



The **number of employees** under labour contract at the end of March 2025 increased by 39.5 thousand, or 1.7%, as compared to the end of December 2024, and reached 2.35 million according to the preliminary data of the National Statistical Institute (NSI). The highest increase was observed in the economic activities: 'Other service activities' - by 6.2%, 'Arts, entertainment and recreation' - by 5.7%, and 'Construction' - by 4.1%.

At the end of March 2025, as compared to March 2024, the number of employees under labour contract increased by 33.1 thousand, or 1.4%. The highest increase in absolute figures was observed in economic activities 'Human health and social work activities' - 11.2 thousand, 'Construction' - 7.9 thousand, and 'Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles' - 6.1 thousand, and the highest decrease was in 'Manufacturing' - 13.9 thousand, and in 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' - 1.5 thousand. In percentages, the highest increase at the end of March 2025 as compared to March 2024 was in economic activity 'Construction' - by 6.1%, 'Arts, entertainment and recreation' - by 6.0%, and in 'Human health and social work activities' - by 5.8%, as the highest decrease was reported in 'Mining and quarrying' - by 3.6%, and in 'Manufacturing' - by 3.0%.

The **average monthly wages and salaries** of the employees under labour contract in January was 2 407 BGN, in February - 2 366 BGN, and in March 2025 - 2 556 BGN.





Figure 1. Gross average wages and salaries by months

In the first quarter of 2025, in comparison with the fourth quarter of 2024, the average monthly wages and salaries increased by 1.2% and reached 2 443 BGN. The highest increase in wages and salaries was reported in: 'Financial and insurance activities' - by 9.0%, 'Administrative and support service activities' - by 8.5%, and in 'Information and communication' - by 8.2%.

Compared to the first quarter of 2024, the average monthly wages and salaries in the first quarter of 2025 rose by 11.1%. The highest growth rates were recorded in the economic activities: 'Arts, entertainment and recreation' - by 19.3%, 'Construction' - by 17.5%, and 'Real estate activities' - by 16.5%.

The economic activities with the highest wages and salaries in the first quarter of 2025 were:


- 'Information and communication' 5 739 BGN;
- 'Financial and insurance activities' 3 837 BGN;
- 'Professional, scientific and technical activities' 3 387 BGN.

The lowest wages and salaries were recorded in:

- 'Accommodation and food service activities' 1 514 BGN;
- 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' 1 584 BGN;
- 'Other service activities' 1 669 BGN.

In comparison with a year earlier, the average monthly wages and salaries in the public sector grew by 9.2% and in the private sector - by 11.8%.

Methodological notes

The source of information is the 'Quarterly Survey on employees, hours worked, wages and salaries, and other expenditures paid by the employer'. The main purpose of this sample survey is to make a study of the current state and dynamics of some main aspects of the labour market. The sample used for the survey is a stratified random sample without replacement. Stratification criteria used include: economic activity (NACE, Rev. 2), size of the enterprise (according to the number of employees) and regional breakdown (28 districts, NUTS3).
