

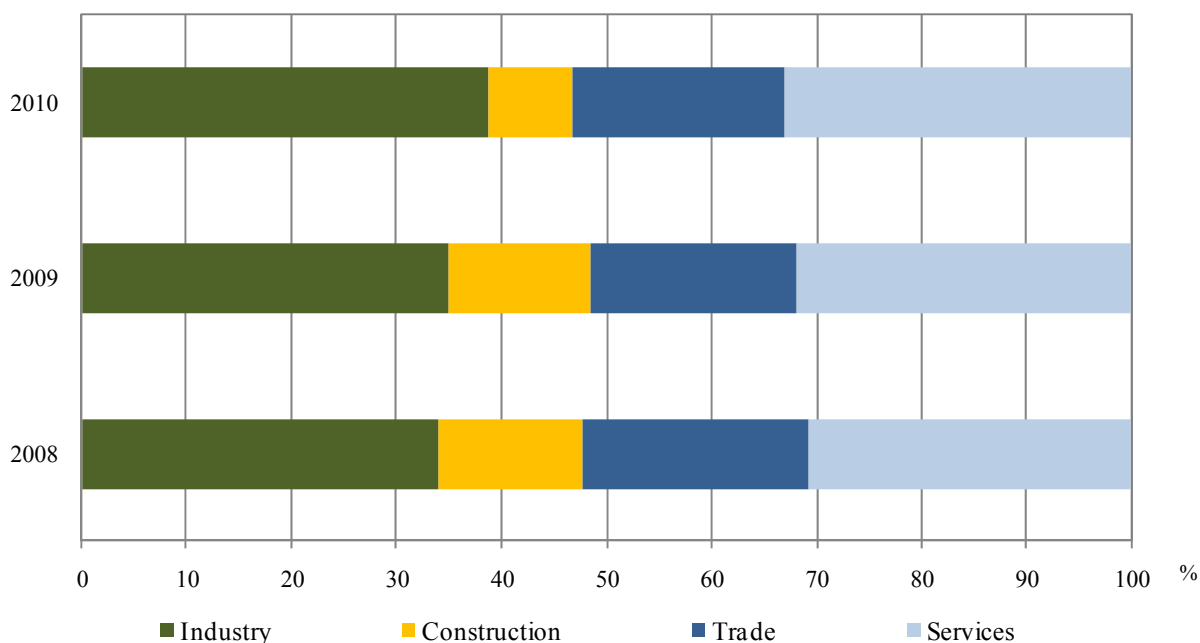


ACTIVITY OF NON FINANCIAL ENTERPRISES¹ FOR 2010 (PRELIMINARY DATA)

1. OVERVIEW

According to the preliminary data 315 819 non-financial enterprises have submitted their annual reports for 2010 at the National Statistical Institute, employing 1 934 544 persons, generating 32 138 million BGN of value added and making 12 776 million BGN gross investments in tangible goods.

