First propositions of TF3

- › Main objective : make operational proposals that do not increase the burden of NSI
 - Short term : production and dissemination of first results with existing data
 - Middle term : recommendations for the reengineering of ESS
- › Agreement on the main dimensions to take into account in the quality of life :
 - To consider that distinction objective vs subjective is irrelevant
 - To represent each dimension of QoL by a dummy indicator, based on a collection of items and the use of thresholds
 - Not to compute an aggregate indicator of QoL but rather propose scoreboards



First propositions of TF3

- › General agreement that indicators have to be defined at an individual level to :
 - Compute indicators for usual subpopulations (by income, age,..) and vulnerable population
 - Compute correlations or multiple deprivations
- › Disagreement between members on the use of data coming out of the ESS
- › Quality recommendations
 - Timeliness
 - Data matching
