



## TRIPS OF BULGARIAN RESIDENTS ABROAD AND ARRIVALS OF VISITORS FROM ABROAD TO BULGARIA IN OCTOBER 2014




Figure 1. Trips of Bulgarian residents abroad by months

In October 2014, **the number of the trips of Bulgarian residents abroad** was 300.9 thousand or by 1.8% under the registered in October 2013 (Figure 1). In comparison with the same month of the previous year a decrease was observed in the total number of the trips of Bulgarians to: Serbia - by 21.1%, Czech Republic - by 17.6%, Romania - by 17.4%, Austria - by 5.2%, Italy - by 1.7%, and etc. At the same time an increase was observed in the total number of the trips of Bulgarians to: France - by 66.7%, Germany - by 57.5%, the United Kingdom - by 19.0%, Spain - by 13.7%, the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia (FYROM) - by 6.2%, Greece - by 5.1%, Turkey - by 2.6%, and etc. (Annex, Table 1).


The trips with other purposes (as a guest, education and visit the cultural and sport events) in October 2014 composed the greatest share of the total number of trips of Bulgarian residents abroad - 41.1%, followed by the trips with holiday and recreation purposes - 33.4%, and with professional purpose - 25.5%. In comparison with October 2013 an increase was registered in the trips with holiday and recreation and with professional purpose - by 60.8% and 5.0% respectively, while these with other purposes decreased by 27.7%.

In October 2014, the trips with other purposes formed 56.8% of all trips to the United Kingdom and 54.0% to Germany. The trips to Italy with professional purpose were 37.5%, as these to Spain and Greece with holiday and recreation purpose were 56.1% and 49.7% respectively of all trips of Bulgarian residents to these countries (Figure 2).




Figure 3. Arrivals of visitors from abroad to Bulgaria by months

In October 2014, **the number of arrivals of visitors from abroad to Bulgaria** was 557.1 thousands or by 1.9% above the level of October 2013 (Figure 3). An increase was registered in the trips with other purposes - by 30.8% while the trips with holiday and recreation purpose and with professional purpose decreased by 23.3% and 7.8% respectively.

The share of visits of EU citizens was 54.2% of the total number of foreigners' visits to Bulgaria in October 2014 (Annex, Table 2) or by 0.2% more in comparison with the same month of the previous year. An increase was registered in the visits of the citizens of Italy - by 28.0%, Belgium - by 9.8%, Greece - by 3.2%, Poland - by 2.9%, Germany - by 1.2%, and etc. At the same time decreased the visits from the United Kingdom - by 18.7%, France - by 17.4%, Czech Republic - by 8.2%, Austria - by 2.4%, and etc.

The visits of foreigners in the group 'Other European countries' increased by 0.7% as the highest growth was observed in the visits of citizens of Serbia - by 3.5%.

In October 2014, the predominant share of the visits with others purposes (including as guest and passing transit) was - 53.6%, followed by these with holiday and recreation purpose - 31.3% and with professional purpose - 15.1%.


The visits with holiday and recreation purposes formed 81.7% of the arrivals from the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia and 63.6% - from the United Kingdom. The visits with professional purpose were 54.6% of the arrivals from Belgium, as with other purposes were 83.7% of all arrivals from Greece and 69.0% - from Romania (Figure 4).

Group "Other European countries" includes countries in Europe outside EU.

## **Methodological notes**

The definitions recommended by the World Tourist Organization and the Methodological manual for tourism by Eurostat are applied by the National Statistical Institute.

In accordance with these definitions **an international tourist** is any person who travels to a country other than his/her permanent residence for at least 24 hours but no more than one year and whose main purpose is not doing any activity for payment.

## The purposes of visiting a country are the following:

- Excursion, holiday or entertainment (visits to cultural or historical landmarks, sport events and other);
- Visiting friends and relatives;
- Professional purposes (business trips, participation in conferences, congresses, concluding deals, etc.);
- Other (education, medical treatment, etc.) purposes.

Statistical data on the trips of Bulgarian citizens travelling abroad and visits by foreigners to Bulgaria are obtained on the basis of monthly information received from the Ministry of Interior and sample survey of the National Statistical Institute among Bulgarian and foreign citizens passing through border check points.

Data on the number of the trips of the citizens of the European Union are estimated on the basis of the information obtained from the Ministry of Interior and the airport authorities. Data on the number of citizens from "third countries" are obtained directly from the Ministry of Interior.

Data on the purposes of the trips are obtained on the basis of the NSI's regular monthly sample survey of passing Bulgarian and foreign citizens through the border check points.
