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Interviewer!

- Highest degree of education completed is to be recorded in PE040, for which the person is issued a document (diplome, certificate, etc.)
- For children aged 3-7 years visiting a kindergarten, code "1" is to be recorded for question PE010 and code "14" for question PE020
- Code 15 „Person who has never visited school" is to be recorded for persons aged 8+ only, who have never visited school
- Code 13 „Uncompleted Primary" is to be recorded for persons only who are not studying at present, but who have completed several grades of the primary education, without completing it
