




BULGARIAN TRADE WITH EU IN THE PERIOD JANUARY - MAY 2015 (PRELIMINARY DATA)

In **January - May 2015** period Bulgarian **exports to the EU** increased by 12.2% compared to the corresponding period of 2014 and amounted to 11.6 Billion BGN (Annex, Table 1 and 2). Main trade partners of Bulgaria were Germany, Italy, Romania, Greece, Belgium and France which accounted for 70.1% of the exports to the EU Member States (Annex, Table 3).

In **May 2015** the exports to the EU increased by 12.0% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 2.3 Billion BGN.

(Compared to the same month of the previous year)**




Bulgarian **imports from the EU** in the period January - May 2015 increased by 8.0% compared to the same period of 2014 and added up to 13.3 Billion BGN at CIF prices (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). The largest amounts were reported for the goods imported from Germany, Italy, Romania, Spain and Greece (Annex, Table 3).

In **May 2015** the Bulgarian imports from the EU Member States increased by 9.4% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 2.6 Billion BGN at CIF prices.

The **foreign trade balance** of Bulgaria (export FOB - import CIF) **with the EU** in the period January - May 2015 was negative and added up to 1 678.7 Million BGN (Annex, Table 1). At FOB/FOB prices (after elimination of transport and insurance costs on imports) the trade balance was also negative and amounted to 1 139.9 Million BGN.

In the first five months of **2015** compared to the same period of 2014 the largest growth **in the exports** of Bulgaria to the **EU** distributed according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Annex, Table 4) was recorded in the sections 'Mineral fuel, lubricants and related materials' (38.8%) and 'Crude materials, inedible (except fuel)'² (27.3%) . Fall was recorded in section 'Beverages and tobacco' (15.4%).

In **imports from the EU** the largest growths were reported in the sections 'Crude materials, inedible (except fuel)' (16.5%) and 'Beverages and tobacco' (14.9%) while the most notable fall was observed in section 'Mineral fuel, lubricants and related materials' (30.9%).
