


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### BULGARIAN TRADE WITH THIRD COUNTRIES IN THE PERIOD JANUARY - OCTOBER 2014 (PRELIMINARY DATA)

In the period **January - October 2014** Bulgarian **exports to third countries** decreased by 7.1% compared to the corresponding period of 2013 and amounted to 13.5 Billion BGN (Annex, Table 1 and 2). Main trade partners of Bulgaria were Turkey, Singapore, Russian Federation, China, Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia and Serbia which accounted for 53.0% of the exports to non EU countries (Annex, Table 3).

**In October 2014 exports to third countries** decreased by 2.5% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 1.5 Billion BGN.




**Bulgarian imports from third countries in the first ten months of 2014** decreased by 2.8% compared to the corresponding period of 2013 and added up to 16.5 Billion BGN (at CIF prices) (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). The largest amounts were reported for the goods imported from the Russian Federation, Turkey, China and Ukraine (Annex, Table 3).

**In October 2014** Bulgarian imports from **third countries** decreased by 2.7% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 1.7 Billion BGN.

**The foreign trade balance** of Bulgaria (export FOB - import CIF) with third countries in the period January - October 2014 was negative and added up to 2 992.1 Million BGN (Annex, Table 1). The trade balance at FOB/FOB prices (after elimination of transport and insurance costs on imports) was also negative and amounted to 2 210.0 Million BGN.

**In October 2014** the foreign trade balance of Bulgaria (export FOB - import CIF) with third countries was negative and amounted to 191.5 Million BGN.

In the first ten months of 2014 compared to the corresponding period of 2013 in the exports of Bulgaria to third countries distributed according to the **Standard International Trade Classification** the largest growth was recorded in the section 'Animals and vegetable oils, fats and waxes' (24.6%) (Annex, Table 4). The most notable falls were reported in sections 'Crude materials, inedible (except fuels)'<sup>2</sup> (27.0%) and 'Mineral fuel, lubricants and related materials' (15.0%).

In imports from third countries the largest growths were reported in sections 'Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material' (15.3%) and 'Machinery and transport equipment' (15.3%) while the most notable fall was observed in section 'Mineral fuel, lubricants and related materials' (15.1%).

#### Bulgarian trade with third countries and EU - total

**In the period January - October 2014** the value of **all exported goods** from Bulgaria amounted to 35.9 Billion BGN and compared to the corresponding period of 2013 the exports decreased by 1.4% (Annex, Table 1 and 2).

**In October 2014** the total exports added up to 4.0 Billion BGN and increased by 1.9% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year.




Figure 3. Nominal value<sup>1</sup> change of exports of Bulgaria in the period 2013 - 2014 (Compared to the same month of the previous year)

The total value of **all the goods imported in** the country **in the period January - October 2014** amounted to 42.4 Billion BGN (at CIF prices), or by 0.9 % more than corresponding period of 2013 (Annex, Table 1 and 2).

**In October 2014** the total imports increased by 4.4% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and added up to 4.7 Billion BGN.

The **total foreign trade balance** (exports FOB - import CIF) was negative in the period January - October 2014 and amounted to 6 442.5 Million BGN which was 912.8 Million BGN more than the balance in the first ten months of 2013 (Annex, Table 1 and 2). At FOB/FOB prices (after elimination of transport and insurance costs on imports) in the period January - October 2014 the total foreign trade balance was also negative and amounted to 4 588.1 Million BGN.

**In October 2014** the total foreign trade balance (exports FOB - import CIF) was negative and added up to 697.8 Million BGN. The trade balance at FOB/FOB prices was also negative and amounted to 463.9 Million BGN.