Figure 2. Structure of persons employed by economic sectors and years

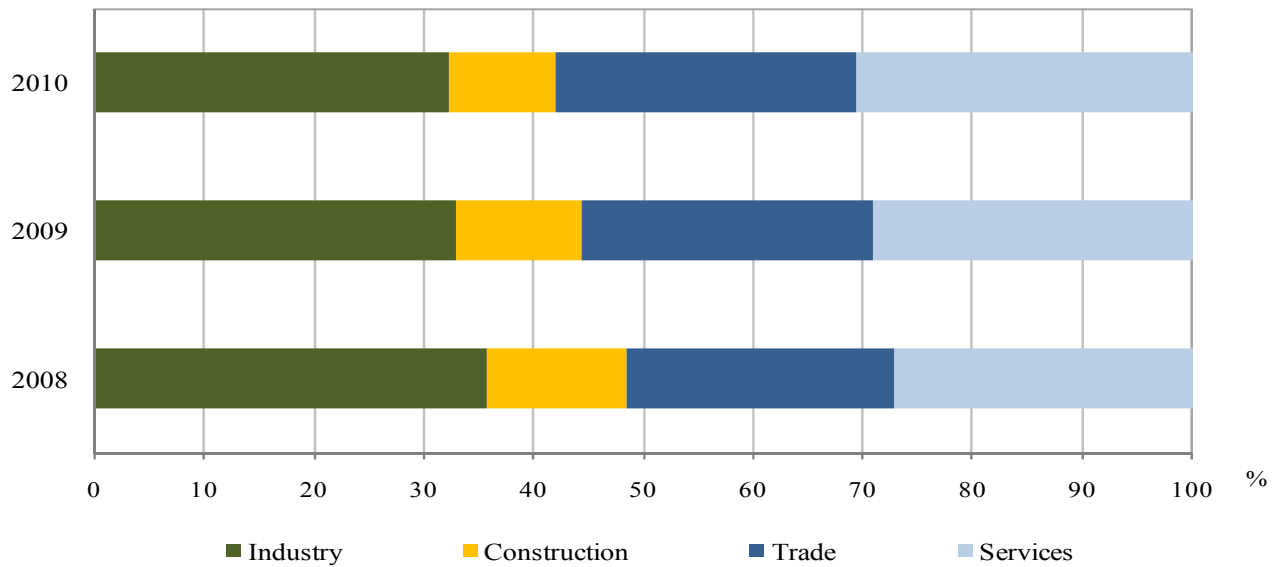


Figure 3. Structure of production value by economic sectors and years

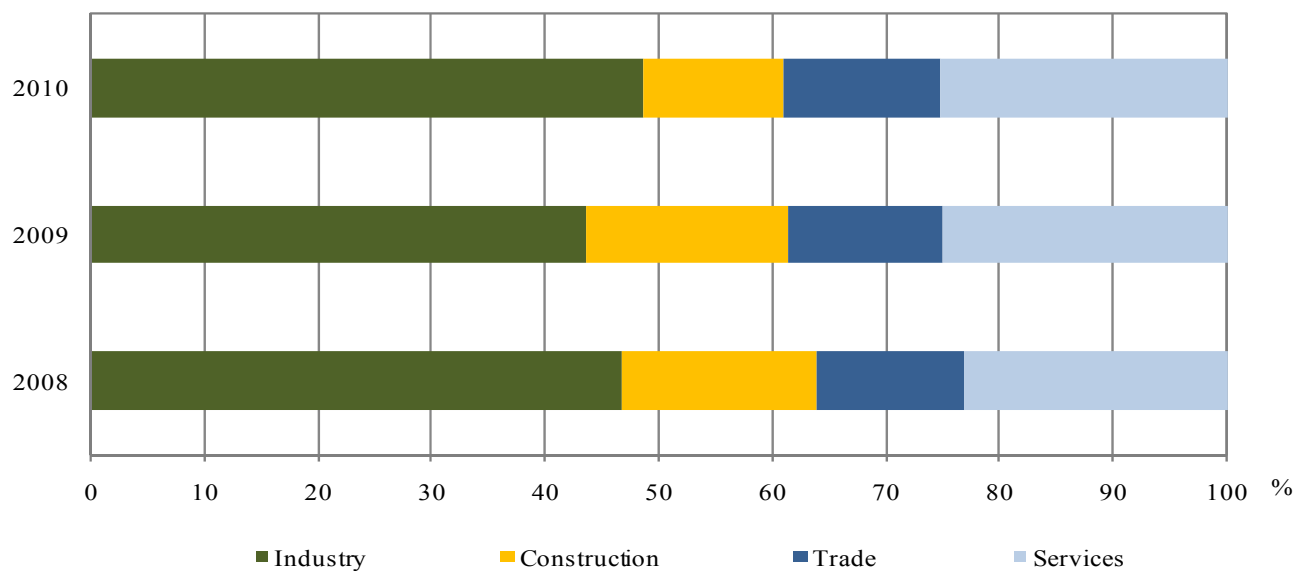
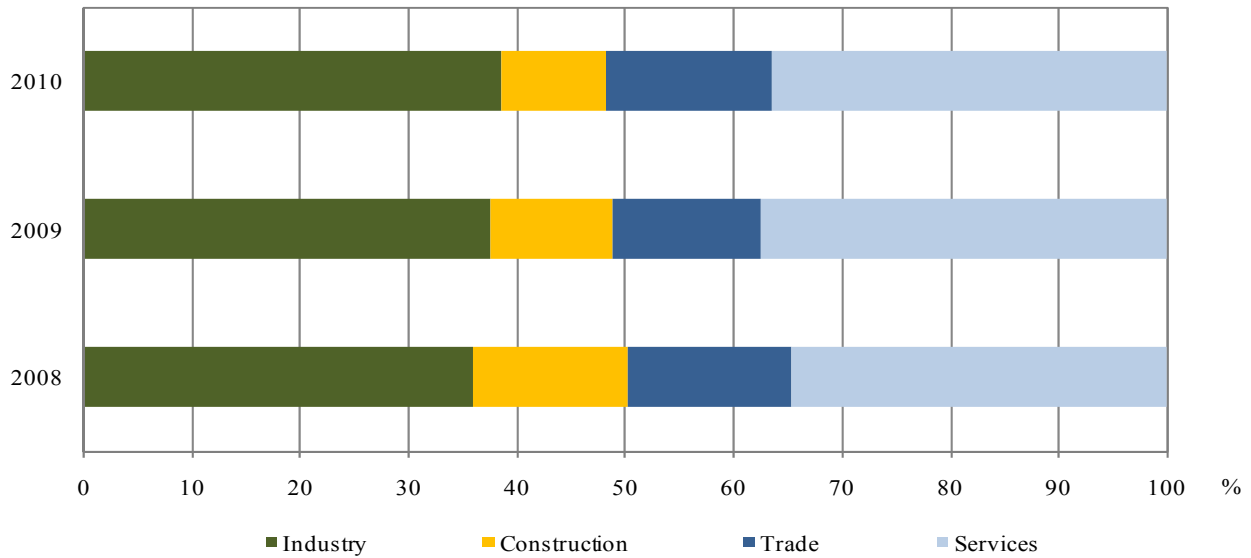




