CONSTRUCTION PRODUCTION INDICES IN MARCH 2022^{1,2}

According to the preliminary data, in March 2022, the index of production in section 'Construction' calculated on the basis of seasonally adjusted data³ was 0.4% below the level of the previous month (Table 1).

In March 2022, the calendar adjusted data⁴ showed an increase of 1.6% in construction production, compared to the same month of 2021 (Table 3).




Figure 1. Construction Production Indices (2015 = 100)

¹ Data for March 2022 are preliminary.

² The monthly indices show the short-term changes in construction production between two comparable periods. This information can be used to analyse the current state of construction activity in the country, as well as a short-term forecast for its future development. The indices are calculated on the basis of information on hours worked in construction. The data are collected with a monthly sample survey that includes construction enterprises, which production exceeds 75% of the total production in construction. Construction Production Indices are calculated on the base 2015 = 100. Data for 2020 and 2021 are reconciled.


³ Seasonal adjustment is a statistical method that eliminates the seasonal component of time series.

⁴ Calendar adjustment is an adjustment for variations in monthly data, caused by calendar effects, the different number of calendar and working days in the months, national holidays and outliers (for example, the presence of more non-working days in May could contribute to the decline in production in some activities).

Monthly changes

In March 2022, the construction production index, calculated from the seasonally adjusted data, was below the level of the previous month. The production index of building construction as well as the production of civil engineering fell by 0.4% (Table 1).



Annual changes

On an annual basis in March 2022, the increase in production in construction, calculated from calendar adjusted data, was determined by the positive rate in building construction, where the growth was 4.2%, while in civil engineering was registered a decrease of 1.6% (Table 3).
