
## TRIPS OF BULGARIAN RESIDENTS ABROAD AND ARRIVALS OF VISITORS FROM ABROAD TO BULGARIA IN JULY 2010

In July 2010 the number of the trips of Bulgarian residents abroad was 355.9 thousand, or 31.9% less than the number of the trips in July 2009 (Table 1).

As compared to the corresponding month of 2009, an increase in the total number of the trips was registered only to Norway - by 20.7% and Turkey - by 9.5%. At the same time a decrease in the number of the trips to all other surveyed countries was observed. The highest decline was registered in the trips to Japan - by 63.6%, Slovakia - by 63.0%, Greece - by 60.6%, Malta - by 51.0%, Romania - by 47.7%, Israel - by 47.4%, Ireland - by 37.4%, France - by 37.2%, Sweden - by 37.1%, Hungary - by 32.0%, Italy - by 31.2% and Russian Federation - by 30.7%.

The highest share of the trips of Bulgarian citizens travelling abroad had the trips with professional purpose - 37.2%, followed up by visits as guests - 31.7%, holiday and recreation - 24.4%, and others - 6.7%.

In July 2010, the number of arrivals of visitors from abroad to Bulgaria was 1 568.9 thousand or 6.9% more than the number of trips in the corresponding month of 2009 (Table 2).

In comparison with July 2009, an increase in the number of visitors with purpose holiday and recreation by 9.2% was registered. The visits with other purposes and visitors passing transit increased by 11.6 and 8.3% respectively. At the same time, a decrease was recorded in visits with professional purpose by 17.8% and visits as guests - by 1.8%.







Figure 2. Number of arrivals of visitors to Bulgaria from abroad by purpose of visit

The arrivals of visitors from EU Member States fell by 1.9%, while the highest drop was observed in the number of visits from Ireland and Sweden - 39.1 and 28.9% respectively. An increase was registered in the visits from Spain - by 4.2%, Malta - by 4.2%, Rumania - by 3.2%, Cyprus - by 3.1%, etc.

The visits of foreigners in the group "Other European countries" <sup>1[1]</sup> increased by 31.4%. The largest growth was observed in the number of arrivals of citizens from Russian Federation - by 35.1%, Turkey - by 34.7% and FYROM - by 34.2%.

In July 2010, arrivals with purpose holiday and recreation composed the greatest share of the total number of foreigners' visited Bulgaria - 59.6%, followed by transit trips - 27.1%, professional purpose - 6.6%, others - 5.6% and visits as guests - 1.1%.

### Methodological notes

Statistical data on the trips of Bulgarian citizens travelling abroad and visits by foreigners in Bulgaria are obtained on the basis of monthly information received from the Ministry of Interior and sample survey of the National Statistical Institute among Bulgarian and foreign citizens passing the border check points.

Data on the number of the trips of the citizens of the European Union are estimated on the basis of the information obtained from the Ministry of Interior and the airport authorities. Data on the number of citizens of "third countries" are obtained directly from the Ministry of Interior.

Data on the purposes of the trips are developed on the basis of the NSI's regular monthly sample survey of passing Bulgarian and foreign citizens on the border check points.