Figure 4. Structure of costs for gross investments in tangible goods by years



2. Industry

Annual report for their activities in 2010 have submitted 32 964 industrial enterprises, which was 10.4% of the total number of reported at the NSI.

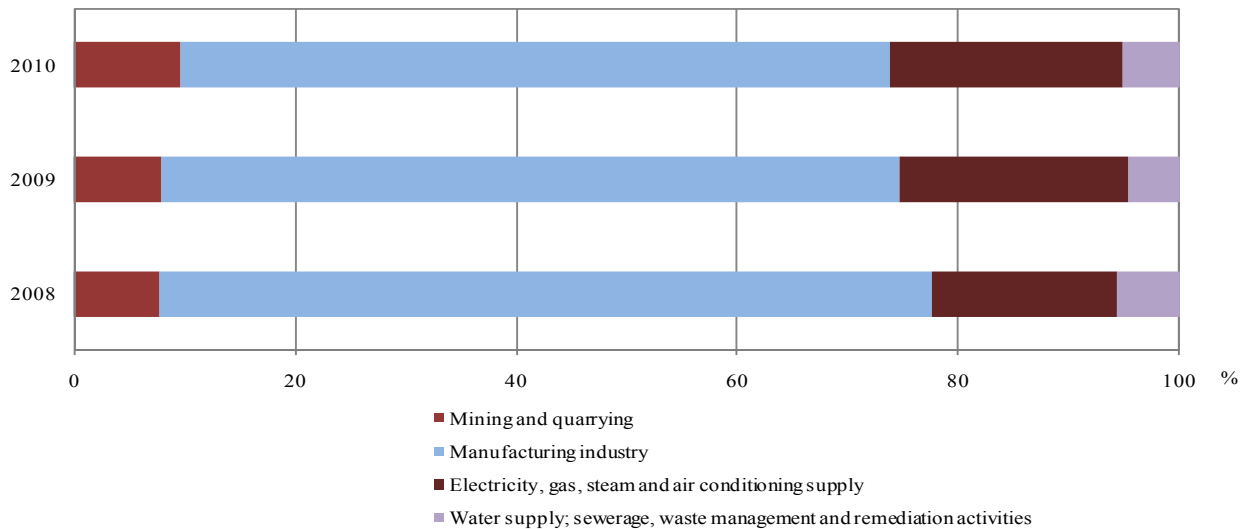

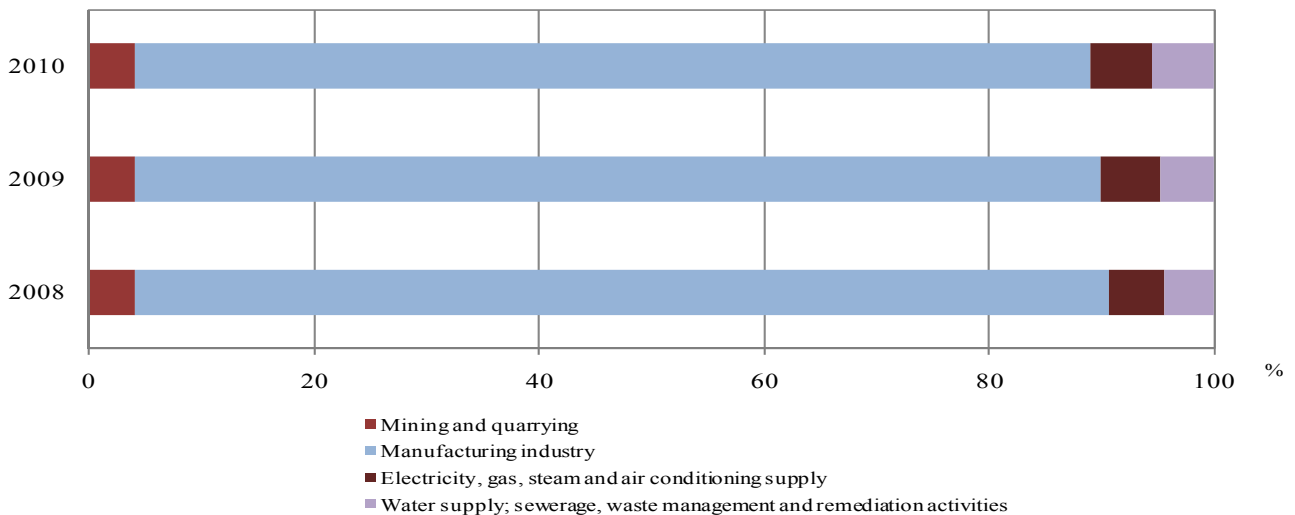
The value added at factor cost in the Industry in 2010 at current prices reached 12 422 million BGN. Compared to the previous year, its structure was changed by activities, increasing the share of the sections Mining and quarrying - by 1.7 points, Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply - by 0.5 points and "Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities - by 0.4 points, while the relative share of section Manufacturing industry decrease by 2.6 points.

The number of persons employed in the Industry in 2010 was 625 812 and formed the largest share of total number - 32.4%.

3. Construction

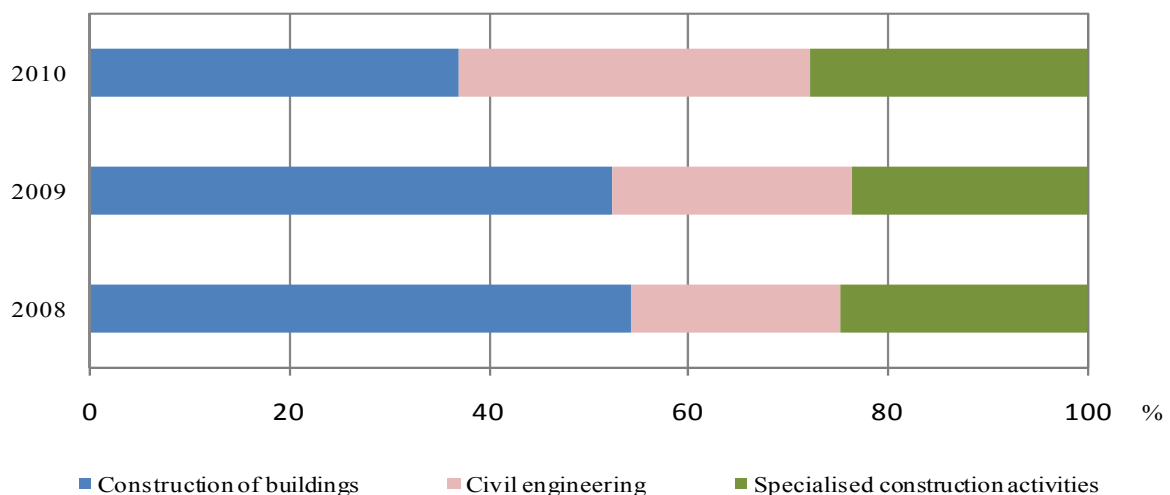
The number of the construction enterprises, which have presented the annual reports for their activities in 2010 was 21 118, or 6.7% of all reported at NSI.

According to the preliminary data in 2010 the value added in factor cost in the construction sector reached 2 614 million BGN at current prices. Compared to 2009 its relative share declined by 5.3 points.

