



GOODS AND PASSENGERS CARRIED AND TRANSPORT PERFORMANCE BY MODE OF TRANSPORT


1. Land transport

1.1. Freight transport

According to the preliminary data in the second quarter of 2010 is registered an increase in comparison to the previous quarter for the transported goods by 37.8%, as well for the transport performance in tonne-kilometres by 16.7%.

Compared to the same period of 2009 the volume of the transported goods is by 3.6% lower, while the transport performance rose by 17.3%. Only the pipeline transport registers a decline in the tonne-kilometres by 4.4%.

1.2. Passenger transport


In the period April – June 2010 the transported passengers by the means of the land transport are 136 751.9 thousand. A decrease is registered compared to the previous three months, as well to the same period of 2009, by 0.7 and by 5% respectively.

In the international carriages there is an increase by 42.6% in comparison with the second quarter of 2009, but due to their low percentage in volume of transported passengers – 0.3%, they do not have significant influence on the general trend.

The transport performance in passengers-kilometers in the period April – June 2010 is by 9.4% more compared to the previous three months and reaches 3 196.5 million pkm, while in comparison with the corresponding quarter of 2009 there is a drop by 2.4%.



Figure 2. Transported passengers and transport performance by the land transport




2. Water transport

2.1. Freight transport

Goods carried by water transport in the second quarter of 2010 are almost the same volume as in the previous quarter – 1962.8 thousand tons, while in comparison with the corresponding quarter of 2009 they are by 17.9% lower.

The transport performance (in tkms) is 7 631.2 million tkm or by 44.5% more than the previous quarter. The growth of the transport performance is due to the increased average distance travelled in the water transport by 1 961 km. In comparison with the second quarter of 2009 the transport performance fell by 43.1%.

Figure 3. Transported goods and transport performance by the water transport






2.2. Passenger transport

The number of the passengers transported by water transport in the second quarter of 2010 increase by 34.1% as compared to the previous quarter. In comparison with the same period of 2009 is registered a drop by 28.9%.

Transport performance in passenger-kilometers in the period April – June 2010 is increased compared to the corresponding quarter of 2009 and reaches 348 thousand pkm, while in comparison to the previous quarter is registered a decrease by 26.0%.

Figure 4. Transported passengers and transport performance by the water transport




3. Urban electrical transport

During the second quarter of 2010 the passengers transported by urban electrical transport are 73 674 thousand or by 3.8% less than the previous quarter, but by 6.3% higher compared to the corresponding quarter of 2009.

Compared to the first quarter of 2010 the transport performance in pkms fell by 3.3%, due to the decreased volume of the transported passengers. In comparison with the second quarter of 2009 the passenger-kilometers rose by 31.4%, due to the increased volume of the transported passengers and the increased average distance travelled.

Methodological notes

Land transport covers the passengers' or freight carriages by road and rail transport from vehicles with Bulgarian registration as well as transmission of goods by pipelines.

Water transport covers the passengers' or freight carriages and transport performance by maritime and IWW vessels with Bulgarian registration.

Urban electrical transport includes passengers carried and transport performance of trolleybus transport in the country, tramway transport, and metro in Sofia.

Goods carried - (tons) is measured the total volume of goods carried between two places (place of loading and place of unloading).

Transport performance of freight transport (tonne-kilometres) - corresponds to the transportation of one tonne over one kilometre.

Passengers carried (number) - measures the total number of passengers with paid fares carried by the corresponding type of transport between two places (place of embarkation and place of disembarkation).

Transport performance of passenger transport (passenger-kilometres) - corresponds to the transportation of one passenger over one kilometre.
