

PRODUCTION AND DELIVERIES OF ENERGY PRODUCTS, FEBRUARY 2023

In February 2023, compared to the previous month, for the production of energy products, no increase is observed for any of the products. The largest decrease is registered in unleaded motor gasoline - by 29.7%.

In February 2023, compared to the previous month, the largest increase is observed in the deliveries of unleaded motor gasoline, due to reduced deliveries in January 2023, as currently reaches its usual levels. The largest decrease is registered in solid fuels - by 10.9%.

Production of energy products

In February 2023, compared to January 2023, no increase is observed for any of the energy products. A decrease is reported for the production of:

- unleaded motor gasoline - by 29.7% to 116 thousand tonnes;
- liquefied petroleum gases - by 28.6% to 5 thousand tonnes;
- transport diesel - by 28.6% to 227 thousand tonnes;
- solid fuels - by 8.7% to 2 782 thousand tonnes;
- electricity - by 7.3% to 4 114 GWh.

No change for the production of natural gas (Annex, Table 1).

In February 2023, compared to the same month of the previous year, an increase is reported for the production of liquefied petroleum gases - by 66.7%.

A decrease is reported for the production of:

- natural gas - by 50.0%;
- solid fuels - by 15.6%;
- electricity - by 8.3%;
- unleaded motor gasoline - by 5.7%.

No change for the production of transport diesel.

Deliveries of energy products

In February 2023, compared to January 2023, an increase is reported for the deliveries of liquefied petroleum gases - by 18.9% to 44 thousand tonnes. The deliveries of unleaded motor gasoline significantly increase, due to reduced deliveries in January 2023, as currently reaches its usual levels - to 39 thousand tonnes.

A decrease is reported for the deliveries of:

- solid fuels - by 10.9% to 2 594 thousand tonnes;
- transport diesel - by 10.4% to 199 thousand tonnes;
- electricity - by 5.4% to 3 183 GWh;
- natural gas - by 0.8% to 258 million m³ (Annex, Table 2).



In February 2023, compared to the same month of the previous year, an increase is reported for the deliveries of:

- liquefied petroleum gases - by 51.7%;
- unleaded motor gasoline - by 14.7%;
- transport diesel - by 12.4%;
- electricity - by 4.9%.

A decrease is reported for the deliveries of:

- solid fuels - by 22.9%;
- natural gas - by 18.9%.

Methodological notes

The survey on energy products is conducted every month in accordance with Regulation (EC) No. 1099/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 October 2008 on energy statistics and its amendments. The survey aims to submit information on the production and inland deliveries of the main energy products - electricity, solid fuels, natural gas and petroleum products. The reporting units are producers, importers and exporters of energy products. Production and deliveries of energy products are the main observed indicators.

Solid fuels

Production - includes Hard coal, Lignite and Solid fuels from coal. Producers report quantities calculated after any operation for the removal of inert matter.

Deliveries - quantities delivered to the internal market. They are equal to the total of the deliveries to the different types of consumers: producers' own use, main activity power stations, coking plants and patent fuel plants, industry, iron and steel industry and others.

Since 1.01.2017, Brown coal briquettes have been excluded from the monthly survey.

Petroleum products

Production - includes production of finished products at a refinery or blending plant.

Deliveries - wholesale deliveries to the domestic market of finished petroleum products from producers and importers/exporters.

Deliveries of petroleum products are defined as: primary product receipts + gross refinery output + recycled products – refinery fuel + imports – exports – international marine bunkers + interproduct transfers – products transferred – stock changes.

Natural gas

Production - includes all dry marketable production within national boundaries, including offshore production. Production is measured after purification and extraction of NGLs and sulfur. Excludes extraction losses and quantities reinjected, vented or flared. Includes quantities used within the natural gas industry; in gas extraction, pipeline systems and processing plants.

Deliveries - total natural gas, distributed for the internal market, including own use and losses.

Data are presented in million cubic meters assuming reference gas conditions 15°C and 101.325 kPa. To convert quantities from cubic meters at 20°C to cubic meters at 15°C - according to the reporting requirements of Regulation (EC) No. 1099/2008 of the European Parliament and the Council on energy statistics, we use a conversion factor of 0.98294.

Electricity

Production - includes produced electricity from Thermal power plants, Nuclear power plants, Hydropower plants, Pumped storage plants and electricity, obtained from wind generators and solar panels.

Deliveries/Total net consumption - the sum of the net produced electricity and net import, reduced by the amount used for pumped storage.