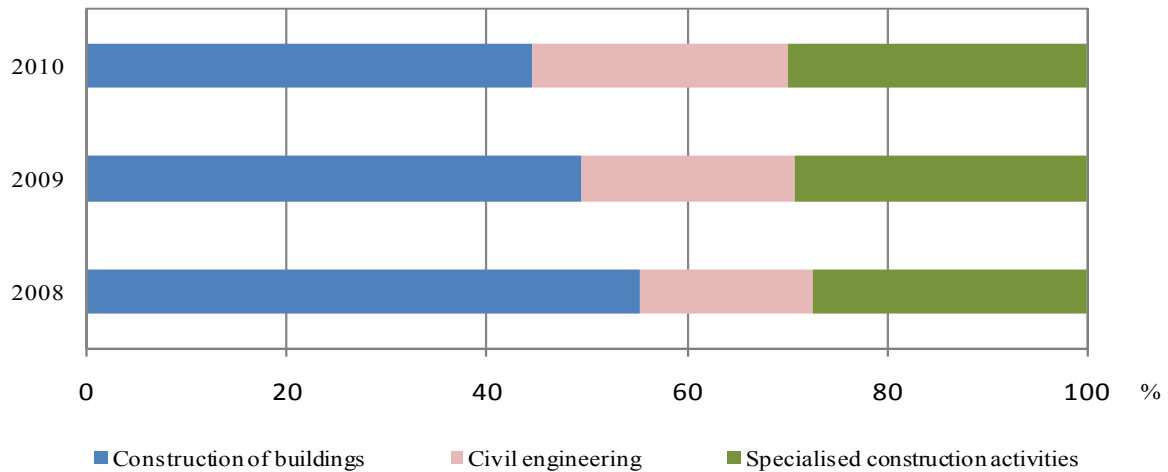
Figure 7. Structure of value added at factor cost of the construction enterprises by years



In the construction sector the number of persons employed in 2010 reached 185 453, or 9.6% of total number and fell by 2.0 points in comparison with 2009.

4. Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles

In the NSI 143 688 trade enterprises have sent their annual reports for 2010, or 45.5% of the total number.

