



INFLATION AND CONSUMER PRICE INDICES - MARCH 2026 - FLASH ESTIMATE

Consumer Price Index (CPI)

According to the flash estimates of NSI, in March 2026, the monthly inflation rate is expected to be 0.7% and the annual inflation rate is expected to be 3.9%. In March 2026, compared to the previous month, the following groups are expected to have the highest increase: 'Transport' (5.5%), 'Alcoholic beverages, tobacco' (0.8%), 'Information and communication' (0.8%) and 'Personal care, social protection and miscellaneous goods and services' (0.8%). The following groups are expected to have a decrease: 'Recreation, sport and culture' (-2.1%), 'Clothing and footwear' (-0.9%) and 'Furnishings, household equipment and routine household maintenance' (-0.2%).

Harmonized Index of Consumer Prices (HICP)

According to the flash estimates of NSI, in March 2026, the monthly inflation rate is expected to be 0.9% and the annual inflation rate is expected to be 2.6%. In March 2026, compared to the previous month, the following groups are expected to have the highest increase: 'Transport' (3.3%), 'Restaurants and accommodation services' (1.0%), 'Alcoholic beverages, tobacco' (0.7%) and 'Recreation, sport and culture' (0.7%). The following group is expected to have a decrease: 'Clothing and footwear' (-1.1%).

Price Index of a Small Basket (PISB)

According to the flash estimates of NSI, in March 2026, the monthly rate, measured by PISB, is expected to be 0.3% and the annual rate is expected to be 2.6%. In March 2026, compared to the previous month, the prices of goods and services in the small basket for the 20% of households with the lowest income are expected to have:

- 'Services' - an increase of 0.7%;
- 'Food products' - an increase of 0.3%.

The prices of goods in 'Non-food products' remained unchanged.

The press release for inflation and consumer price indices for March 2026 will be published on 14 April 2026.

Methodological notes

Flash estimates for inflation and consumer price indices are calculated based on registered prices which accounts for about 90% of all planned registrations for the reference month. The remaining received data are included into the calculation of the indices of consumer prices of the final data.

The **chain** consumer price indices measure the price change in the current month compared to the previous month. The chain consumer price indices are used as a measure of **monthly inflation**.

The **12-month** consumer price indices measure the price changes occurring between the current month and the same month of the previous year. The 12-month consumer price indices are used as a measure of **annual inflation**.
