



## PRODUCER PRICE INDICES IN INDUSTRY<sup>1</sup>

SEPTEMBER 2009

### 1. Producer Price Indices on Domestic Market<sup>2</sup>

**Producer Price Index on Domestic Market** in September 2009 rose 1.2% compared to the previous month. The domestic prices in the manufacturing increased by 1.8% and in the mining and quarrying industry by 0.6%.

In the manufacturing the more significant price increase were seen in the manufacture of basic metals by 7.0%, in the manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery and equipment and in the manufacture of machinery and equipment by 1.3%. The prices decreased comparing to the previous month in the manufacture of paper and paper products by 1.3%, in the manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products by 0.8%, in manufacture of food products by 0.5%.

**Producer Price Index on Domestic Market** in September 2009 fell by 7.8% compared to the same month of 2008. The domestic prices decreased in the manufacturing by 10.3%, in the mining and quarrying industry by 8.1% and in the electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply by 1.7%.

In the manufacturing compared to the same month of 2008, the prices decreased in the manufacture of basic metals by 25.5%, in the manufacture of rubber and plastic products by 7.1%, in the manufacture of wood and of products of wood, except furniture by 6.8%, in the manufacture of food products by 4.8%. The price increase was seen in the manufacture of beverages by 7.2%, in the manufacture of leather and related products by 5.5%, in the manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers by 5.0%.

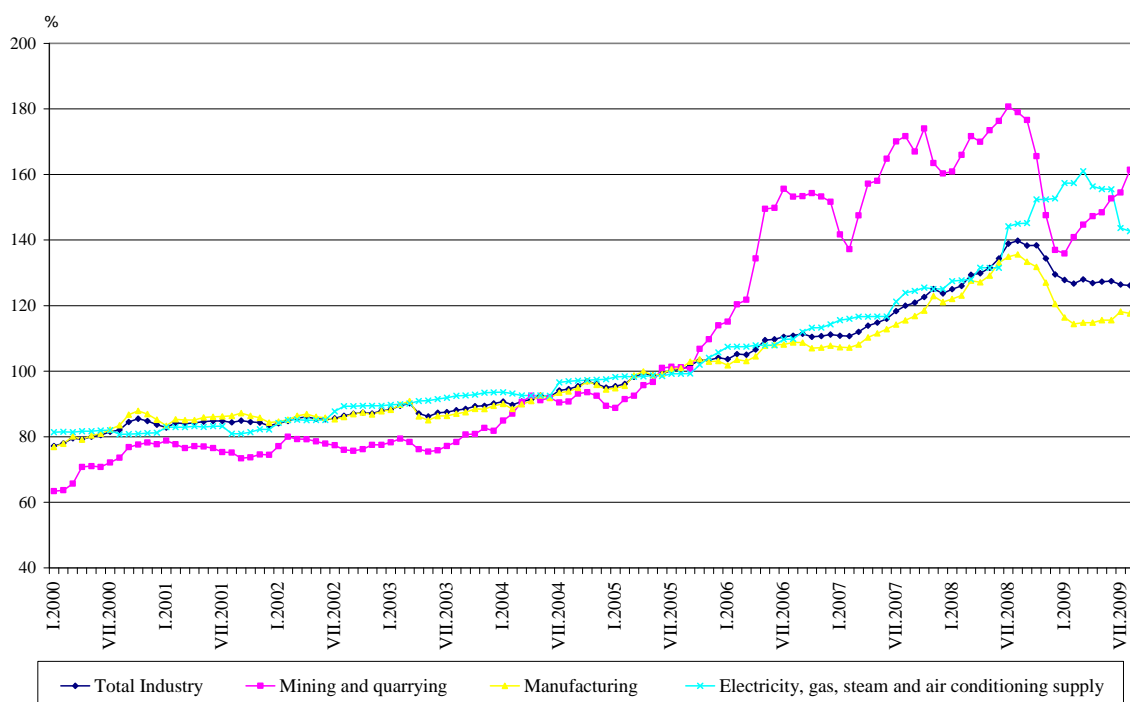

<sup>1</sup> Since January 2009, Producer Price Indices are calculated according to the new Classification of Economic Activities NACE.BG 2008. At the same time, the base year has been changed and indices are calculated at 2005 as a base year. Historical data series have been recalculated back to 2000 and they are posted in NSI web-site ([http://www.nsi.bg/Op\\_e/Op\\_e.htm](http://www.nsi.bg/Op_e/Op_e.htm)).

