



The **number of employees** under labour contract at the end of December 2024 decreased by 11.7 thousand, or 0.5%, as compared to the end of September 2024, and reached 2.31 million according to the preliminary data of the National Statistical Institute (NSI). The highest decrease was observed in the economic activities: 'Accommodation and food service activities' - by 7.7%, 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' - by 6.9%, and 'Real estate activities' - by 1.8%. The highest increase of the number of employees - by 1.7%, was recorded in the economic activity 'Arts, entertainment and recreation'.

At the end of December 2024, as compared to December 2023, the number of employees under labour contract increased by 25.7 thousand, or 1.1%. The highest increase in absolute figures was observed in economic activities 'Human health and social work activities' - 12.7 thousand, 'Accommodation and food service activities' - 7.0 thousand, and 'Construction' - 5.4 thousand, and the highest decrease was in 'Manufacturing' - 12.7 thousand, and in 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' - 3.7 thousand. In percentages, the highest increase at the end of December 2024 as compared to December 2023 was in economic activity 'Accommodation and food service activities' - by 7.4%, 'Human health and social work activities' - by 6.8%, and in 'Construction' - by 4.3%, as the highest decrease was reported in 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' - by 5.6%, and in 'Mining and quarrying' - by 4.9%.

The **average monthly wages and salaries** of the employees under labour contract in October was 2 387 BGN, in November - 2 383 BGN, and in December 2024 - 2 468 BGN.





Figure 1. Gross average wages and salaries by months

In the fourth quarter of 2024, in comparison with the third quarter of 2024, the average monthly wages and salaries increased by 6.1% and reached 2 413 BGN. The highest increase in wages and salaries was reported in 'Education' - by 19.1%, 'Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply' - by 8.4%, and in 'Financial and insurance activities' - by 8.0%.

Compared to the fourth quarter of 2023, the average monthly wages and salaries in the fourth quarter of 2024 rose by 13.7%. The highest growth rates were recorded in the economic activities: 'Other service activities' - by 27.5%, 'Professional, scientific and technical activities' - by 17.3%, and 'Arts, entertainment and recreation' - by 16.5%.

The economic activities with the highest wages and salaries in the fourth quarter of 2024 were:


- 'Information and communication' 5 305 BGN;
- 'Financial and insurance activities' 3 520 BGN;
- 'Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply' 3 506 BGN.

The lowest wages and salaries were recorded in:

- 'Accommodation and food service activities' 1 510 BGN;
- 'Other service activities' 1 666 BGN;
- 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' 1 675 BGN.

In comparison with a year earlier, the average monthly wages and salaries in the public sector grew by 12.0% and in the private sector - by 14.2%.

#### Methodological notes

The source of information is the 'Quarterly Survey on employees, hours worked, wages and salaries, and other expenditures paid by the employer'. The main purpose of this sample survey is to make a study of the current state and dynamics of some main aspects of labour market. The sample used for the survey is a stratified random sample without replacement. Stratification criteria used include: economic activity (NACE, Rev. 2), size of the enterprise (according to the number of employees) and regional breakdown (28 districts, NUTS3).
