




BULGARIAN TRADE WITH THIRD COUNTRIES IN THE PERIOD JANUARY - MAY 2015 (PRELIMINARY DATA)

In the period **January - May 2015** Bulgarian **exports to third countries** increased by 10.4% compared to the corresponding period of 2014 and amounted to 6.8 Billion BGN (Annex, Table 1 and 2). Main trade partners of Bulgaria were Turkey, China, Serbia, USA, Russian Federation and Singapore, which accounted for 50.6% of the exports to non EU countries (Annex, Table 3).

In May 2015 exports to third countries decreased by 0.7% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 1.4 Billion BGN.

Bulgarian imports from third countries in the first five months of 2015 decreased by 1.1% compared to the corresponding period of 2014 and added up to 7.8 Billion BGN (at CIF prices) (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). The largest amounts were reported for the goods imported from the Russian Federation, Turkey, China and Ukraine (Annex, Table 3).

In May 2015 Bulgarian imports from third countries decreased by 9.3% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 1.6 Billion BGN.



The foreign trade balance of Bulgaria (export FOB - import CIF) with third countries in the period January - May 2015 was negative and added up to 982.7 Million BGN (Annex, Table 1). The trade balance at FOB/FOB prices (after elimination of transport and insurance costs on imports) was also negative and amounted to 626.2 Million BGN.

In May 2015 the foreign trade balance of Bulgaria (export FOB - import CIF) with third countries was negative and amounted to 183.5 Million BGN.

In the first five months of 2015 compared to the corresponding period of 2014 in the exports of Bulgaria to third countries distributed according to the **Standard International Trade Classification** the largest growth were recorded in the section 'Animals and vegetable oils, fats and waxes' (251.2%) and 'Miscellaneous manufactured articles' (56.7%) (Annex, Table 4). The most notable fall was reported in section 'Mineral fuel, lubricants and related materials' (8.1%).

In imports from third countries the largest growths were reported in sections 'Food and live animals' (32.9%) and 'Crude materials, inedible (except fuels)' (20.0%) while the most notable fall was observed in section 'Beverages and tobacco' (21.8%).

The section includes the following divisions: leather, leather manufactures, n.e.s. and dressed furskins; rubber manufactures, n.e.s; cork and wood manufactures (excluding furniture); paper, paperboard and articles of paper pulp, of paper or of paperboard; textile yarn, fabrics, made-up articles, n.e.s., and related products; non-metallic mineral manufactures, n.e.s.; iron and steel; non-ferrous metals; manufactures of metals, n.e.s.

Bulgarian trade with third countries and EU - total

In the period January - May 2015 the value of all exported goods from Bulgaria amounted to 18.4 Billion BGN and compared to the corresponding period of 2014 the exports increased by 11.6% (Annex, Table 1 and 2).

In May 2015 the total exports added up to 3.7 Billion BGN and increased by 6.8% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year.




Figure 3. Nominal value¹ change of exports of Bulgaria in the period 2014 - 2015 (Compared to the same month of the previous year)

The total value of **all the goods imported in** the country **in the period January - May 2015** amounted to 21.0 Billion BGN (at CIF prices), or by 4.4 % more than the corresponding period of 2014 (Annex, Table 1 and 2).


In May 2015 the total imports increased by 1.2% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and added up to 4.2 Billion BGN

The **total foreign trade balance** (exports FOB - import CIF) was negative in the period January - May 2015 and amounted to 2 653.8 Million BGN which was 1 018.2 Million BGN less than the balance in the first five months of 2014 (Annex, Table 1 and 2). At FOB/FOB prices (after elimination of transport and insurance costs on imports) in the period January - May 2015 the total foreign trade balance was also negative and amounted to 1 732.6 Million BGN.

In May 2015 the total foreign trade balance (exports FOB - import CIF) was negative and added up to 453.2 Million BGN. The trade balance at FOB/FOB prices was also negative and amounted to 248.6 Million BGN
