



EMPLOYEES UNDER LABOUR CONTRACT AND GROSS AVERAGE WAGES AND SALARIES, THIRD QUARTER OF 2021

According to the preliminary data of the National Statistical Institute (NSI) at the end of September 2021 the **number of employees** under labour contract decreased by 23.7 thousand, or by 1.0%, as compared to the end of June 2021 and reached 2.28 million. The highest decrease was observed in economic activities: 'Accommodation and food service activities' - by 11.0%, 'Real estate activities' - by 4.8% and in 'Administrative and support service activities' - by 2.7%. The highest increase of the number of employees was recorded in economic activities: 'Education' - by 1.3% and 'Human health and social work activities' - by 1.0%.

In the structure of employees by economic activities the biggest relative share of employees was in 'Manufacturing' - 20.7% and 'Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles' - 16.9%.

At the end of September 2021 as compared to September 2020 the number of employees under labour contract increased by 32.5 thousand. The highest increase in absolute figures was observed in economic activities 'Information and communication' - 8.7 thousand, 'Human health and social work activities' - 8.4 thousand and 'Accommodation and food service activities' - 4.8 thousand. The highest decrease was in 'Administrative and support service activities' - 3.5 thousand. In percentages the highest increase at the end of September 2021 as compared to September 2020 was in economic activity 'Information and communication' - by 8.6%, 'Human health and social work activities' - by 5.5% and in 'Accommodation and food service activities' - by 5.2%. The highest decrease was reported in 'Mining and quarrying' - by 7.0%.

The **average gross monthly wages and salaries** of the employees under labour contract in July was 1 533 BGN, in August - 1 485 BGN and in September 2021 - 1 543 BGN.





Figure 1. Gross average wages and salaries by months





In the third quarter of 2021 in comparison with the second quarter of 2021 the average monthly wages and salaries decreased by 0.3% - getting to 1 520 BGN. The highest decrease in wages and salaries was reported in 'Human health and social work activities' - by 5.4%, 'Mining and quarrying' - by 4.9% and in 'Financial and insurance activities' - by 4.3%. The highest increase of wages and salaries was recorded in economic activities 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' - by 7.8% and 'Arts, entertainment and recreation' - by 6.9%.

Compared to the third quarter of 2020 the average monthly wages and salaries in the third quarter of 2021 rose by 10.7%. The highest growth rates were recorded in economic activities: 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' - by 17.4%, 'Arts, entertainment and recreation' - by 16.5% and 'Administrative and support service activities' - by 16.2%.

The economic activities with the highest wages and salaries in the third quarter of 2021 were:

- 'Information and communication' 3 687 BGN
- 'Financial and insurance activities' 2 267 BGN
- 'Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply' 2 225 BGN.

The lowest wages and salaries were recorded in:

- 'Accommodation and food service activities' 940 BGN
- 'Other service activities' 1 013 BGN
- 'Water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation activities' 1 150 BGN.

In comparison with a year earlier the average monthly wages and salaries in public sector grew by 12.4% while in private sector - by 10.2%.




Figure 3. Gross average monthly wages and salaries by kind of ownership





Methodological notes

The source of information is the Quarterly Survey on employees, hours worked, wages and salaries, and other expenditures paid by the employer. It is a sample survey, which main purpose is to make a study of the current state and dynamics of some main aspects of labour market. The sample used for the survey is a stratified random sample without replacement. Stratification criteria used includes: economic activity (NACE rev. 2), size of the enterprise (according to the number of employees) and regional breakdown (28 districts, NUTS3).
