

TRIPS OF BULGARIAN RESIDENTS ABROAD AND ARRIVALS OF VISITORS FROM ABROAD TO BULGARIA IN MARCH 2015




Figure 1. Trips of Bulgarian residents abroad by months

In March 2015, **the number of the trips of Bulgarian residents abroad** was 318.3 thousand (Annex, Table 1) or by 1.6% above the registered in March 2014 (Figure 1). In comparison with the same month of the previous year an increase was observed in the total number of the trips of Bulgarians to: Spain - by 16.9%, Romania - by 15.0%, Czech Republic - by 12.6%, Greece - by 7.7%, Serbia - by 6.9%, Germany - by 5.3%, and etc. At the same time a decrease was observed in the total number of the trips of Bulgarians to: the United Kingdom - by 9.5%, Austria - by 9.0%, Italy -by 8.2%, Belgium - by 7.9%, the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia - by 7.1%, France - by 5.4%, Turkey - by 5.3%, and etc.

The trips with other purposes (as a guest, education and visit the cultural and sport events) in March 2015 composed the greatest share of the total number of trips of Bulgarian residents abroad - 50.0%, followed by the trips with professional purpose - 28.2%, and with holiday and recreation purposes - 21.8%. In comparison with March 2014 an increase was registered in the trips with other and with professional purposes - by 14.0% and 8.2% respectively, while these with holiday and recreation purposes decreased by 23.6%.





Figure 2. Structure of the trips of Bulgarian residents abroad by purpose of visit and country of destination in March 2015

In March 2015, the trips with other purposes formed 72.7% of all trips to Turkey and 72.0% to France. The trips to Belgium with professional purpose were 49.5%, to Germany - 48.6%, as these to Spain and Italy with holiday and recreation purpose were 38.6 and 38.1% respectively of all trips of Bulgarian residents to these countries (Figure 2).

In March 2015, **the number of arrivals of visitors from abroad to Bulgaria** was 370.5 thousands (Annex, Table 2) or by 2.6% above the level of March 2014 (Figure 3). An increase was registered in the trips with professional purpose and with other purposes by 23.1% and 9.5% respectively, while the trips with holiday and recreation purpose decreased by 11.8%.





The share of visits of EU citizens was 45.9% of the total number of foreigners' visits to Bulgaria in March 2015 or by 1.0% more in comparison with the same month of the previous year. An increase was registered in the visits of the citizens of Belgium - by 10.4%, the United Kingdom - by 7.5%, France - by 6.3%, Spain - by 4.7%, Czech Republic - by 3.9%, Greece - by 1.8%, Austria - by 1.8%, Italy - by 1.2%, and etc. At the same time decreased the visits from Hungary - by 30.2%, Poland - by 5.0%, and etc.

The visits of foreigners in the group 'Other European countries'¹ increased by 2.3%, as the highest growth was observed in the visits of citizens of Turkey - by 9.9%.

In March 2015, the predominant share of the visits with others purposes (including as guest and passing transit) was 42.0%, followed by these with holiday and recreation purpose - 37.2% and with professional purpose - 20.8%.




Figure 4. Structure of the arrivals of visitors to Bulgaria from abroad by purpose of visit and country of origin in March 2015

The visits with holiday and recreation purposes formed 93.2% of the arrivals from Israel and 81.3% - from the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia. The visits with professional purpose were 57.1% of the arrivals from Spain and 53.8% - from Austria, as with other purposes were 57.9% of all arrivals from Romania and 57.4% - from Turkey (Figure 4).

Methodological notes

The definitions recommended by the World Tourist Organization and the Methodological manual for tourism by Eurostat are applied by the National Statistical Institute.

In accordance with these definitions **an international tourist** is any person who travels to a country other than his/her permanent residence for at least 24 hours but no more than one year and whose main purpose is not doing any activity for payment.

The purposes of visiting a country are the following:

- Excursion, holiday or entertainment (visits to cultural or historical landmarks, sport events and other);
- Visiting friends and relatives;
- Professional purposes (business trips, participation in conferences, congresses, concluding deals, etc.);
- Other (education, medical treatment, etc.) purposes.

Statistical data on the trips of Bulgarian citizens travelling abroad and visits by foreigners to Bulgaria are obtained on the basis of monthly information received from the Ministry of Interior and sample survey of the National Statistical Institute among Bulgarian and foreign citizens passing through border check points.

Data on the number of the trips of the citizens of the European Union are estimated on the basis of the information obtained from the Ministry of Interior and the airport authorities. Data on the number of citizens from 'third countries' are obtained directly from the Ministry of Interior.

Data on the purposes of the trips are obtained on the basis of the NSI's regular monthly sample survey of passing Bulgarian and foreign citizens through the border check points.
