



GOODS AND PASSENGERS CARRIED AND TRANSPORT PERFORMANCE BY MODE OF TRANSPORT IN THE SECOND QUARTER OF 2011


1. Land transport

1.1. Freight transport

According to the preliminary data of NSI, in the second quarter of 2011 the **transported goods** by land transport were 24 622.5 thousand tons or by 3 589.8 more compared to the same period of the previous year. The biggest increase was observed in the road freight transport by 19.8%, which represents 71.4% of the total growth.

The **transport performance**, measured in tonne-kilometres, also rose by 17.3% as compared to the second quarter of 2010 and reached 6 309.8 million tkm. Both by the transported goods and by the transport performance a growth in all types of land transport was observed. The highest increase was in the road freight transport with 734.5 million tkm and by the railway transport with 540.6 million tkm.

Figure 1. Transported goods and transport performance by the land transport




1.2. Passenger transport

The **transported passengers** by land transport during the period April – June were 133 025.2 thousand or by 2.7% less than the corresponding quarter of 2010 due to the less passengers carried by the bus transport. The international carriages rose by 1.6%, but the low share (0.3%) in the structure of the passengers carried did not influence the total trend.

The **transport performance** in passenger-kilometers registered growth by 4.1% compared to the second quarter of 2010, which is due the increased average distance travelled by the international carriages of the bus transport. An increase both in railway and in the bus transport was observed by 2.9 and 4.4% respectively.



Figure 2. Transported passengers and transport performance by the land transport




2. Water transport

2.1. Freight transport

The **transported goods** by water transport in the second quarter of 2011 were 1 484.3 thousand tons or by 24.4% less compared to the same quarter of 2010. The decline was mainly due to the less volume of the goods carried by the maritime transport, which registered a drop by 40.5%.

The **transport performance** measured in tonne-kilometres was 5 124.4 million tkm or by 32.8% less than the second quarter of 2010. The decline in the transported goods and in the transport performance was registered due to the decreased performance by the maritime transport – by 34.3%.

Figure 3. Transported goods and transport performance by the water transport






2.2. Passenger transport

The number of the **transported passengers** by water transport in the period April – June of 2011 remained the same as compared to the same period of 2010 - 40.7 thousand.

Transport performance in passenger-kilometers was by 9.9% more and reached 383 thousand pkm, due to the increased average distance travelled in the maritime transport.

Figure 4. Transported passengers and transport performance by the water transport




3. Urban electrical transport

During the second quarter of 2011 the **passengers transported** by the enterprises performing urban electrical transport were 70 024 thousand or by 5.0% less than the same quarter of 2010. A decrease in all modes of the urban electrical transport was registered. The highest decline was by the trolleybus transport with 3 268 thousand passengers or by 11.8%.

In comparison with the second quarter of 2010 the **transport performance** in pkms also drop by 6.8%, which is due to the less transported passengers by the tramway and trolleybus transport.

Methodological notes

Land freight transport covers the freight carriages by road and rail transport from vehicles with Bulgarian registration as well as transmission of goods by pipelines.

Land passenger transport covers the passengers' carriages by road and rail transport from vehicles with Bulgarian registration.

Water transport covers the passengers' or freight carriages and transport performance by maritime and IWW vessels with Bulgarian registration.

Urban electrical transport includes passengers carried and transport performance of trolleybus transport in the country, tramway transport, and metro in Sofia.

Goods carried - (tons) is measured the total volume of goods carried between two places (place of loading and place of unloading).

Transport performance of freight transport (tonne-kilometres) - corresponds to the transportation of one ton over one kilometre.

Passengers carried (number) - measures the total number of passengers with paid fares carried by the corresponding type of transport between two places (place of embarkation and place of disembarkation).

Transport performance of passenger transport (passenger-kilometres) - corresponds to the transportation of one passenger over one kilometre.
