


TRADE IN GOODS OF BULGARIA IN 2023 - FINAL DATA

In **2023**, the **goods exported** from Bulgaria amounted to 86 903.6 million BGN or 6.5% less than in 2022 (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). In comparing monthly data for 2023 with the data for the corresponding month of the previous year, the highest growth in exports was observed in January (18.0%), while the biggest fall was registered in June (15.5%).

Figure 1. Nominal value¹ change of exports of goods from Bulgaria in the period 2022 - 2023






In the exports of goods from Bulgaria, distributed according to the Standard International Trade Classification, in 2023 compared to 2022, the largest growth was reported in the section 'Beverages and tobacco' (18.0%). The biggest fall was observed in section 'Animal and vegetable oils, fats and waxes' (49.9%) (Annex, Table 4).

The imported goods in 2023 were for 97 073.0 million BGN (at CIF prices)¹, which is 10.0% less than the previous year (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). Analyzing the monthly data on imports in 2023 and the corresponding ones in 2022, the biggest increase was observed in January (6.5%), while the biggest decrease was registered in June (22.4%).

In the imports of goods to Bulgaria, distributed according to the **Standard** International Trade Classification, in 2023 compared to the previous year, the largest growth was registered in the section 'Beverages and tobacco' (14.9%). The biggest fall was observed in section 'Animal and vegetable oils, fats and waxes' (45.1%)(Annex, Table 4).

Foreign trade balance (exports FOB - import CIF) was negative in 2023 and amounted to 10 169.4 million BGN (Annex, Tables 1 and 2).



Trade in goods of Bulgaria with the EU

In 2023, the **exports** of goods from Bulgaria **to the EU countries** decreased by 9.0% compared to the previous year and amounted to 55 155.0 million BGN (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). Main trade partners of Bulgaria were Germany, Romania, Italy, Greece, France and Belgium, which accounted for 66.0% of the exports to the EU (Annex, Table 3).

Figure 3. Nominal value¹ change of exports of goods from Bulgaria to EU in the period 2022 - 2023






In the exports of goods from Bulgaria to the EU, distributed according to the **Standard International Trade Classification**, in 2023 compared to 2022, the largest growth was registered in section 'Beverages and tobacco' (11.0%). The biggest fall was observed in section 'Animal and vegetable oils, fats and waxes' (63.6%) (Annex, Table 4).

The **imports** of goods to Bulgaria **from the EU countries** in 2023 decreased by 2.5% compared to 2022 and amounted to 58 140.2 million BGN (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). The most significant amounts were reported for the goods imported from Germany, Romania, Italy, Greece and the Netherlands, which represent 57.4% from the imports from the EU.

In the imports of goods from the EU, distributed according to the **Standard International Trade Classification**, in 2023 compared to the previous year, the largest growth was registered in section 'Beverages and tobacco' (15.5%). The biggest fall was observed in section 'Mineral fuel, lubricants and related materials' (60.5%) (Annex, Table 4).

Foreign trade balance (exports FOB - import CIF) of Bulgaria with the EU countries in 2023 was negative and amounted to 2 985.2 million BGN (Annex, Table 1).



Bulgarian trade in goods with third countries

In 2023, the **exports** of goods from Bulgaria **to third countries** decreased by 1.8% compared to the previous year and added up to 31 748.6 million BGN (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). Leading trade partners of Bulgaria were Türkiye, the United States, China, Serbia, the Republic of North Macedonia, Ukraine and the United Kingdom, which accounted for 51.1% of the total exports to non-EU countries (Annex, Table 3).

Figure 5. Nominal value¹ change of exports of goods from Bulgaria to non-EU countries in the period 2022 - 2023



The **imports** of goods to Bulgaria **from third countries** in 2023 decreased by 19.4% compared to 2022 and amounted to 38 932.8 million BGN (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). The largest amounts were reported for the goods imported from Türkiye, the Russian Federation, China, Serbia and Ukraine, whose share amounted to 61.7% of the total imports from non-EU countries.

Foreign trade balance of Bulgaria (export FOB - import CIF) with third countries in 2023 was negative and amounted to 7 184.2 million BGN (Annex, Table 1).

Methodological Notes

Legislative Framework

Regulation (EU) 2019/2152 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 November 2019 on European business statistics (including intra-EU trade in goods). Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/1197 of 30 July 2020 laying down technical specifications and rules pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2019/2152 of the European Parliament and of the Council on European business statistics.

Regulation (EU) 2019/2152 of the European Parliament and of the Council by further specifying the details of the statistical information to be provided by tax and customs authorities, and amending Annexes V and VI thereof (text relevant to the EEA).

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2022/1225 of 27 July 2022 laying down the rules for data exchange pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2019/2152 of the European Parliament and of the Council and amending Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/1197 regarding the member country of extra-EU export and the obligations of reporting units.

Scope and Basic Terminology

External trade in goods covers trade with third countries (Extrastat) and with EU member states (Intrastat), with detailed statistical information collected at the commodity code level (8 digits) of the Combined Nomenclature.

Imports include all goods entering the statistical territory* of the Republic of Bulgaria from other countries intended for domestic consumption, processing in the country for export after processing, as well as imports of goods processed outside the country. **Exports** include all goods leaving the statistical territory of the Republic of Bulgaria intended for normal export to another country. This includes goods returned to the trading partner after processing in Bulgaria or goods exported for processing in another country with the intention of being returned to Bulgaria.

The **statistical territory of the European Union (EU)**, in the context of international trade in goods statistics, corresponds to the combined customs territories of the EU member states with one exception: unlike the customs territory, the statistical territory of Germany includes Helgoland.

Statistical volumes of imports and exports do not include imported goods placed under customs warehousing without processing, nor do exports include the re-export of these goods.

International trade statistics do not account for the transit of goods through the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria.

Main Sources of Information

Customs declaration - Single Administrative Document (SAD), which is filled out by all entities importing or exporting goods to/from third countries.

Intrastat declaration for intra-EU imports and exports to/from EU member states. The Customs Agency is the institution responsible for collecting customs declarations (SAD), and the National Revenue Agency is responsible for Intrastat declarations. Trade estimates are made to compensate for the impact of thresholds below which traders are exempt from submitting Intrastat declarations, as well as for those who have not responded.
