




# ACTIVITY OF ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS IN MARCH 2025

In March 2025, 2 279 accommodation establishments - hotels, motels, camping sites, mountain chalets and other establishments for short-term accommodation, with 10 or more bed-places, functioned in the country (Annex, Table 1), with 66.3 thousand rooms and 138.1 thousand bed-places in them. In comparison with the same month of the previous year, the number of accommodation establishments increased by 3.0%, and the bed-places in them - by 6.2%.

The total number of nights spent was 1 123.1 thousand, or 4.5% more in comparison to a year earlier. The nights spent by Bulgarian residents were 755.4 thousand and by non-residents - 367.7 thousand.


In 4 and 5-star accommodation establishments were realized 77.6% of all nights spent by non-residents and 48.0% by Bulgarian residents. In 3 stars were spent 15.8% of all nights by non-residents and 25.7% by Bulgarian residents, while in 1 and 2 stars, they were 6.6% and 26.3%, respectively (Figure 1).

## ACTIVITY OF ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS IN MARCH 2025

The number of arrivals<sup>1</sup> increased by 6.3% compared to the same month in 2024 and reached 528.5 thousand, as an increase by 11.4% for non-residents and by 4.4% for Bulgarian residents was reported. The Bulgarian residents were 382.4 thousand and spent 2.0 nights on average. The arrivals of non-residents were 146.1 thousand, and had 2.5 nights on average, as 76.7% of them spent nights in accommodation establishments with 4 and 5 stars (Figure 2).





Figure 3. Occupation of the bed-places in accommodation establishments by categories and by months

The total occupancy of the bed-places was 26.6% and decreased by 0.5 percentage points compared to a year earlier. The highest occupancy of the bed-places was in 4 and 5-star accommodation establishments - 36.3%, followed by those with 3 stars - 24.2%, and with 1 and 2 stars - 16.0% (Figure 3).

The total revenues from nights spent increased by 13.6%, compared to the same month of the previous year, and reached 106.2 million BGN, as 65.5 million BGN were from Bulgarian residents and 40.7 million BGN from non-residents (Figure 4).

## Methodological notes

Since 2012, the statistical survey on **accommodation establishments** has been carried out monthly in compliance with the Regulation 692/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning European statistics on tourism and the Regulation 1051/2011 of the Commission implementing Regulation 692/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning European statistics on tourism, as regards the structure of the quality reports and the transmission of the data.

All categorized hotels, camping sites and other types of accommodation establishments with 10 or more bed-places in use during the reporting period are included in the observation.

The indicator **other accommodation establishments** includes holiday settlements, hostels, guest houses, bungalows, rest houses, mountain chalets, private rooms and flats and other establishments for short accommodation.

**Available Bed Capacity** is the maximum number of bed-places, offered for each day of the reference month.

The **revenues from nights spent** in accommodation establishments include the sums paid by the guests, without the extra services.
