




TRADE IN GOODS OF BULGARIA WITH THIRD COUNTRIES IN THE PERIOD JANUARY - FEBRUARY 2021 (PRELIMINARY DATA)

In **the period January - February 2021 the exports** of goods from Bulgaria **to third countries** decreased by 11.6% in comparison with the same period of 2020 and added up to 3 051.4 Million BGN (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). Main trade partners of Bulgaria were Turkey, China, the United States, Serbia, the United Kingdom, the Republic of North Macedonia, Libya and the Russian Federation, which accounted for 60.3% of the exports to non EU countries (Annex, Table 3).

In **February 2021** the **exports** of goods from Bulgaria **to third countries** increased by 0.1% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 1 673.4 Million BGN.

In the period January - February 2021 in the exports of goods from Bulgaria to third countries, distributed according to the Standard International Trade Classification, the most notable growth compared to the same period of 2020 was recorded in section 'Crude materials, inedible (except fuel)' (20.4%) (Annex, Table 4). The most notable fall was reported in sections 'Mineral fuel, lubricants and related materials' (54.9%) and 'Beverages and tobacco' (34.0%).

Imports of goods to Bulgaria from third countries in the period January - February 2021 decreased by 9.0% in comparison with the same period of 2020 and added up to 3 867.4 Million BGN (at CIF






prices)¹ (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). The largest amounts were reported for the goods imported from Turkey, the Russian Federation, China, Serbia and Ukraine (Annex, Table 3).

In **February 2021** the imports of goods to Bulgaria from third countries decreased by 2.6% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 1 994.1 Million BGN.

In the period January - February 2021 in the imports of goods to Bulgaria from third countries, distributed according to the Standard International Trade Classification, the largest growth compared to the same period of 2020 was recorded in the sections 'Animals and vegetable oils, fats and waxes' (13.4%) and 'Machinery and transport equipment' (8.0%) (Annex, Table 4). The most notable fall was observed in sector 'Mineral fuel, lubricants and related materials' (39.6%).

The foreign trade balance of Bulgaria (export FOB - import CIF) with third countries in the period January - February 2021 was negative and added up to 816.0 Million BGN (Annex, Table 1).

In February 2021 the foreign trade balance of Bulgaria (export FOB - import CIF) with third countries was also negative and amounted to 320.7 Million BGN.




Trade in goods of Bulgaria with third countries and EU - total

In the period January - February 2021 the total value of all the goods exported from Bulgaria amounted to 9 669.1 Million BGN which is 1.7% less than the same period of 2020 (Annex, Tables 1 and 2).

In **February 2021** the total exports of goods added up to 4 984.2 Million BGN and increased by 2.8% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year.

The total value of all the goods imported in the country in the period January - February 2021 amounted to 10 371.2 Million BGN (at CIF prices), or by 2.0% less than the same period of 2020 (Annex, Tables 1 and 2).

In **February 2021** the total imports of goods increased by 2.6% compared to the same month of the previous year and added up to 5 414.0 Million BGN.

The total foreign trade balance (exports FOB - import CIF) was negative in the period January - February 2021 and amounted to 702.1 Million BGN (Annex, Tables 1).

In February 2021 the total foreign trade balance (exports FOB - import CIF) was also negative and added up to 429.8 Million BGN.
