



TRIPS OF BULGARIAN RESIDENTS ABROAD AND ARRIVALS OF VISITORS FROM ABROAD TO BULGARIA IN SEPTEMBER 2012




Figure 1. Trips of Bulgarian residents abroad by months

In September 2012 **the number of the trips of Bulgarian residents abroad** was 334.0 thousand as compared to August 2012 and September 2011 a decrease was registered by 19.1% and 8.7% respectively (Figure 1). In comparison with the same month of the previous year a decrease in the total number of the trips of Bulgarian residents was reported to: Serbia - by 56.2%, Turkey - by 45.4% and Greece - by 13.9%. At the same time an increase was observed to: Austria - by 159.4%, Romania - by 52.3%, Spain - by 37.1%, Germany - 30.8% and etc (Annex, Table 1).


The trips with other purposes (as guest, education and visit the cultural and sport events) composed the greatest share of the total number of trips of Bulgarian residents abroad - 48.7%, followed by the trips with holiday and recreation purposes - 29.2% and with professional purpose - 22.1%. In comparison with September 2011 an increase in the trips with other purposes was observed - by 25.4%, while a decrease was registered in the trips with professional purposes, as well as these with holiday and recreation purpose - by 46.4% and 1.0% respectively.

In September 2012 the trips with other purposes formed 63.5% from all trips to Greece, 60.3% - to Serbia and 50.9% - to Germany. Predominated share of the trips to Turkey and FYROM was with holiday and recreation purpose - 53.3% and 39.7% respectively, while to Belgium and Austria they were connected with professional purpose - 74.4% and 53.1% respectively of all trips of Bulgarian residents to these countries (Figure 2).




Figure 3. Arrivals of visitors from abroad to Bulgaria by months

In September 2012, **the number of arrivals of visitors from abroad to Bulgaria** was 1 082.4 thousand which was by 33.9% less compared to August 2012 but it was by 3.2% above the level from September 2011 (Figure 3). An increase in the visit by all observed purposes was registered, as the greatest was the growth in the visits with holiday and recreation purpose - by 5.0%, followed by these with professional purpose - by 4.4%, and with other purposes - by 0.4%.

The visits of the citizens of European Union composed the greatest relative share of the total number of foreigners visited Bulgaria - 67.3%, followed by citizens from the other European countries - 25.7% (Annex, Table 2). In comparison with the same month of the previous year the arrivals of visitors from EU Member States decreased by 1.9%. A significant decrease was observed in the visits of the citizens from Denmark - by 16.2%, Finland - by 16.2%, Netherlands - by 15.1% and Germany - by 10.2%. However a growth in the visits from Spain - by 19.4%, Belgium - by 8.2%, Slovenia - by 8.1% and Italy - by 7.1% was registered.

The visits of foreigners in the group "Other European countries" increased by 19.9% as the highest growth was observed from Ukraine, Turkey, and Serbia - by 36.0%, 34.3% and 22.5% respectively.

In September 2012 the predominated share of the total number of the visits to Bulgaria were with holiday and recreation purpose - 50.2%, followed by the arrivals with other purposes (including as guest and passing transit) - 36.8% and with professional purpose - 13.0%.

The visits with holiday and recreation purpose formed 80.6% of the arrivals from Russia, 78.0% - from FYROM and 72.3% - from Germany. The visits with professional purpose were 35.9% of all arrivals from Italy, while with other purpose were 80.0% of the arrivals from Turkey and 56.3% - from Romania (Figure 4).



Methodological notes

Statistical data on the trips of Bulgarian citizens travelling abroad and visits by foreigners in Bulgaria are obtained on the basis of monthly information received from the Ministry of Interior and sample survey of the National Statistical Institute among Bulgarian and foreign citizens passing the border check points.

Data on the number of the trips of the citizens of the European Union are estimated on the basis of the information obtained from the Ministry of Interior and the airport authorities. Data on the number of citizens of "third countries" are obtained directly from the Ministry of Interior.

Data on the purposes of the trips are developed on the basis of the NSI's regular monthly sample survey of passing Bulgarian and foreign citizens on the border check points.
