



PRODUCER PRICE INDICES IN INDUSTRY¹, SEPTEMBER 2012

1. Producer Price Indices on Domestic Market²

Producer Price Index on Domestic Market in September 2012 increased by 0.3% compared to the previous month. The domestic prices rose in the manufacturing by 0.8%, while the prices went down in the mining and quarrying industry by 1.9% and in the electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply by 0.2%.

In the manufacturing, the more significant prices increases³ compared to the previous month was seen in the manufacture of food products by 2.0%, in the manufacture of leather and related products by 1.9% and in the printing and reproduction of recorded media by 1.4%.

Producer Price Index on Domestic Market in September 2012 grew by 6.6% compared to the same month of 2011. The domestic prices increased in the manufacturing by 5.8% and in the electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply by 10.5%, while in the mining and quarrying industry the prices fell by 3.3%.

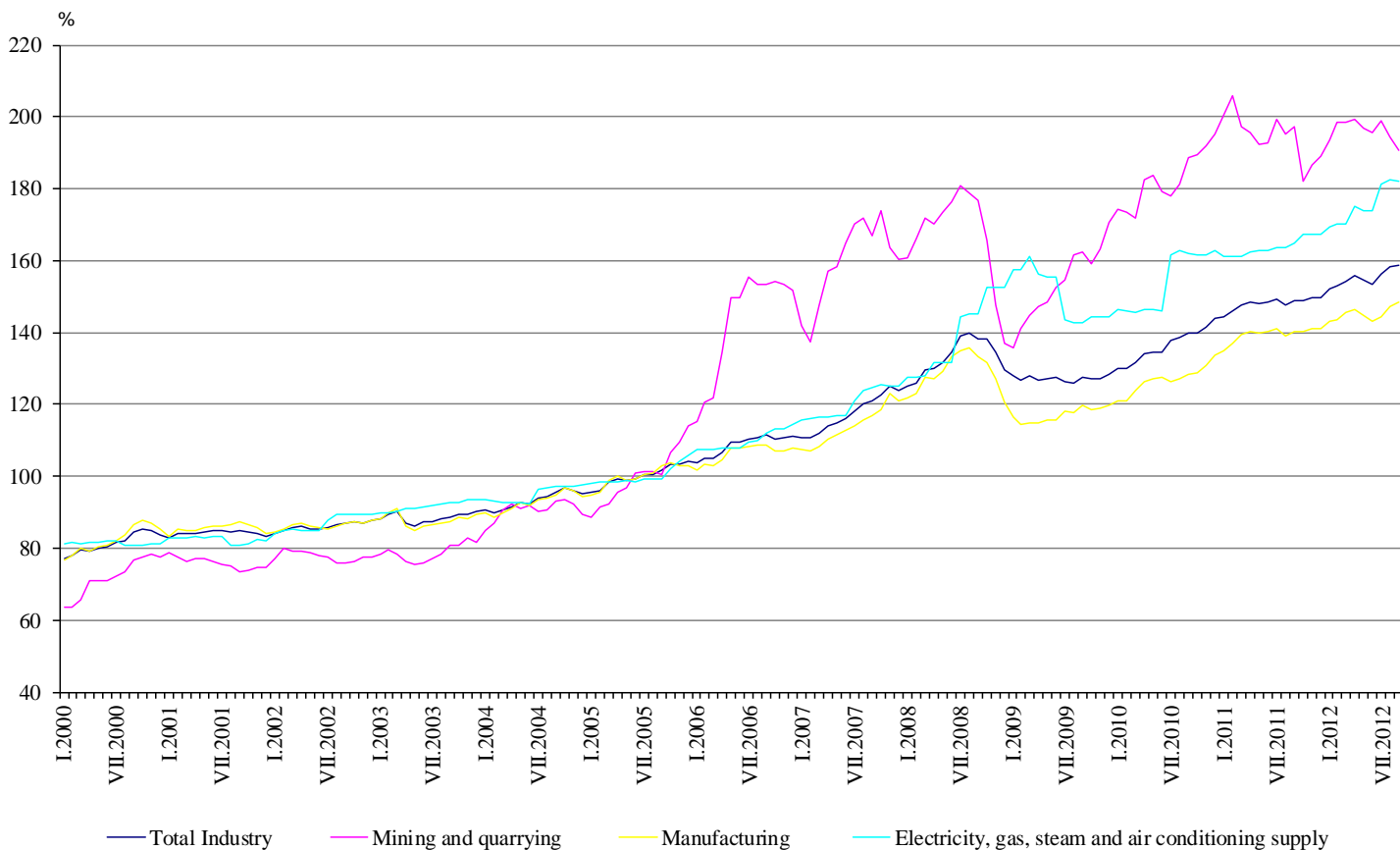
In the manufacturing compared to September 2011, the prices increase was registered in the manufacture of tobacco products by 8.0%, in the manufacture food products by 6.7%, in the manufacture of textiles by 5.6%, in the manufacture of chemical and chemical products by 5.4%, in the manufacture of beverages by 5.3%. The prices reductions were seen in the manufacture of basic metals by 2.1%, in the manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products by 1.4% and in the manufacture of electrical equipment by 0.8%.

