



PRODUCER PRICE INDICES IN INDUSTRY¹, SEPTEMBER 2015

1. Producer Price Indices on Domestic Market²

Producer Price Index on Domestic Market in September 2015 decreased by 0.1% compared to the previous month. The domestic prices fell in the mining and quarrying industry by 1.9% and in the manufacturing by 0.6%, while in the electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply the prices rose by 0.9%.

In the manufacturing³, compared to the previous month the prices went down in the manufacture of basic metals by 0.9% and in the manufacture of rubber and plastic products by 0.6%, while a price increase was reported in the manufacture of tobacco products by 4.5%, in the manufacture of wearing apparel by 0.6%, and in the printing and reproduction of recorded media by 0.5%.

Producer Price Index on Domestic Market in September 2015 decreased by 2.1% compared to the same month of 2014. The domestic prices fell in the mining and quarrying industry by 8.4% and in the manufacturing by 4.7%, while prices increases were registered in the electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply by 3.0%.

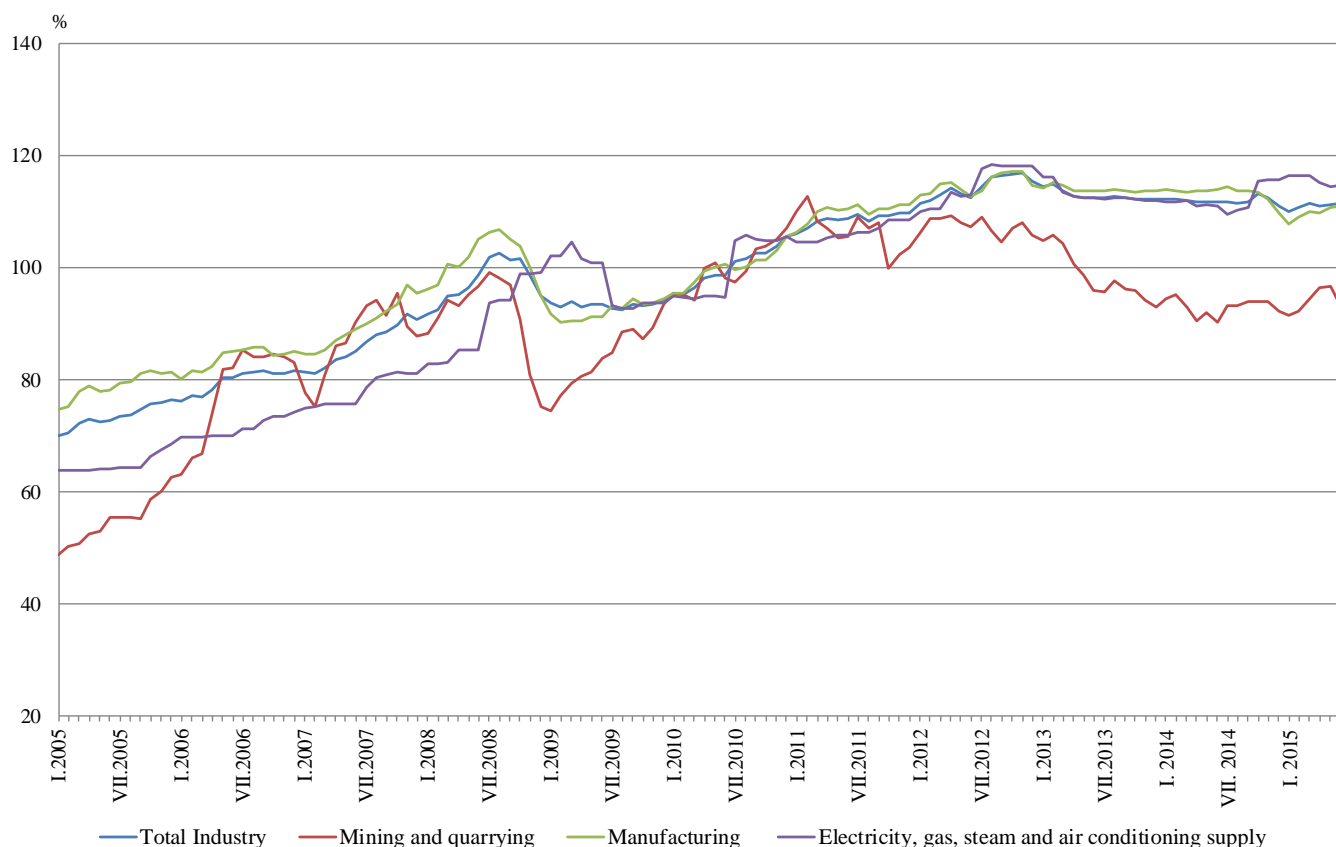
In the manufacturing compared to September 2014 the prices fell in the manufacture of basic metals by 6.0%, in the manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery and equipment by 1.7%, in the repair and installation of machinery and equipment by 1.0%. The prices increases were reported in the manufacture of tobacco products by 7.7%, in the manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products by 3.8% and in the manufacture of machinery and equipment n.e.c. by 3.5%.

¹Producer Price Indices measure the average change in the prices of industrial products, which are produced and sold by Bulgarian enterprises. They can be considered as an early measure of the current inflation process in the economy and also they can be used for international comparisons. Information for calculation of Producer Price Indices is received on the bases of monthly surveys on producer prices of industrial products, sold on domestic market and on industrial products sold on non-domestic market. Producer price surveys are based on constant sample of groups of products, and that sample is representative for total industrial production.

