



## ACTIVITY OF ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS IN JANUARY 2013


Since 2012 the survey on accommodation establishments has been carried out monthly in compliance with the Regulation 692/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning European statistics on tourism and the regulation 1051/2011 of the Commission implementing Regulation 692/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning European statistics on tourism, as regards the structure of the quality reports and the transmission of the data.

In January 2013, 1 791 accommodation establishments - hotels, motels, camping sites, mountain chalets and other establishments for short-term accommodation with more than 10 bed places were functioned in the country (Annex, Table 1). The total number of the rooms in them was 52.0 thousands and the bed-places were 103.4 thousands. In comparison with January 2012 the total number of accommodation establishments increased by 8.0% and the bed-places in them - by 3.9%.

The total number of the nights spent in all accommodation establishments amounted to 644.1 thousands or by 5.0% more in comparison with the same month of the previous year as the nights spent in 1 and 2 or 3 stars accommodation establishments increased by 12.7% while in 4 and 5 stars hotels a decrease by 2.8% was registered.

In January 2013 the foreign citizens realized 63.6% from all nights spent by them in 4 and 5 stars hotels, while by Bulgarians they were 29.9%. In 3 stars accommodation establishments were spent 36.2% by nights of Bulgarian residents and 22.3% - by foreigners, while in the rest of accommodation with 1 and 2 stars these share were 34.0 and 14.0% respectively.


**Figure 1. The nights spent in accommodation establishments by categories and by months**





Compared to January 2012 the arrivals in all accommodation establishments in January 2013 increased by 7.6% and reached 261.4 thousands. The Bulgarian guests were 64.9% of all arrivals as the majority part (68.9%) of them spent the nights in hotels 1 and 2 or 3 stars and spent 2.0 nights on the average. The arrivals of foreigners were 91.8 thousands as 64.3% of them spent nights in hotels with 4 and 5 stars. On the average 3.4 nights were spent by foreigners.


**Figure 2. Arrivals in accommodation establishments by categories in January 2013**



In January 2013, the total occupancy of the bed-places in accommodation establishments was 20.7% as the highest it was in 4 and 5 stars accommodation establishments - 32.1%, followed by these with 3 stars - 20.4% and with 1 and 2 stars - 12.4%. In comparison with the same month of the previous year the occupancy of the bed-places rose by 0.6 percentage points as the greatest increase was registered in the accommodation establishments with 3 stars - by 2.0 percentage points.




**Figure 3. The occupation of the bed-places in accommodation establishments by categories and by months**



The total revenues from nights spent in January 2013 reached 29.8 million BGN or by 0.8% more compared to January 2012. An increase was registered in the revenues from foreigners - by 7.7% while from the Bulgarians they decreased by 6.7%.

### Methodological notes

In the statistical survey of **accommodation establishments** were included all categorized hotels, camping sites and other type of accommodation establishments with more than 10 bed-places in use during the reporting period.

The indicator **other accommodation establishments** contained the holiday settlements, hostels, guests houses, bungalows, rest houses, mountain chalets, private rooms and flats and other establishments for short accommodation.

**Available Bed Capacity** is the maximum number of bed-places on offer for each day of the reference month.

In the **revenues from nights spent** in accommodation establishments are included the sums paid by the guests, without the extra services.
