



TRIPS OF BULGARIAN RESIDENTS ABROAD AND ARRIVALS OF VISITORS FROM ABROAD TO BULGARIA IN SEPTEMBER 2014




Figure 1. Trips of Bulgarian residents abroad by months

In September 2014, **the number of the trips of Bulgarian residents abroad** was 407.0 thousand or by 9.7% above the registered in September 2013 (Figure 1). In comparison with the same month of the previous year an increase was observed in the total number of the trips of Bulgarians to: Greece - by 19.6%, Turkey - by 17.7%, Italy - by 17.1%, Germany - by 13.6%, Spain - by 13.2%, the United Kingdom - by 12.1%, Serbia - by 7.8%, the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia (FYROM) - by 7.7% and etc. At the same time a decrease was observed in the total number of the trips of Bulgarians to: Czech Republic - by 16.8%, Romania - by 11.5%, Russian Federation - by 5.6%, and etc. (Annex, Table 1).


The trips with other purposes (as a guest, education and visit the cultural and sport events) in September 2014 composed the greatest share of the total number of trips of Bulgarian residents abroad - 41.6%, followed by the trips with holiday and recreation purposes - 33.7%, and with professional purpose - 24.7%. In comparison with September 2013 an increase was registered in the trips with professional and holiday and recreation purpose - by 41.5% and 30.2% respectively, while these with other purposes decreased by 13.0%.

In September 2014, the trips with other purposes formed 59.3% of all trips to the United Kingdom and 56.8% to Russian Federation. The trips to Italy with professional purpose were 37.5%, as these to Spain and Greece with holiday and recreation purpose were 56.1% and 49.9% respectively of all trips of Bulgarian residents to these countries (Figure 2).

In September 2014, **the number of arrivals of visitors from abroad to Bulgaria** was 1 108.0 thousands or by 0.5% under the level of September 2013 (Figure 3). A decrease was registered in the trips with holiday and recreation purpose - by 8.8% while the trips with professional purpose and other purposes increased by 23.9% and 2.9% respectively.

The share of visits of EU citizens was 64.0% of the total number of foreigners' visits to Bulgaria in September 2014 (Annex, Table 2) as in comparison with the same month of the previous year they decreased by 2.4%. A decrease was registered in the visits of the citizens of Romania - by 21.3%, Hungary - by 15.4%, Greece - by 4.8%, and etc. At the same time increased the visits from Czech Republic - by 11.6%, Germany - by 10.9%, Spain - by 10.0%, the United Kingdom - by 8.3%, France - by 6.2%, the Netherlands - 5.3% and etc.

The visits of foreigners in the group "Other European countries" decreased by 1.6% as the highest decrease was observed in the visits of citizens of Ukraine and Russian Federation - by 23.2% and 21.5% respectively.

In September 2014, the predominant share of the visits with holiday and recreation purpose was - 46.7%, followed by these with others purposes (including as guest and passing transit) - 37.9% and with professional purpose - 15.4%.

The visits with holiday and recreation purposes formed 85.5% of the arrivals from Russian Federation, 78.8% - from the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, 76.8% - from the United Kingdom. The visits with professional purpose were 44.5% of the arrivals from Spain, as with other purposes were 74.1% of all arrivals from Turkey and 63.8% - from Romania (Figure 4).



Methodological notes

The definitions recommended by the World Tourist Organization and the Methodological manual for tourism by Eurostat are applied by the National Statistical Institute.

In accordance with these definitions **an international tourist** is any person who travels to a country other than his/her permanent residence for at least 24 hours but no more than one year and whose main purpose is not doing any activity for payment.

The purposes of visiting a country are the following:

- Excursion, holiday or entertainment (visits to cultural or historical landmarks, sport events and other);
- Visiting friends and relatives;
- Professional purposes (business trips, participation in conferences, congresses, concluding deals, etc.);
- Other (education, medical treatment, etc.) purposes.

Statistical data on the trips of Bulgarian citizens travelling abroad and visits by foreigners to Bulgaria are obtained on the basis of monthly information received from the Ministry of Interior and sample survey of the National Statistical Institute among Bulgarian and foreign citizens passing through border check points.

Data on the number of the trips of the citizens of the European Union are estimated on the basis of the information obtained from the Ministry of Interior and the airport authorities. Data on the number of citizens from "third countries" are obtained directly from the Ministry of Interior.

Data on the purposes of the trips are obtained on the basis of the NSI's regular monthly sample survey of passing Bulgarian and foreign citizens through the border check points.