¹Producer Price Indices measure the average change in the prices of industrial products, which are produced and sold by Bulgarian enterprises. They can be considered as an early measure of the current inflation process in the economy and also they can be used for international comparisons. Information for calculation of Producer Price Indices is received on the bases of monthly surveys on producer prices of industrial products, sold on domestic market and on industrial products sold on non-domestic market. Producer price surveys are based on constant sample of groups of products, and that sample is representative for total industrial production.

² Producer Price Indices on domestic market are calculated at constant base (2005) weighed with turnover structure on domestic market.

2. Total Producer Price Indices in Industry¹

Total Producer Price Index in Industry in September 2012 increased by 0.9% compared to the previous month. The higher prices were registered in the manufacturing by 1.4%, in the mining and quarrying industry the prices went down by 2.0%, while in the electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply the prices did not change.

In the manufacturing, more significant prices increases² were seen in the manufacture of basic metals by 7.7%, in the manufacture of food products by 1.9% and in the manufacture of leather and related products by 1.7%.

¹ Total Producer Price Index is calculated from Producer Price Index on Domestic Market and Producer Price Index on Non-domestic Market weighted with the turnover structure on domestic and on non-domestic market to the total value of turnover in the base year 2005.

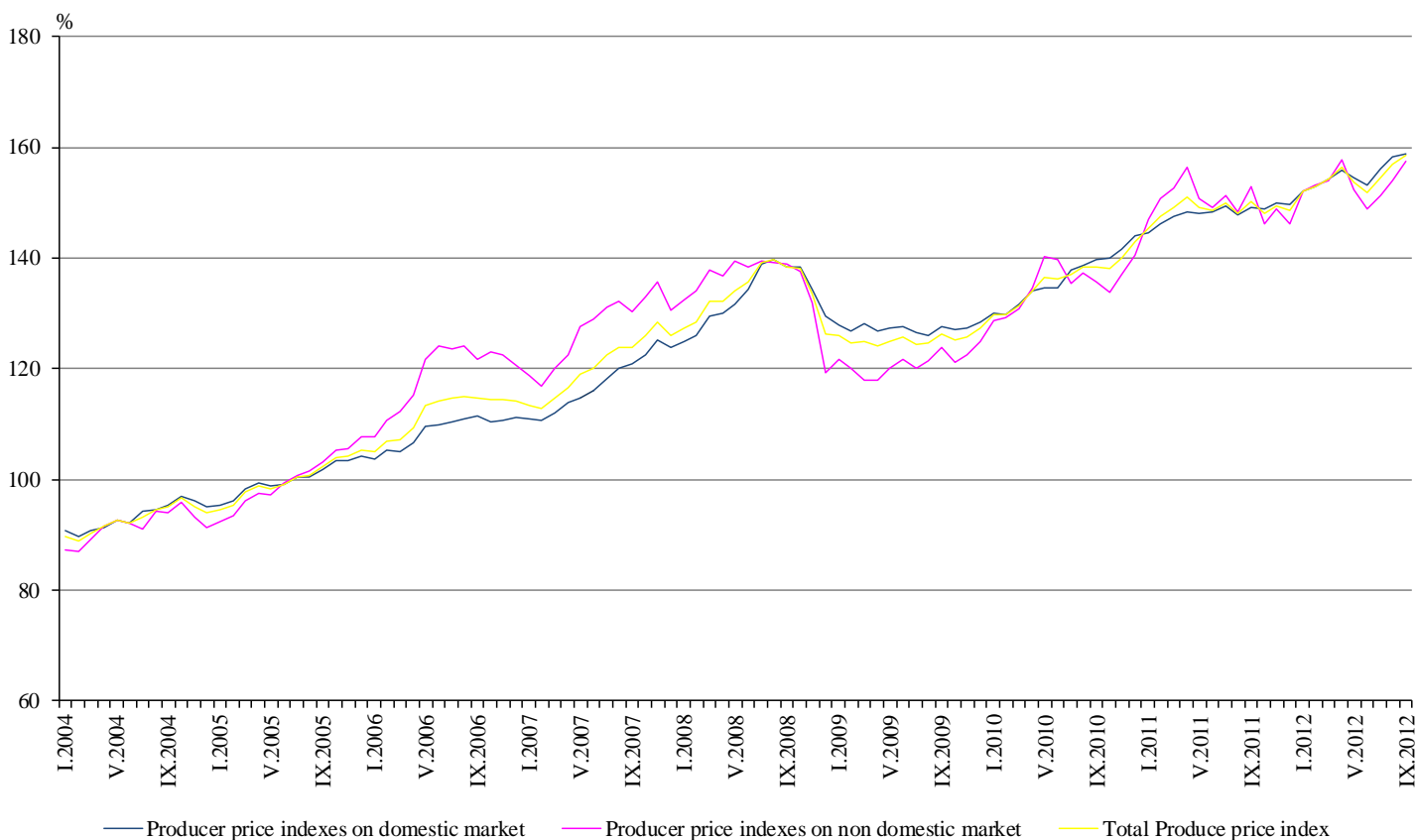

Total Producer Price Index in September 2012 grew by 5.4% comparing to the same month of 2011.

In the manufacturing, the prices rose by 4.7% as compared to September 2011. More significant prices increases were seen in the manufacture of textiles by 10.8%, in the manufacture food products by 6.4%, in the manufacture of tobacco products by 6.2%, while the producer prices went down in the manufacture of basic metals by 5.8% and in the manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products by 0.9%.