² Producer Price Indices on domestic market are calculated at constant base (2010) weighed with turnover structure on domestic market.

2. Total Producer Price Indices in Industry¹

Total Producer Price Index in Industry in September 2015 decreased by 0.2% compared to the previous month. Lower prices were registered in the mining and quarrying industry by 5.4% and in the manufacturing by 0.5%, while in the electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply the prices went up by 1.2%.

In the manufacturing², more significant prices decreases² were seen in the manufacture of basic pharmaceutical products and pharmaceutical preparations by 0.8% and in the manufacture of chemicals and chemical products by 0.3% while prices increases were reported in the manufacture of tobacco products by 3.1%, in the printing and reproduction of recorded media and in the manufacture of basic metals by 0.5%.

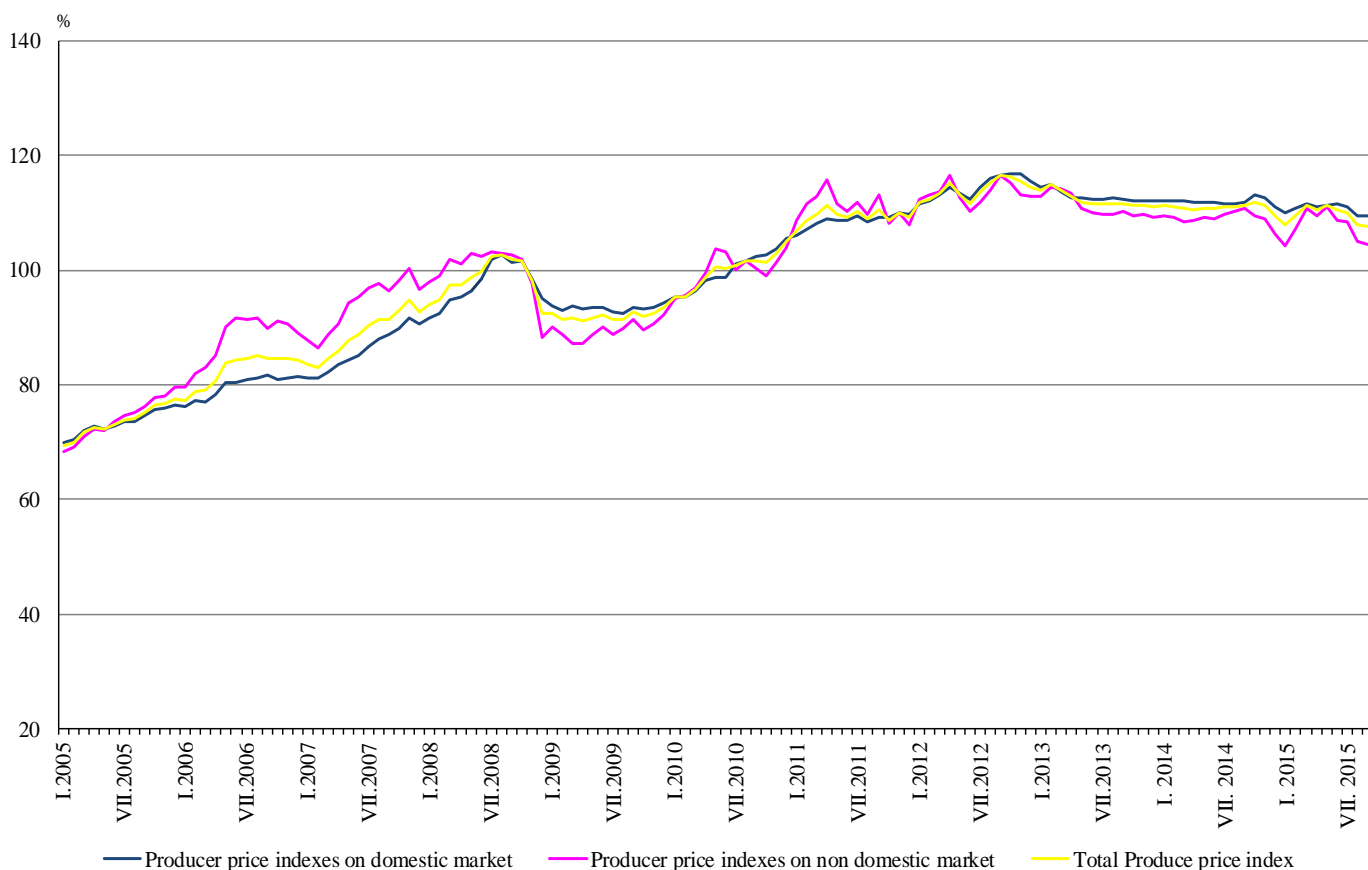
¹ Total Producer Price Index is calculated from Producer Price Index on Domestic Market and Producer Price Index on Non-domestic Market weighted with the turnover structure on domestic and on non-domestic market to the total value of turnover in the base year.

² In the text are not quoted the activities that are confidential according to the Law on Statistics and in this way they are statistical secrecy.



Total Producer Price Index in September 2015 decreased by 3.3% compared to the same month of 2014. In the manufacturing, the prices fell by 5.3% compared to September 2014. More significant prices decreases were seen in the manufacture of basic metals by 5.6%, in the manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products by 0.7% and in the repair and installation of machinery and equipment by 0.6%, while the producer prices rose in the manufacture of tobacco products by 6.2%, in the manufacture of other transport equipment by 5.9% and in the manufacture of textiles by 5.6%.
