

The Statistical Yearbook (89th edition) is the main publication of the National Statistical Institute. It provides domestic and international users with compound information about the demographic, social and economic development of Bulgaria for the 2016 - 2020 period.

Information sources are statistical surveys carried out by the NSI and other offices and institutions being bodies of statistics.

The statistical information presents the country as a whole (General Review) and it is also given at a regional level (Regional Review) according to the administrative division of Bulgaria (28 districts) and to the Classification of the Territorial Units for Statistics in Bulgaria (2 statistical zones and 6 statistical regions).

The Yearbook is designed thematically by chapters and each chapter is preceded by an introductory text with methodological notes.

A chapter containing time series by main indicators about demographic, social and economic development of Bulgaria for the 2004 - 2020 period is presented at the beginning of the General Review.

Along with information about Bulgaria, the Statistical Yearbook also contains an International Review Section with latest data for other countries available at the NSI at the date of preparation of the publication. This data enable users to work out international comparative analyses.

Information on the activity of regional, distirct and military courts and since 2012 - of the Special Criminal Court on penal trials of general, private and administrative character is also included. Comparable data on crimes with penalty inflicted as well on persons convicted with sentences which have come into force for the 1990 - 2021 period are also shown.

The issue contains basic methodological notes and an analysis on crimes with penalty inflicted as well on persons convicted with sentences come into force.

The information is systematized in two sections: General Review and Regional Review in accordance with the Law for Administrative-territorial Structure of the Republic of Bulgaria (28 districts) and the Classification of the Territorial Units for Statistical purposes in Bulgaria (2 statistical zones and 6 statistical regions).

The electronic bilingual (Bulgarian/English) publication 'Regions, districts and municipalities in the Republic of Bulgaria 2020' is a continuation of the annual NSI electronic publications containing regional data. The publication contains data for the demographic, socio-economic and environmental condition of Bulgaria's regions, districts and municipalities in 2020.

The statistical information is provided at national and regional level. The most important indicators are included in order to outline the specifics of the territorial units. Administrative-territorial units, are presented in accordance with the Territorial Organization Act of the Republic of Bulgaria, and territorial units for statistical purposes - 'statistical zones' and 'statistical regions' are elaborated according to the Classification of territorial units for statistics (NUTS).

HOUSEHOLD BUDGETS IN THE REPUBLIC OF BULGARIA 2021

The edition contains data from the sample survey of the household budgets in Bulgaria for the 2012 - 2021 period. The survey has been conducted quarterly. Every quarter are surveyed 3 060 households.

The publication presents the results from the survey of households and their members by socio-demographic characteristics, amount of income by sources, amount of expenditure by purpose, consumption of basic foods, calorie contents of consumed basic foods.

The results are presented in groups by the following characteristics - place of residence of the household, size of the household, number of employed persons in the household, number of children in the household, total annual income per person of the household, presence of pensioners in the household, professional and socio-economic status of the head of the household and deciles groups.



AVERAGE PRICES AND PURCHASED QUANTITIES OF MAIN FOODS AND NON-FOODS BY HOUSEHOLDS FOR THE 2010 - 2021 PERIOD

The publication contains data on average prices and purchased quantities of main foods and non-foods by households by years for the 2010 - 2021 period and by quarters for 2021. The used information is obtained from the household budget survey and because of that these average prices differ from the average consumer prices published by the NSI. The purchased quantities foods are computed average per household and the purchased quantities non-food goods - average per 100 households.

There are also data on the purchasing power of households calculated by means of total and monetary income, as well as the changes in the purchased power.

EMPLOYMENT AND UNEMPLOYMENT - ANNUAL DATA 2021

The publication contains average annual data from the Labour Force Survey. It is a sample statistical survey among private households which provides detailed annual and quarterly information on the labour status (employment, unemployment, inactivity) of population aged 15 years and over.

The main definitions used in the survey follow the ILO and Eurostat recommendations.

The publication consists of:

- Methodological notes;
- Average annual data on main indicators for the 2015 2021 period;
- Data on labour force, employment, unemployment and inactivity in 2021, broken down by sex, age, educational attainment, statistical regions etc.;
- Data on main indicators for FU member states

Data are systematized in two sections:

- Book Publishing (books, pamphlets and digital editions);
- Continued Editions (newspapers, magazines, bulletins, periodical collections and others). Data on other continued editions (of which: reports, accounts, reference books) has been published since 2007.

Data on issued books, pamphlets and newspapers by title and an annual circulation, and by type and number of appearances are presented at national level as well as by statistical regions and by districts.

The issue includes data on basic statistical indicators about enrolments and teaching staff in all types and levels of education - pre-primary, basic and uppersecondary (general and vocational programmes) and tertiary.

The issue presents data about the enrolment rate of the population and the educational institutions

The published information is systematized in two sections: General Review and Regional Review.

The basic methodological concepts in the field of statistics of education are harmonized with the International Standard Classification of Education, revision 2011 (ISCED 2011).

The publication is a joint edition of the National Statistical Institute and National Centre on Public Health and Analyses at the Ministry of Health. The data sources are the annual statistical surveys carried out by the both institutions and included in the National Statistical Programme.

Data in the publication are systematized as follows:

- Population and demographic processes main demographic indicators, deaths by causes:
- Morbidity of population incidence and prevalence of some socially significant diseases:
- Health care system resources health establishments; medical personnel in health establishments; crèches and others;
- · Activities of the hospitals.

The edition contains time series with data on previous years. In a territorial aspect the information is presented by districts. Some main demographic indicators are given by municipalities.

The publication contains data on energy statistics for the 2014 - 2020 period obtained from the current surveys of the National Statistical Institute.

The publication presents also detailed information on: Commodity energy balances; Overall energy balance; Primary energy production; Gross inland energy consumption; Transformation input/output; Final energy consumption; Specific conversion factors.

The overall energy balance sheets for 2019 and 2020 are presented in three matrixes: Primary energy; Transformed energy; Final energy consumption, according to Eurostat's methodology.

Tables with international comparisons for main energy indicators are included in publication.
