

## PRODUCER PRICE INDICES IN INDUSTRY<sup>1</sup>, AUGUST 2013

### 1. Producer Price Indices on Domestic Market<sup>2</sup>

**Producer Price Index on Domestic Market** in August 2013 increased by 0.2% compared to the previous month. The domestic prices grew in the mining and quarrying industry by 2.1%, in the manufacturing by 0.2% and in the electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply by 0.1%.

In the manufacturing<sup>3</sup>, compared to the previous month the prices went up in the manufacture of basic metals by 0.9%, in the manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery and equipment by 0.4%, in the manufacture of wood and of products of wood and cork, except furniture 0.3%, while a price decrease was seen in the manufacture of food products by 0.9%, and in the manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products by 0.7%.

**Producer Price Index on Domestic Market** in August 2013 decreased by 2.9% compared to the same month of 2012. The domestic prices fell in the mining and quarrying industry by 8.3%, in the manufacturing by 1.8% and in the electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply by 5.1%.


In the manufacturing compared to August 2012, the price decrease was registered in the manufacture of basic metals by 5.2%, in the manufacture of paper and paper products by 1.9% and in the manufacture of chemicals and chemical products by 1.1%. The prices increases were seen in the manufacture of leather and related products by 10.3%, in the repair and installation of machinery and equipment by 6.0%, in the manufacture of beverages by 3.9%.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup>Producer Price Indices measure the average change in the prices of industrial products, which are produced and sold by Bulgarian enterprises. They can be considered as an early measure of the current inflation process in the economy and also they can be used for international comparisons. Information for calculation of Producer Price Indices is received on the bases of monthly surveys on producer prices of industrial products, sold on domestic market and on industrial products sold on non-domestic market. Producer price surveys are based on constant sample of groups of products, and that sample is representative for total industrial production.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Producer Price Indices on domestic market are calculated at constant base (2010) weighed with turnover structure on domestic market.

### 2. Total Producer Price Indices in Industry<sup>1</sup>

**Total Producer Price Index in Industry** in August 2013 increased by 0.1% compared to the previous month. Higher prices were registered in the mining and quarrying industry by 0.9% and in the electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply by 0.4%, while in the manufacturing the prices did not change.

In the manufacturing<sup>2</sup>, more significant prices decreases were seen in the manufacture of leather and related products by 2.8%, in the manufacture of food products and in the manufacture of paper and paper products by 0.9%, while the prices went up in the manufacture of rubber and plastic products by 0.8% and in the manufacture of basic metals by 0.4%.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Total Producer Price Index is calculated from Producer Price Index on Domestic Market and Producer Price Index on Nondomestic Market weighted with the turnover structure on domestic and on non-domestic market to the total value of turnover in the base year.

Total Producer Price Index in August 2013 fell by 3.2% comparing to the same month of 2012.

In the manufacturing, the prices declined by 2.2% as compared to August 2012. More significant prices decreases were seen in the manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers by 4.9%, in the manufacture of basic metals by 2.3% and in the manufacture of paper and paper products by 2.1%, while the producer prices rose in the repair and installation of machinery and equipment by 5.2%, in the manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery and equipment by 4.9%, in the manufacture of beverages by 4.0% and in the manufacture of rubber and plastic products by 2.7%,