**Producer Price Indices** measure the average change in the prices of industrial products, which are produced and sold by Bulgarian enterprises. They can be considered as an early measure of the current inflation process in the economy and also they can be used for international comparisons. Information for calculation of Producer Price Indices is received on the bases of monthly surveys on producer prices of industrial products, sold on domestic market and on industrial products sold on non-domestic market. Producer price surveys are based on constant sample of groups of products, and that sample is representative for total industrial production.

<sup>2</sup> Producer Price Indices on domestic market are calculated at constant base (2005) weighed with turnover structure on domestic market.

## 2. Total Producer Price Indices in Industry<sup>3</sup>

**Total Producer Price Index in Industry** in September 2009 increased by 1.4% compared to August 2009. The price increase was registered in the manufacturing by 1.9%, in the mining and quarrying industry by 0.2%, while in the electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply, the prices fell by 0.1%.

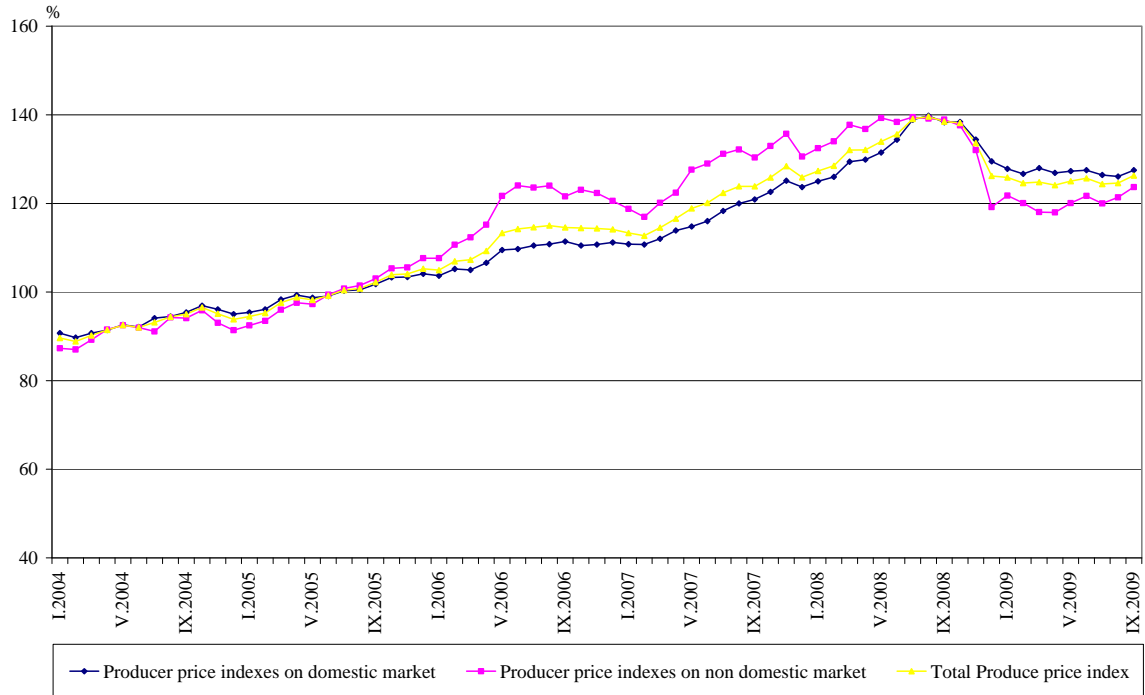
In the manufacturing industry, more significant price increase was seen in the manufacture of basic metals by 13.7%, in the repair and installation of machinery and equipment by 0.8%, in the manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery and equipment and in the manufacture of machinery and equipment by 0.7%, while the prices fell, in the manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products by 1.7%, in the manufacture of food products and in the of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers by 1.1%.

**Total Producer Price Index** in September 2009 decreased by 8.8% comparing to the same month of 2008.

In the manufacturing, the prices fell by 9.6% as compared to the same month of 2008. More significant price decreases were seen in the manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailer by 19.6%, in the manufacture of basic metals by 14.7%, in the manufacture of food products by 6.8%, while the producer prices increased in the manufacture of beverages by 6.9%.

<sup>3</sup> Total Producer Price Index is calculated from Producer Price Index on Domestic Market and Producer Price Index on Non-domestic Market weighted with the turnover structure on domestic and on non-domestic market to the total value of turnover in the base year 2005.