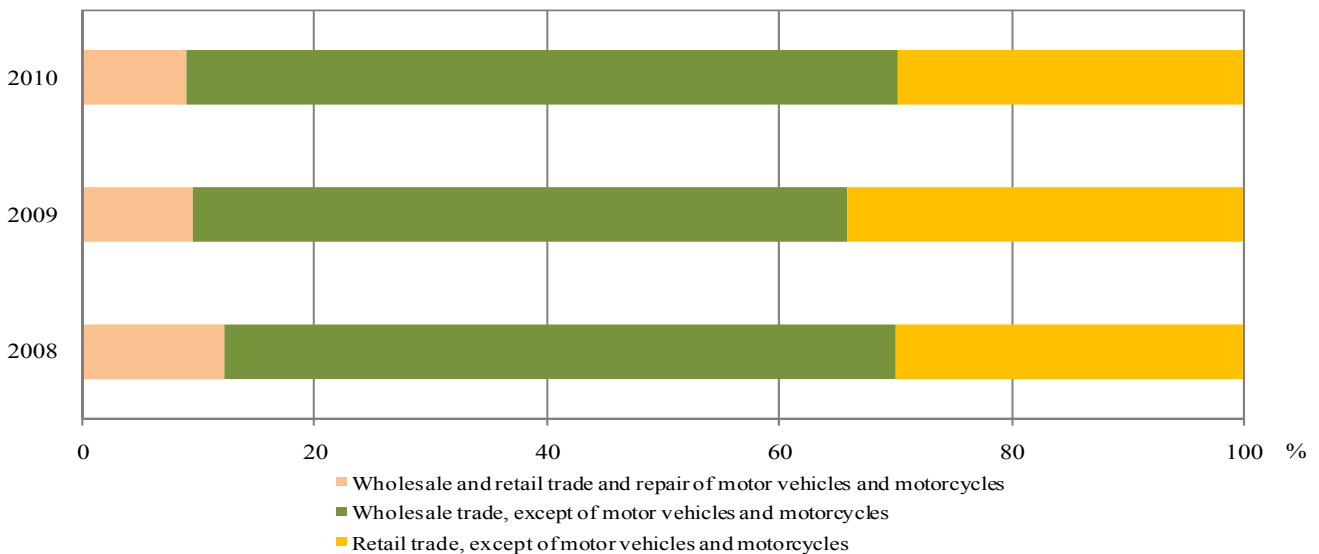

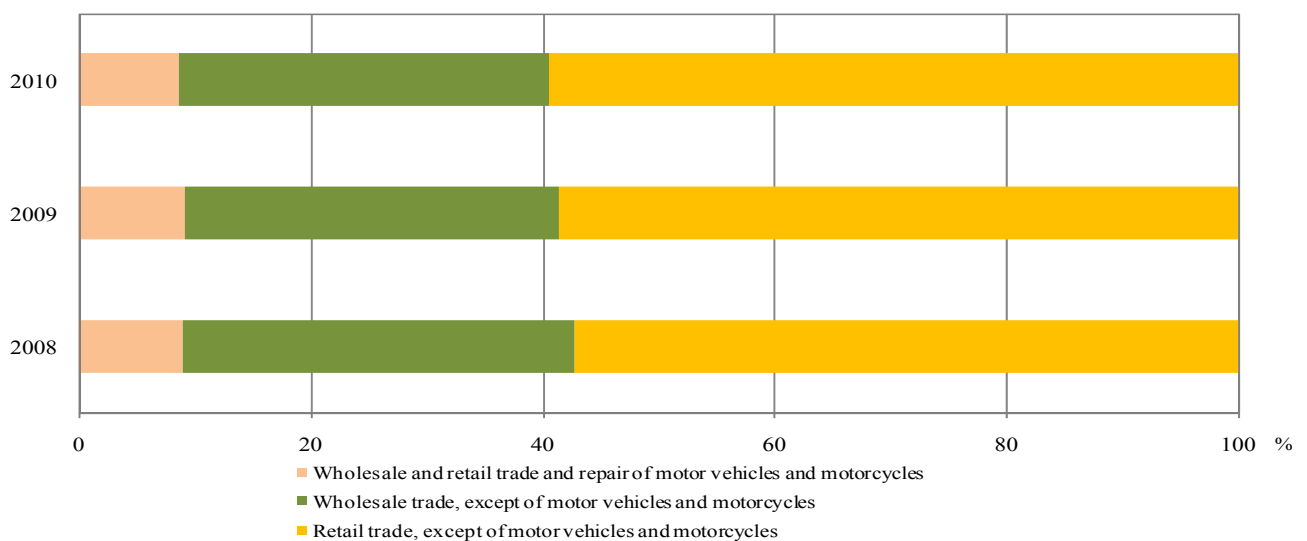
According to preliminary data the value added at factor cost in trade sector reached 6 452 million BGN in 2010 at current prices. Compared to 2009 the share of ‘Wholesale trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles’ increased by 4.8 percentage points, while the share of two other main trade activities – ‘Retail trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles’ and ‘Wholesale and retail trade