



## ACTIVITY OF ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS IN SEPTEMBER 2016

In September 2016, 2 725 accommodation establishments - hotels, motels, camping sites, mountain chalets and other establishments for short-term accommodation with more than 10 bed-places were functioned in the country (Annex, Table 1). The total number of the rooms in them was 124.4 thousand and the bed-places were 278.4 thousand. In comparison with September 2015 the total number of accommodation establishments (functioned during the period) increased by 3.1% and the bed-places in them - by 5.1%.

The total number of the nights spent in all accommodation establishments registered in September 2016 was 3 073.6 thousand, or by 27.1% more in comparison with the same month of the previous year, as the greatest increase (by 33.6%) was observed in 3 stars accommodation establishments.

In September 2016, 70.8% of all nights spent by foreign citizens and 32.8% of all nights spent by Bulgarians were realized in 4 and 5 stars hotels. In 3 stars accommodation establishments were spent 23.4% of all nights by foreigners and 29.7% of all nights by Bulgarian residents, while in the rest of accommodation establishments (with 1 and 2 stars) they were 5.8% and 37.5% respectively.




Figure 1. The nights spent in accommodation establishments by categories and months





In September 2016, the arrivals in all accommodation establishments increased by 23.7% compared to the same month of 2015 and reached 783.6 thousand. Bulgarian guests were 46.9% of all arrivals as the majority part (67.1%) of them spent the nights in accommodation establishments with 1 and 2 or 3 stars and spent 2.6 nights on the average. The arrivals of foreigners were 415.8 thousand as 69.2% of them spent nights in hotels with 4 and 5 stars. On the average 5.2 nights were spent by foreigners.





Figure 2. Arrivals in accommodation establishments by categories in September 2016

In September 2016, the total occupancy of the bed-places in accommodation establishments was 39.2%, as compared to September 2015 increased by 5.8 percentage points. The highest was occupancy of the bed-places in 4 and 5 stars accommodation establishments - 53.1%, followed by 3 stars accommodation establishments - 35.6%, and with 1 and 2 stars - 21.3%.






Figure 3. The occupation of the bed-places in accommodation establishments by categories and months



The total revenues from nights spent in September 2016 reached 146.0 million BGN or by 28.8% more compared to September 2015. An increase was registered in the revenues from both foreign citizens and Bulgarian - by 28.9% and 28.6% respectively.

## **Methodological notes**

Since 2012 the statistical survey on **accommodation establishments** has been carried out monthly in compliance with the Regulation 692/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning European statistics on tourism and the regulation 1051/2011 of the Commission implementing Regulation 692/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning European statistics on tourism, as regards the structure of the quality reports and the transmission of the data.

All categorized hotels, camping sites and other types of accommodation establishments with more than 10 bedplaces in use during the reporting period were included in the observation.

The indicator **other accommodation establishments** include the holiday settlements, hostels, guests houses, bungalows, rest houses, mountain chalets, private rooms and flats and other establishments for short accommodation.

Available Bed Capacity is the maximum number of bed-places on offer for each day of the reference month.

In the **revenues from nights spent** in accommodation establishments are included the sums paid by the guests, without the extra services.
