

TRADE IN GOODS OF BULGARIA WITH THE EU IN THE PERIOD JANUARY - JULY 2023 (PRELIMINARY DATA)

In the period **January - July 2023, the exports of goods** from Bulgaria **to the EU** decreased by 6.0% in comparison with the same period of 2022 and added up to 33 154.1 million BGN (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). Main trade partners of Bulgaria were Germany, Romania, Italy, Greece and France, which accounted for 61.4% of the exports to the EU Member States (Annex, Table 3).

In **July 2023**, the exports to the EU decreased by 9.1% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 4 787.1 million BGN.





In the period **January - July 2023**, in the exports of goods from Bulgaria to the EU, distributed according to the **Standard International Trade Classification**, the most notable growth compared to the same period of 2022 was recorded in the section 'Miscellaneous manufactured articles' (17.1%) (Annex, Table 4). The most notable fall was reported in the section 'Animal and vegetable oils, fats and waxes' (71.6%).



Imports of goods to Bulgaria **from the EU** in the period **January - July 2023** remains unchanged compared with the same period of 2022 and is worth to 34 008.6 million BGN (at CIF prices)¹ (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). The largest amounts were reported for the goods imported from Germany, Italy, Romania, Greece and the Netherlands (Annex, Table 3).

In **July 2023**, the imports from the EU decreased by 5.5% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and amounted to 4 727.4 million BGN.

In the period **January - July 2023**, in the imports of goods to Bulgaria from the EU Member States, distributed according to the **Standard International Trade Classification**, the largest growth compared to the same period of 2022 was recorded in the section 'Machinery and transport equipment' (18.1%). The most notable fall was reported in the section 'Mineral fuel, lubricants and related materials' (67.1%).

The foreign trade balance of Bulgaria (export FOB - import CIF) with the EU in the period January - July 2023 was negative and added up to 854.5 million BGN (Annex, Table 1).