and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles’ fell by 4.3 and 0.5 percentage points respectively.

In trade sector the number of persons employed was 531 921, as its relative share in total amount rose by 1.0 percentage points in comparison with the previous year.

5. Services

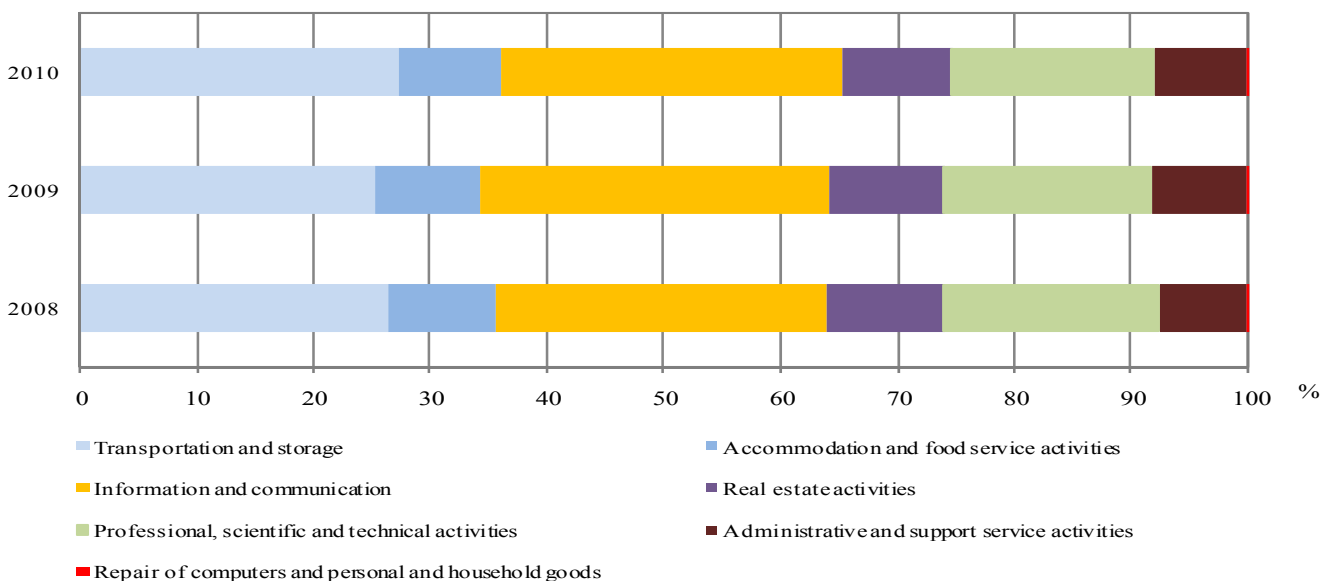
By preliminary data 118 049 enterprises of the service sector have submitted their annual reports for 2010 at NSI, or 37.4% of the total number, and their relative share increased by 0.9 points compared to 2009.

