

# PRODUCTION AND DELIVERIES OF ENERGY PRODUCTS, FEBRUARY 2024

In February 2024, compared to the previous month, for the production of energy products, the largest increase is observed in liquefied petroleum gases - by 25.0%. The largest decrease is registered in solid fuels - by 36.5%.

For the deliveries of energy products no increase is observed for any of the products. The largest decrease is registered in solid fuels - by 36.5%.

# **Production of energy products**

In February 2024, compared to January 2024, an increase is reported for the production of:

- liquefied petroleum gases by 25.0% to 5 thousand tonnes;
- transport diesel by 2.5% to 242 thousand tonnes.

A decrease is reported for the production of:

- solid fuels by 36.5% to 989 thousand tonnes;
- electricity by 14.4% to 3 186 GWh;
- motor gasoline by 4.1% to 140 thousand tonnes.

There is no change in the production of natural gas (Annex, Table 1).

Compared to the same month of the previous year, an increase is reported for the production of:

- motor gasoline by 20.7%;
- transport diesel by 6.6%.

A decrease is reported for the production of:

- solid fuels by 64.5%;
- electricity by 22.6%.

There is no change in the production of liquefied petroleum gases and natural gas.

### **Deliveries of energy products**

In February 2024, compared to January 2024, for the deliveries of energy products, no increase is reported for any of the products.

A decrease is reported for the deliveries of:

- solid fuels by 36.5% to 1 032 thousand tonnes;
- electricity by 20.0% to 2 969 GWh;
- natural gas by 16.2% to 249 million m<sup>3</sup>;
- transport diesel by 13.5% to 179 thousand tonnes;
- liquefied petroleum gases by 7.7% to 36 thousand tonnes;
- motor gasoline by 3.8% to 50 thousand tonnes (Annex, Table 2).



Compared to the same month of 2023, an increase is reported for the deliveries of motor gasoline - by 28.2%.

A decrease is reported for the deliveries of:

- solid fuels by 60.2%;
- liquefied petroleum gases by 18.2%;
- transport diesel by 10.1%;
- electricity by 6.7%;
- natural gas by 3.5%.

### **Methodological notes**

The survey on energy products is conducted every month in accordance with Regulation (EC) No. 1099/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 October 2008 on energy statistics and its amendments. The survey aims to submit information on the production and inland deliveries of the main energy products - electricity, solid fuels, natural gas and petroleum products. The reporting units are producers, importers and exporters of energy products. Production and deliveries of energy products are the main observed indicators.

#### **Solid fuels**

*Production* - includes Hard coal, Lignite and Solid fuels from coal. Producers report quantities calculated after any operation for the removal of inert matter.

*Deliveries* - it is calculated as: production + imports – exports + stock change.

Since 1.01.2017, Brown coal briquettes have been excluded from the monthly survey.

### **Petroleum products**

*Production* - includes production of finished products at a refinery or blending plant.

*Deliveries* - wholesale deliveries to the domestic market of finished petroleum products from producers and importers/exporters.

Deliveries of petroleum products are defined as: primary product receipts + gross refinery output + recycled products - refinery fuel + imports - exports - international marine bunkers + interproduct transfers - products transferred - stock changes.

The production and deliveries of motor gasoline and transport diesel include the quantity of biofuel, mixed with the mineral fuel.

# Natural gas

*Production* - includes all dry marketable production within national boundaries, including offshore production. Production is measured after purification and extraction of NGLs and sulfur. Excludes extraction losses and quantities reinjected, vented or flared. Includes quantities used within the natural gas industry; in gas extraction, pipeline systems and processing plants.

Deliveries - total natural gas, distributed for the internal market, including own use and losses.

Data are presented in million cubic meters assuming reference gas conditions 15°C and 101.325 kPa. To convert quantities from cubic meters at 20°C to cubic meters at 15°C - according to the reporting requirements of Regulation (EC) No. 1099/2008 of the European Parliament and the Council on Energy Statistics, we use a conversion factor of 0.98294.

#### **Electricity**

*Production* - includes produced electricity from Thermal power plants, Nuclear power plants, Hydropower plants, Pumped storage plants and electricity, obtained from wind generators and solar panels.

*Deliveries/Total net consumption* - the sum of the net produced electricity and net import, reduced by the amount used for pumped storage.




Figure 3. Production and deliveries of motor gasoline




Figure 4. Production and deliveries of transport diesel




Figure 5. Production and deliveries of natural gas




Figure 6. Production and deliveries of electricity
