

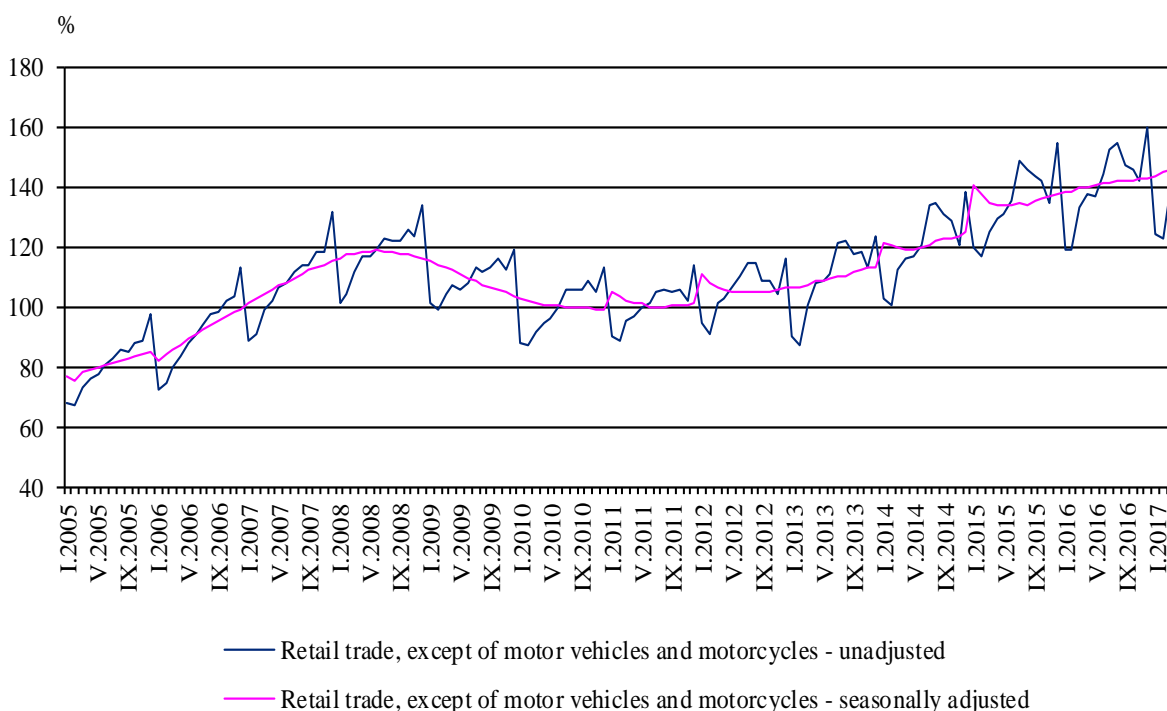


TURNOVER INDICES IN ‘RETAIL TRADE, EXCEPT OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND MOTORCYCLES’ IN MARCH 2017^{1,2}

According to the preliminary seasonally adjusted data³ in March 2017 the turnover in ‘Retail trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles’ at constant prices increased by 0.8% compared to the previous month.

In March 2017, the working day adjusted⁴ turnover in ‘Retail trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles’ increased by 5.9% in comparison with the same month of the previous year.

¹ Data for March 2017 are preliminary.

² The monthly turnover indices reflect the short-term changes in the value of this indicator between two compared periods at constant prices. The information may be used to assess the current situation and the trends in the development of the trade sector as well as for short-term forecasts. In order to calculate the indices trade enterprises are observed by using a representative sample that forms about 70% of the annual receipts of the observed aggregate. The monthly turnover indices are calculated with 2010 as a base year.

³ Seasonal adjustment is a statistical method, which eliminates the seasonal component of time series.

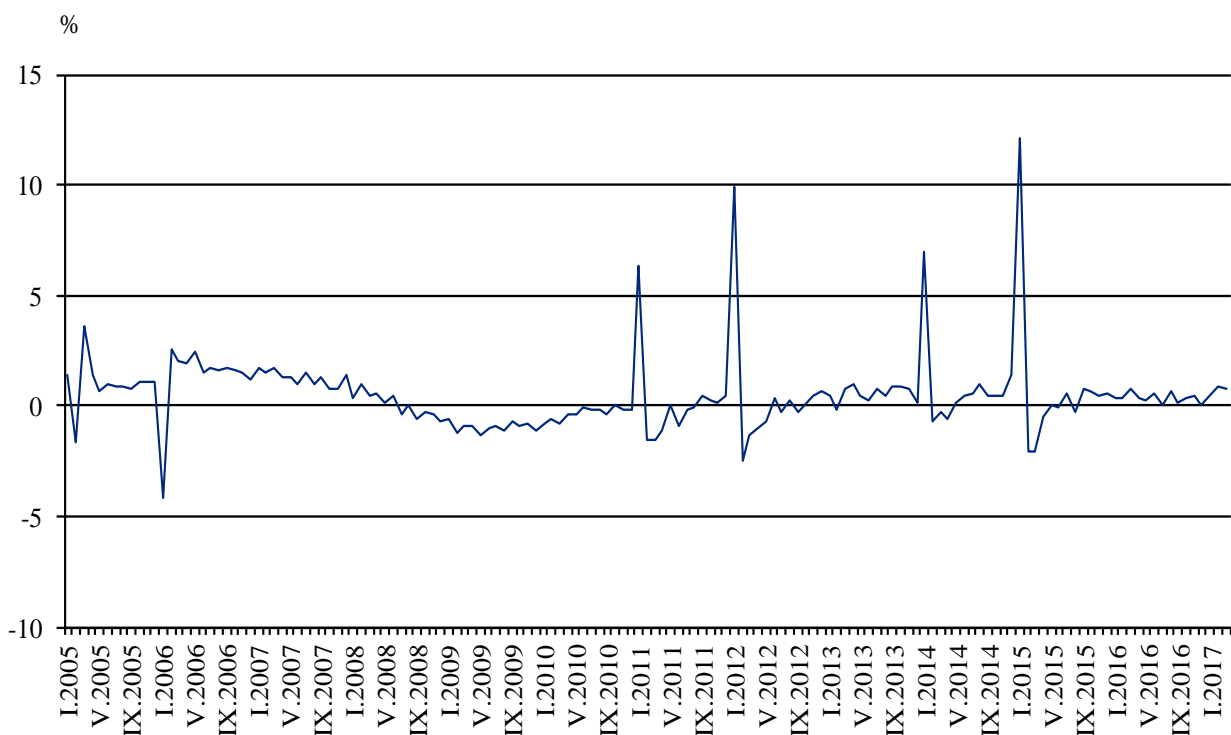
⁴ Working day adjustment is an adjustment for variations caused by calendar effects, different number of calendar and working days in the months, national holidays and outliers (for example the presence of more non-working days in May could contribute to the decline in the retail trade).