In the service activities, according to preliminary data for 2010, the value added at factor cost reached 10 650 million BGN. Its relative share in the total amount increased by 1.2 points compared to the previous year.

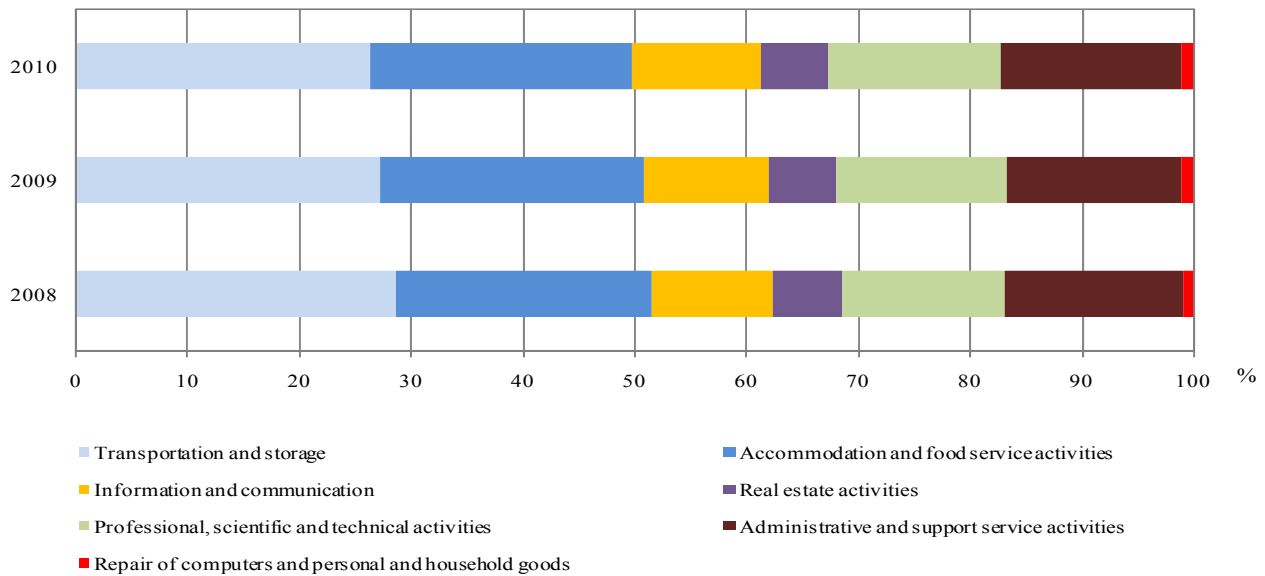
Figure 11. Structure of value added at factor cost in the service activities by years

Methodological notes

Turnover includes the value of all receipts from sales of goods, own products and services plus taxes on products (excise duty)

The production value includes the value of turnover, reduced by the balance sheet of assets sold (without own fixed assets). It also includes changes in stocks of products and work in progress, and the amount of incurred expenditure for the acquisition of assets by economic means.

Value added at factor cost includes the production value, reduced by the amount of excise duty and the cost of operating activities, without these of staff plus financing revenues.
