Share of renewable energy for heating and cooling

Indicator is defined as the quantity of energy from district heating and cooling produced from renewable sources, plus the consumption of other energy from renewable sources in industry, households, services, agriculture, forestry and fisheries, for heating, cooling and processing purposes.

It is calculated as a percent ratio between gross final consumption of energy from renewable sources for heating and cooling and gross final consumption of energy from all sources for heating and cooling, according to the requirements of the Directive 2009/28/EC on the promotion of the use of energy from renewable sources (for the data from 2004 to the first six months of 2021), amended by the Directive (EC) 2018/2001 (for the data from the second six months of 2021 onwards).