Monthly changes

In March 2017 compared to the previous month, **the turnover** increased more significantly in the ‘Retail sale of computers, peripheral units and software; telecommunications equipment’ - 5.7%, in the ‘Retail sale of textiles, clothing, footwear and leather goods’ by 3.1% and in the ‘Retail sale of audio and video equipment; hardware, paints and glass; electrical household appliances’ by 2.0%. A decrease was registered in the ‘Retail sale via mail order houses or via Internet’ - 3.0% and ‘Retail sale of automotive fuel’ - 1.5%.

Figure 2. Change of turnover in ‘Retail trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles’ compared to the previous month (Seasonally adjusted)

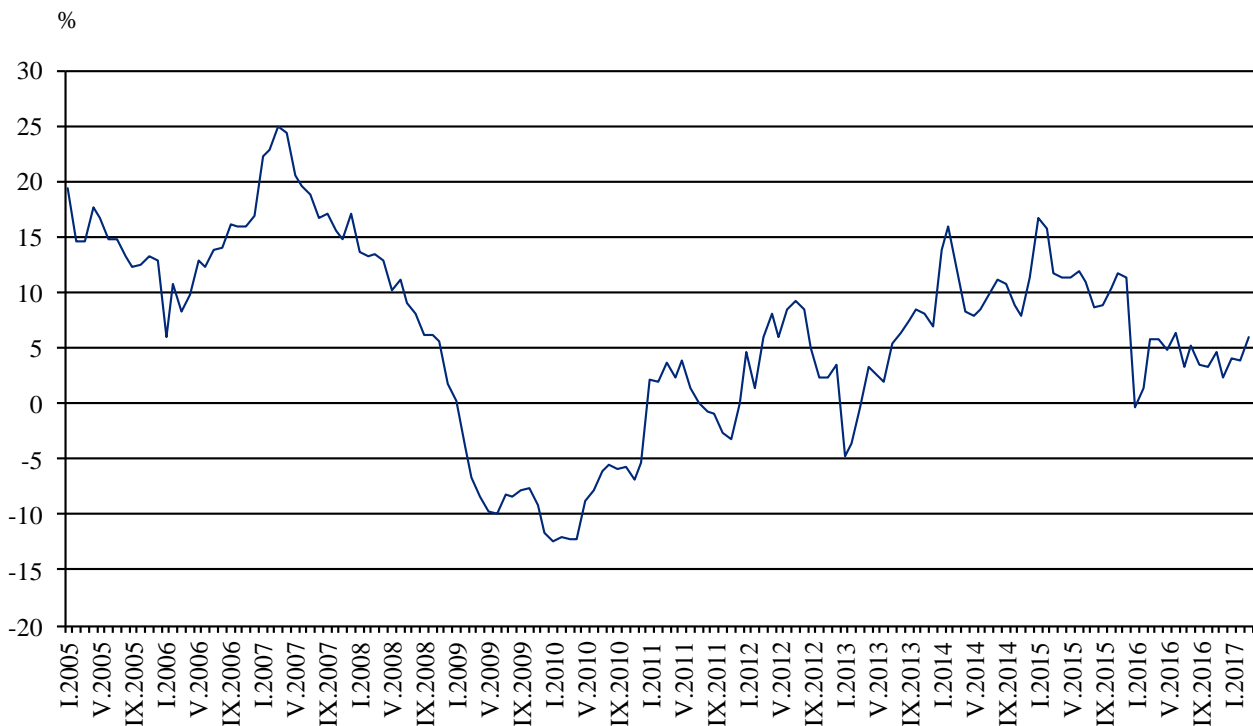




Annual changes

In March 2017 compared to the same month of 2016 **the turnover** increased more significantly in the 'Retail sale of computers, peripheral units and software; telecommunications equipment' by 20.5%, in the 'Retail sale of textiles, clothing, footwear and leather goods' by 17.9% and in the 'Retail sale in non-specialised stores' by 14.8%. A decrease was registered only in the 'Retail sale of automotive fuel' - 12.5%.
