## TURNOVER INDICES IN 'RETAIL TRADE, EXCEPT MOTOR VEHICLES AND MOTORCYCLES', APRIL 2022 ${ }^{1,2}$

According to the preliminary seasonally adjusted data ${ }^{3}$ in April 2022, the turnover in 'Retail trade, except motor vehicles and motorcycles' at constant prices decreased by $0.8 \%$ compared to the previous month.
In April 2022, the calendar adjusted ${ }^{4}$ turnover in 'Retail trade, except motor vehicles and motorcycles' grew by $5.7 \%$ in comparison with the same month of 2021.

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## Monthly changes

In April 2022 compared to the previous month, a decrease in turnover was observed in 'Retail sale of food, beverages and tobacco' - by $0.5 \%$, while in 'Retail sale of automotive fuel in specialised stores' and in 'Retail sale of non-food products (except fuel)' an increase was registered respectively by $1.2 \%$ and $0.3 \%$.
A more considerable growth in 'Retail sale of non-food products (except fuel)' was seen in 'Retail sale of textiles, clothing, footwear and leather goods' $-3.4 \%$ and a more significant decline was observed in 'Retail sale of computers, peripheral units and software; telecommunications equipment' - by $7.0 \%$.

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## Annual changes

In April 2022, compared to the same month of 2021, a rise in turnover was observed in: 'Retail sale of nonfood products (except fuel)' ( $10.0 \%$ ) and 'Retail sale of automotive fuel in specialised stores' ( $9.7 \%$ ). A decrease was reported in 'Retail sale of food, beverages and tobacco' ( $2.1 \%$ ).
In 'Retail sale of non-food products (except fuel)' a rise was registered in all groups: 'Retail sale of textiles, clothing, footwear and leather goods' by $27.7 \%$, 'Retail sale of audio and video equipment; hardware, paints and glass; electrical household appliances' by $15.2 \%$, 'Retail sale in non-specialised stores' by $10.6 \%$, 'Retail sale of computers, peripheral units and software; telecommunications equipment' by $6.1 \%$, 'Dispensing chemist; retail sale of medical and orthopaedic goods, cosmetic and toilet articles in specialised stores' by $5.1 \%$ and 'Retail sale via mail order houses or via Internet' - by $5.0 \%$.

    ${ }^{2}$ The monthly turnover indices reflect the short-term changes in the value of this indicator between two compared periods at constant prices. The information may be used to assess the current situation and the trends in the development of the trade sector as well as for short-term forecasts. In order to calculate the indices trade enterprises are observed by using a representative sample that forms about $70 \%$ of the annual receipts of the observed aggregate. The monthly turnover indices are calculated with 2015 as a base year.
    ${ }^{3}$ Seasonal adjustment is a statistical method, which eliminates the seasonal component of time series.
    ${ }^{4}$ Calendar adjustment is an adjustment for variations caused by calendar effects, a different number of calendar and working days in the months, national holidays and outliers (for example, the presence of more non-working days in May could contribute to the decline in the retail trade).
