




## Industrial Production Indices in September 2011<sup>1</sup>

The preliminary data showed that the Industrial Production Index<sup>2</sup>, seasonally adjusted<sup>3</sup>, increased by 1.0% in September 2011 as compared to August 2011.

In September 2011 working day adjusted<sup>4</sup> Industrial Production Index rose by 1.5% as compared to the same month of 2010.

<sup>2</sup> Monthly Industrial Production and Industrial turnover indices measure changes in **production and turnover values** of industrial enterprises. This information can be used to assess the current economic development and for short-term forecasts. Indices do not measure the actual production level, it aims to measure the average change in value of production between two points of time

Indices are compiled on the base of information collected through representative sampling survey on industrial enterprises. The sample covers enterprises with annual turnover more than 97% of total turnover in industry.

Industrial production indices are calculated at constant base year (2005) that is to say they are weighted with the structure of the value added at factor costs in the base year.

<sup>3</sup> **Seasonal adjustment** is a statistical method, which eliminates the seasonal component of time series and it is particularly suitable for long-term comparisons and analysis of the data.

<sup>4</sup> **Working day adjustment** is an adjustment for variations caused by calendar effects, different number of calendar and working days in the months, national holidays and outliers (for example the presence of more non-working days in May could contribute to the decline in the production in some activities).




### Monthly comparisons

In September 2011 as compared to August 2011, the seasonally adjusted Industrial Production Index in the mining and quarrying industry increased by 10.2%, in the manufacturing by 3.7%, while in the electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply - decreased by 7.2%.

The most significant increases of production in the manufacturing were seen in the repair and installation of machinery and equipment by 40.8%, in the manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery and equipment by 14.7%, in the manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products by 9.2%, in the manufacture of machinery and equipment by 6.5%, in the manufacture of beverages by 5.0%. There was decrease in the manufacture of textiles by 14.3%, in the manufacture of basic metals by 11.1%, in the manufacture of tobacco products by 6.8%.

**Figure 2. Percentage changes of Industrial Production Indices compared to the previous month (seasonally adjusted)**






### Annual comparisons

On annual bases in September 2011 Industrial Production Index, calculated from working day adjusted data in the mining and quarrying industry grew by 7.7%, in the manufacturing by 2.7%, while in the electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply a decrease by 5.1% was seen.

Increases were registered in the production of investment goods by 14.1%, in the production of energy by 2.1% and in the production of intermediate goods by 0.4%.
