




### BULGARIAN TRADE WITH EU IN THE PERIOD JANUARY - MARCH 2018 (PRELIMINARY DATA)

In the period **January - March 2018** Bulgarian **exports to the EU** increased by 13.1% compared to the same period of 2017 and amounted to 8 960.7 Million BGN (Annex, Table 1 and 2). Main trade partners of Bulgaria were Germany, Italy, Romania, Greece, France and Belgium which accounted for 68.6% of the exports to the EU Member States (Annex, Table 3).

In **March 2018** the exports to the EU grew by 7.4% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 3 181.7 Million BGN.

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In the period **January - March 2018** compared to the corresponding period of the previous year the largest growths in the exports of Bulgaria to the EU distributed according to the **Standard International Trade Classification** (Annex, Table 4) were recorded in the sections 'Food and live animals' (42.9%) and 'Crude materials, inedible (except fuels)' (25.7%). Fall was recorded in section 'Mineral fuel, lubricants and related materials' (26.7%).

Bulgarian **imports from the EU** in the period **January - March 2018** increased by 11.4% compared to the same period of 2017 and added up to 9 803.5 Million BGN at CIF prices (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). The largest amounts were reported for the goods imported from Germany, Italy, Romania, Spain and Greece (Annex, Table 3).

In **March 2018** the Bulgarian imports from the EU Member States grew by 9.9% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 3 657.9 Million BGN.

In the period **January - March 2018** compared to the corresponding period of 2017 the largest growth in imports from the EU distributed according to the **Standard International Trade Classification** was reported in the section 'Crude materials, inedible (except fuels)' (36.4%) while the most notable fall was observed in section 'Animals and vegetable oils, fats and waxes' (10.3%).

2017

The **foreign trade balance** of Bulgaria (export FOB - import CIF) **with** the **EU** in the period January - Mach 2018 was negative and added up to 842.8 Million BGN (Annex, Table 1). At FOB/FOB prices (after elimination of transport and insurance costs on imports) the trade balance was also negative and amounted to 242.6 Million BGN.