Figure 1. Production and deliveries of solid fuels

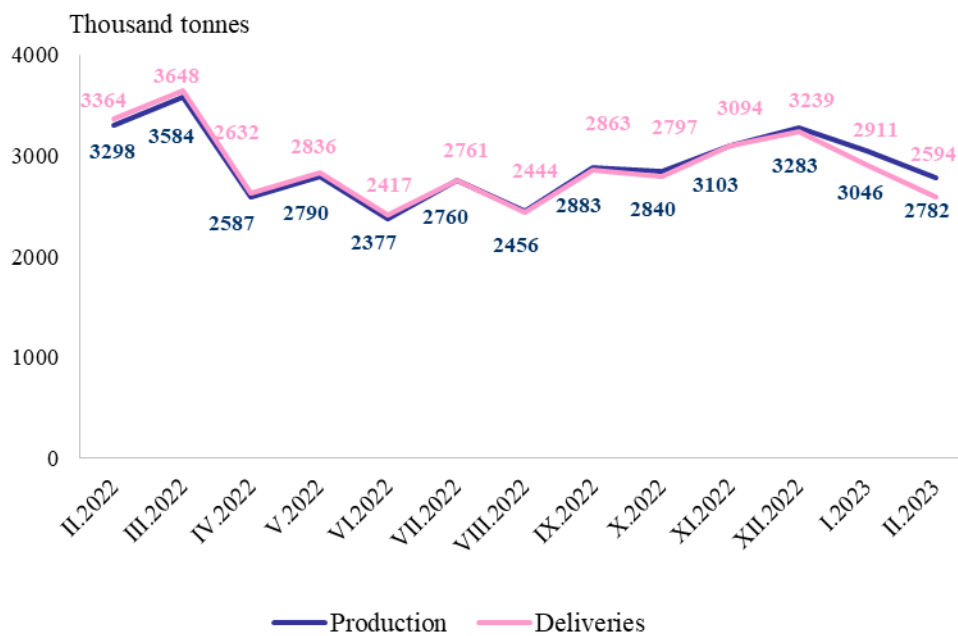


Figure 2. Production and deliveries of liquefied petroleum gases

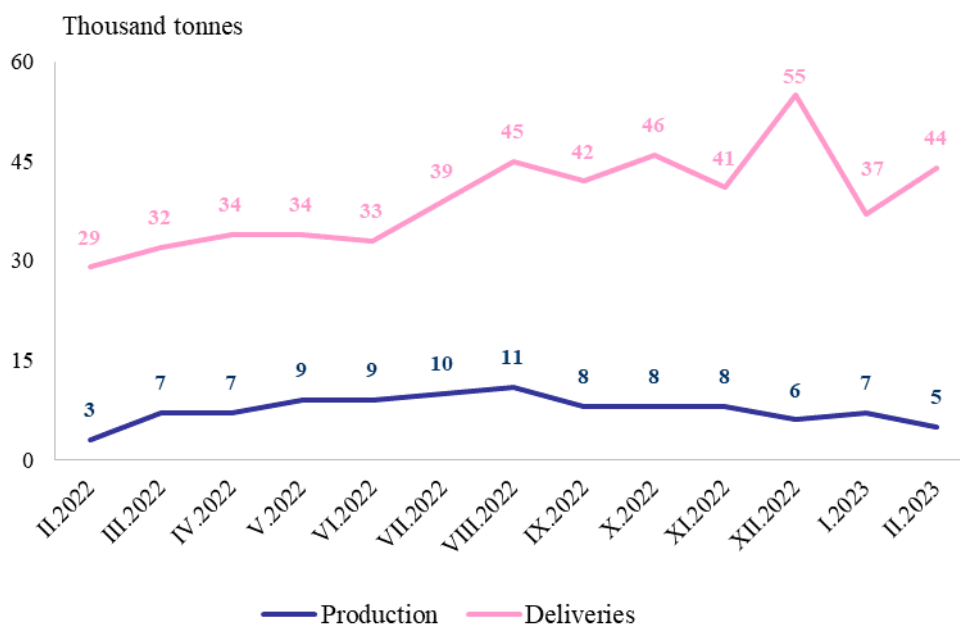


Figure 3. Production and deliveries of unleaded motor gasoline

