




TRADE IN GOODS OF BULGARIA WITH **THIRD COUNTRIES IN JANUARY 2019** (PRELIMINARY DATA)

In January 2019 the exports of goods from Bulgaria to third countries increased by 7.5% in comparison with the same month of the previous year and added up to 1 394.2 Million BGN (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). Main trade partners of Bulgaria were Turkey, China, the United States, Egypt, Serbia and the Russian Federation which accounted for 54.4% of the exports to non EU countries (Annex, Table 3).

In January 2019 in the exports of goods from Bulgaria to third countries, distributed according to the Standard International Trade Classification, the most notable growth compared to the same month of the previous year was recorded in sections 'Animals and vegetable oils, fats and waxes' (168.1%) and 'Food and live animals' (38.0%) (Annex, Table 4). The most notable falls were reported in sections 'Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material' (10.2%) and 'Beverages and tobacco' (4.9%).






Imports of goods to Bulgaria **from third countries** in **January 2019** increased by 9.1% in comparison with same month of 2018 and added up to 1 994.3 Million BGN (at CIF prices) (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). The largest amounts were reported for the goods imported from the Russian Federation, Turkey, China and Egypt (Annex, Table 3).

In **January 2019** in the imports of goods to Bulgaria from third countries distributed according to the **Standard International Trade Classification** the largest growths compared to the same month of the previous year were recorded in the section 'Food and live animals' (43.8%) and 'Mineral fuel, lubricants and related materials' (34.3%) (Annex, Table 4). The most notable falls were observed in sectors 'Animals and vegetable oils, fats and waxes' (28.6%) and 'Machinery and transport equipment' (14.3%).

The foreign trade balance of Bulgaria (export FOB - import CIF) with third countries in January 2019 was negative and added up to 600.1 Million BGN (Annex, Table 1). The trade balance at FOB/FOB prices (after elimination of transport and insurance costs on imports) was also negative and amounted to 421.5 Million BGN.






Trade in goods of Bulgaria with third countries and EU - total

In **January 2019** the total value of **all the goods exported** from Bulgaria amounted to 4 558.3 Million BGN which is 3.8% more than the same month of the previous year (Annex, Tables 1 and 2).

Figure 3. Nominal value¹ change of exports of goods of Bulgaria in the period 2018 - 2019 (Compared to the same month of the previous year)




The total value of **all the goods imported** in the country in **January 2019** amounted to 4 983.5 Million BGN (at CIF prices), or by 1.5% less than January 2018 (Annex, Tables 1 and 2).

The **total foreign trade balance** (exports FOB - import CIF) was negative in **January 2019** and amounted to 425.2 Million BGN (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). At FOB/FOB prices (after elimination of transport and insurance costs on imports) in 2019 the total foreign trade balance was also negative and added up to 97.1 Million BGN.
