



TRIPS OF BULGARIAN RESIDENTS ABROAD AND ARRIVALS OF VISITORS FROM ABROAD TO BULGARIA IN FEBRUARY 2014




Figure 1. Trips of Bulgarian residents abroad by months

In February 2014, **the number of the trips of Bulgarian residents abroad** was 249.5 thousand or by 1.4% above the registered in February 2013 (Figure 1). In comparison with the same month of the previous year an increase was observed in the total number of the trips of Bulgarians to France - by 72.7%, Spain - by 62.1%, the United Kingdom - by 23.0%, Italy - by 17.2%, Germany - by 10.6%, and etc. At the same time a decrease was observed in the total number of the trips of Bulgarians to Austria - by 20.4%, Romania - by 14.3%, Greece - by 9.8%, Serbia - by 8.7%, Turkey - by 5.8%, and etc. (Annex, Table 1).


The trips with other purposes (as guest, education and visit the cultural and sport events) in February 2014 composed the greatest share of the total number of trips of Bulgarian residents abroad - 56.4%, followed by the trips with professional purpose - 24.3%, and with holiday and recreation purposes - 19.3%. In comparison with February 2013, an increase in the trips with holiday and recreation purposes and with professional purpose by 30.0 and 9.1% respectively was observed, while a decrease in the trips with other purposes by 8.3% was registered.

In February 2014, the trips with other purposes formed 66.1% of all trips to Turkey, 59.7% to Greece and 59.0% to Romania. The trips to Belgium with professional purpose were 45.5%, while these to France and Austria with holiday and recreation purpose were 35.9 and 34.0% respectively of all trips of Bulgarian residents to these countries (Figure 2).




Figure 3. Arrivals of visitors from abroad to Bulgaria by months

In February 2014, the number of arrivals of visitors from abroad to Bulgaria was 320.4 thousand as compared to February 2013 they remain approximately at the same level (Figure 3). An increase was registered in the visits with professional purpose - by 6.7%, while the visits with holiday and recreation purpose and other purposes decreased by 1.2 and 0.6% respectively.

The share of visits of EU citizens was 48.8% of the total number of foreigners' visits to Bulgaria in February 2014 (Annex, Table 2) as in comparison with the same month of the previous year they increased by 4.1%. An increase was registered in the visits of the citizens of Spain - by 13.4%, Italy - by 13.0%, Germany - by 11.6%, Poland - by 10.2%, Romania - by 10.2%, Austria - by 9.1%, Czech Republic - by 7.9%, Hungary - by 6.8%, and etc. At the same time decreased the visits from the United Kingdom - by 15.8%, France - by 10.0%, Belgium - 4.1%, and etc.

The visits of foreigners in the group "Other European countries" decreased by 4.4% as the highest drop was observed in the visits of citizens of Turkey and Serbia - by 6.5 and 5.4% respectively.

In February 2014, the predominant share of the visits with holiday and recreation purpose was - 47.2%, followed by these with others purposes (including as guest and passing transit) - 38.6% and with professional purpose - 14.2%.

The visits with holiday and recreation purposes formed 83.7% of the arrivals from the United Kingdom, 81.0% - from FYROM and 72.0% - from Russian Federation. The visits with professional purpose were 43.2% of all arrivals from Austria, while with other purpose were 57.4% of all arrivals from Turkey and 52.8% - from Greece (Figure 4).



Methodological notes

The definitions recommended by the World Tourist Organization and the Methodological manual for tourism by Eurostat are applied by the National Statistical Institute.

In accordance with these definitions **an international tourist** is any person who travels to a country other than his/her permanent residence for at least 24 hours but no more than one year and whose main purpose is not doing any activity for payment.

The purposes of visiting a country are the following:

- Excursion, holiday or entertainment (visits to cultural or historical landmarks, sport events and other);
- Visiting friends and relatives;
- Professional purposes (business trips, participation in conferences, congresses, concluding deals, etc.);
- Other (education, medical treatment, etc.) purposes.

Statistical data on the trips of Bulgarian citizens travelling abroad and visits by foreigners to Bulgaria are obtained on the basis of monthly information received from the Ministry of Interior and sample survey of the National Statistical Institute among Bulgarian and foreign citizens passing through border check points.

Data on the number of the trips of the citizens of the European Union are estimated on the basis of the information obtained from the Ministry of Interior and the airport authorities. Data on the number of citizens from "third countries" are obtained directly from the Ministry of Interior.

Data on the purposes of the trips are obtained on the basis of the NSI's regular monthly sample survey of passing Bulgarian and foreign citizens through the border check points.
