industry; in gas extraction, pipeline systems and processing plants.

Deliveries - total natural gas, distributed for the internal market, including own use and losses.

Data are presented in million cubic meters assuming reference gas conditions 15°C and 101.325 kPa. To convert quantities from cubic meters at 20°C to cubic meters at 15°C - according to the reporting requirements of Regulation (EC) No. 1099/2008 of the European Parliament and the Council on energy statistics, we use a conversion factor of 0.98294.

Electricity



Production - includes produced electricity from Thermal power plants, Nuclear power plants, Hydropower plants, Pumped storage plants and electricity, obtained from wind generators and solar panels.

Deliveries/Total net consumption - the sum of the net produced electricity and net import, reduced by the amount used for pumped storage.

Figure 1. Production and deliveries of solid fuels




Figure 2. Production and deliveries of liquefied petroleum gases




Figure 3. Production and deliveries of unleaded motor gasoline




Figure 5. Production and deliveries of natural gas




Figure 6. Production and deliveries of electricity