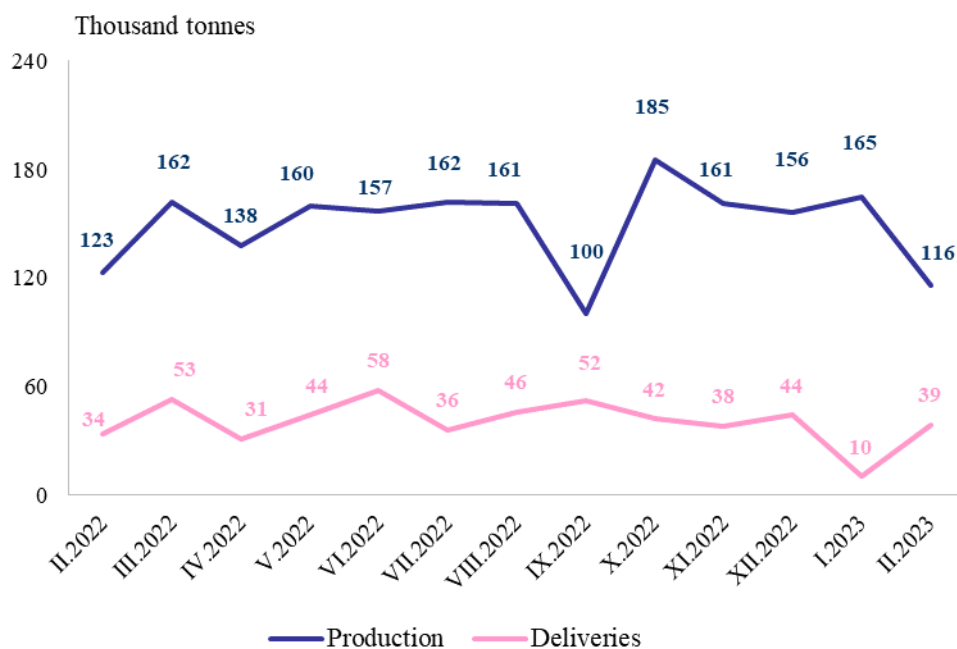


Figure 4. Production and deliveries of transport diesel

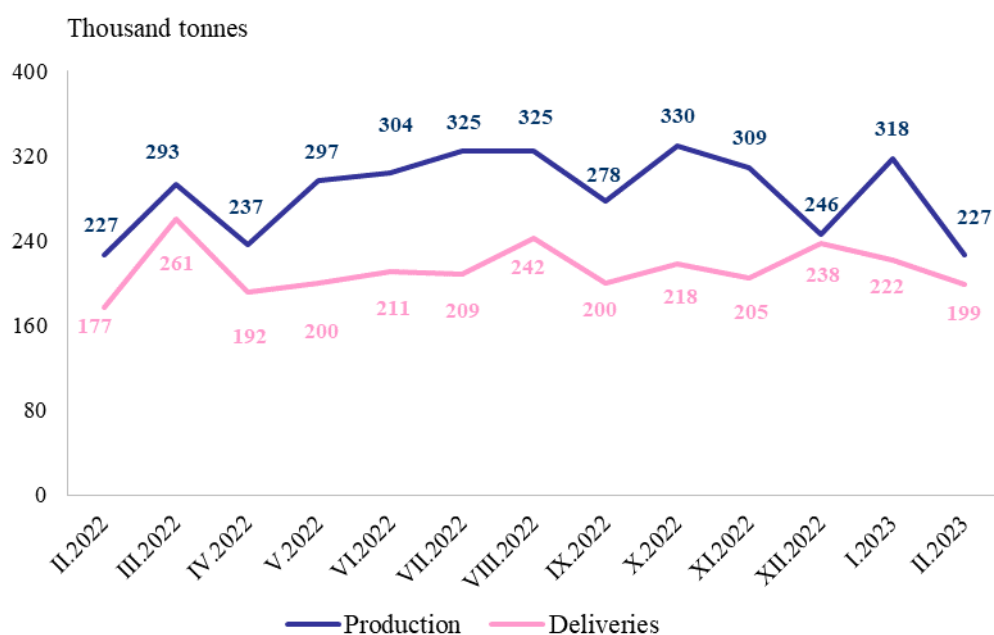


Figure 5. Production and deliveries of natural gas

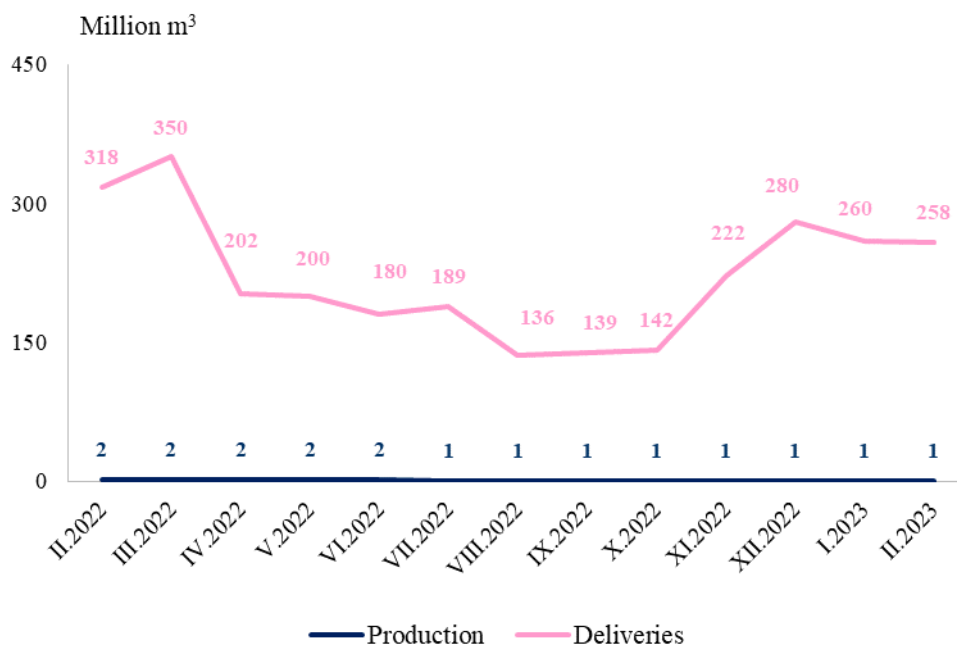


Figure 6. Production and deliveries of electricity
