


EMPLOYEES UNDER LABOUR CONTRACT AND GROSS AVERAGE WAGES AND SALARIES, SECOND QUARTER OF 2022


According to the preliminary data of the National Statistical Institute (NSI) at the end of June 2022, the **number of employees** under labour contract increased by 34.4 thousand, or 1.5%, as compared to the end of March 2022 and reached 2.31 million. The highest increase was observed in economic activities: 'Accommodation and food service activities' - by 30.5%, 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' - by 4.6% and in 'Real estate activities' - by 4.1%. The highest decrease of the number of employees was recorded in economic activities: 'Education' - by 1.6% and 'Construction' - by 1.2%.

In the structure of employees by economic activities, the biggest relative share of employees was in 'Manufacturing' - 20.4% and 'Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles' - 16.6%.

At the end of June 2022, as compared to June 2021, the number of employees under labour contract increased by 3.1 thousand, or 0.1%. The highest increase in absolute figures was observed in economic activities 'Information and communication' - 5.7 thousand, 'Human health and social work activities' - 5.6 thousand and 'Accommodation and food service activities' - 4.9 thousand, and the highest decrease was in 'Manufacturing' - 7.0 thousand and in 'Construction' - 5.3 thousand. In percentages, the highest increase at the end of June 2022 as compared to June 2021 was in economic activity 'Real estate activities' - by 5.3%, 'Information and communication' - by 5.1% and in 'Accommodation and food service activities' - by 4.5%, as the highest decrease was reported in 'Construction' - by 4.1%.

The **average monthly wages and salaries** of the employees under labour contract in April was 1 771 BGN, in May - 1 708 BGN and in June 2022 - 1 710 BGN.








In the second quarter of 2022, in comparison with the first quarter of 2022, the average monthly wages and salaries increased by 7.8% and reached 1 730 BGN. The highest increase in wages and salaries was reported in 'Education' - by 16.2%, 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' - by 15.5% and in 'Mining and quarrying' - by 14.6%. A decrease of wages and salaries by 2.0% was recorded in economic activity 'Human health and social work activities'.

Compared to the second quarter of 2021, the average monthly wages and salaries in the second quarter of 2022 rose by 13.4%. The highest growth rates were recorded in economic activities: 'Administrative and support service activities' - by 21.0%, 'Other service activities' - by 19.0% and 'Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles' - by 18.0%.

The economic activities with the highest wages and salaries in the second quarter of 2022 were:

- 'Information and communication' 4 216 BGN
- 'Financial and insurance activities' 2 739 BGN
- 'Mining and quarrying' 2 544 BGN.

The lowest wages and salaries were recorded in:

- 'Accommodation and food service activities' 1 058 BGN
- 'Other service activities' 1 185 BGN
- 'Water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation activities' 1 262 BGN.

In comparison with a year earlier, the average monthly wages and salaries in the public sector grew by 7.8%, while in the private sector - by 15.4%.




Figure 3. Gross average monthly wages and salaries by kind of ownership



Methodological notes

The source of information is the Quarterly Survey on employees, hours worked, wages and salaries, and other expenditures paid by the employer. It is a sample survey which main purpose is to make a study of the current state and dynamics of some main aspects of labour market. The sample used for the survey is a stratified random sample without replacement. Stratification criteria used include: economic activity (NACE rev. 2), size of the enterprise (according to the number of employees) and regional breakdown (28 districts, NUTS3).
